

# TITLE IX BENCHMARKING SURVEY: RESULTS REPORT

Texas Christian University (TCU) is committed to providing a positive learning and working environment free from discrimination. The university is therefore dedicated to eliminating sexual harassment and sexual violence. These behaviors are incompatible with TCU's mission to educate individuals to think and act as ethical leaders and responsible citizens in the global community, and can threaten the educational experience, careers and well-being of members of the TCU community, including employees, students, and visitors.

During 2021 fall semester, the TCU Office of Student Life Analytics, in collaboration with the Office of Equity & Inclusion, administered a campus climate survey designed to measure peer norms and perceptions of the campus climate, sexual harassment, stalking, dating violence, sexual violence, bystander intervention and campus safety. In addition, the survey included items assessing students' experience with intervention, personal use of resources, and individual barriers when opting not to pursue resources.

The Title IX survey was developed in-house based on recommendations from the Toolkit to End Violence Against Women (US Department of Justice, 2004; [Toolkit to End Violence Against Women | Office of Justice Programs \(ojp.gov\)](#)). Benchmarking studies are conducted on a three-year rotation. This survey was previously administered in 2015 and 2018.

The CampusLabs survey platform was used to distribute the survey, collect responses, and analyze results. The initial survey invitation was sent to 3,752 undergraduate and graduate students. Four reminder emails were sent every four days after the initial invitation. A total of 578 students responded to the survey for a 15.41% response rate. Of those 578 that responded, 505 completed the survey for an 87.37% completion rate. These results yield a 4.25% confidence interval at the 95% confidence level.
