Orientation & New Student Programs Benchmarking Study Results

During the fall 2021 semester, the Texas Christian University (TCU) Office of Student Life Analytics conducted a study to evaluate Orientation and New Student Programs. The evaluation provides actionable data on:

- Outcomes of orientation programming;
- Students' ease of transition to college;
- Students' relationships with faculty, staff, and peers;
- Students' knowledge and utilization of campus resources and co-curricular activities;
- Suggestions for improving orientation.

The Orientation and New Student Programs Benchmark is one of the nine NASPA Assessment & Knowledge Consortium studies. Benchmarking studies are conducted on a three-year rotation.

The CampusLabs survey platform was used to distribute the survey, collect responses, and analyze results. The initial survey invitation was sent to 2,334 First-Year students. Four reminder emails were sent every four days after the initial invitation. A total of 281 students responded to the survey for an 12.04% response rate. Of those 281 that responded, 266 completed the survey for a 94.66% completion rate. While the response rate was less than desired, these results still yield a 5.5% confidence interval at the 95% confidence level.
