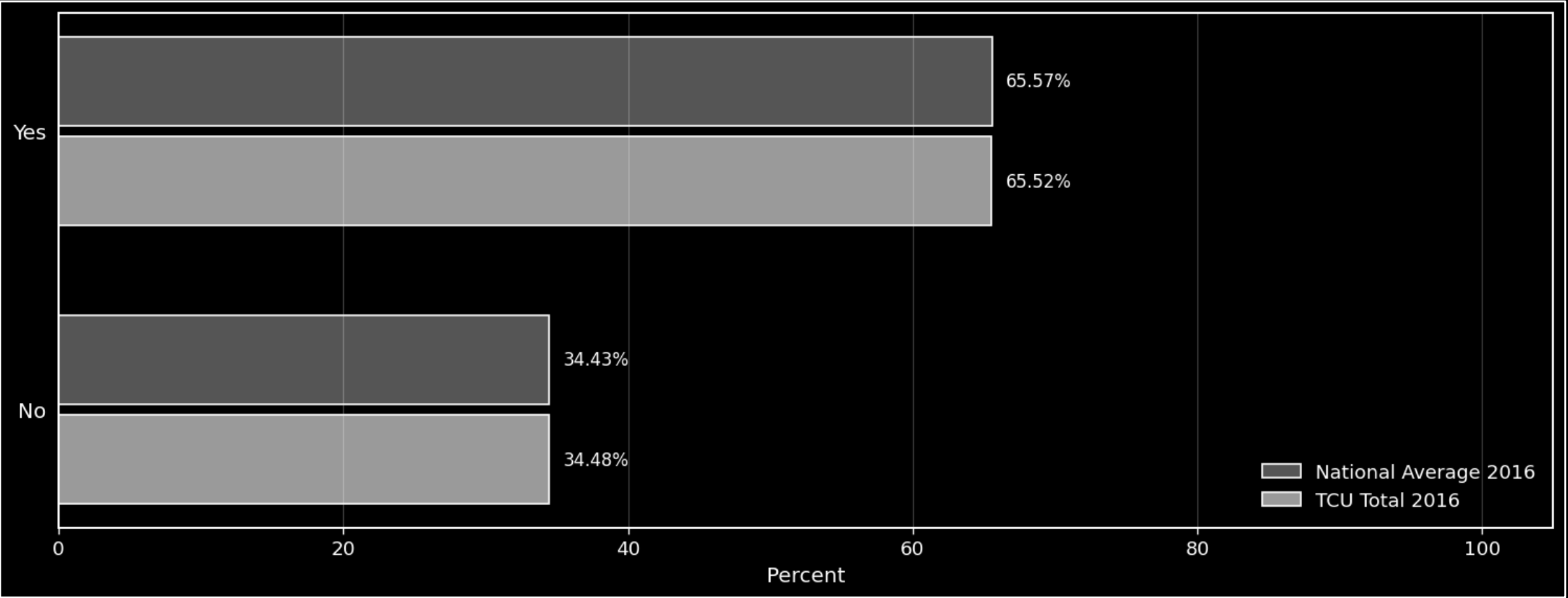


Chart 2. Of which type of organization are/were you a member?

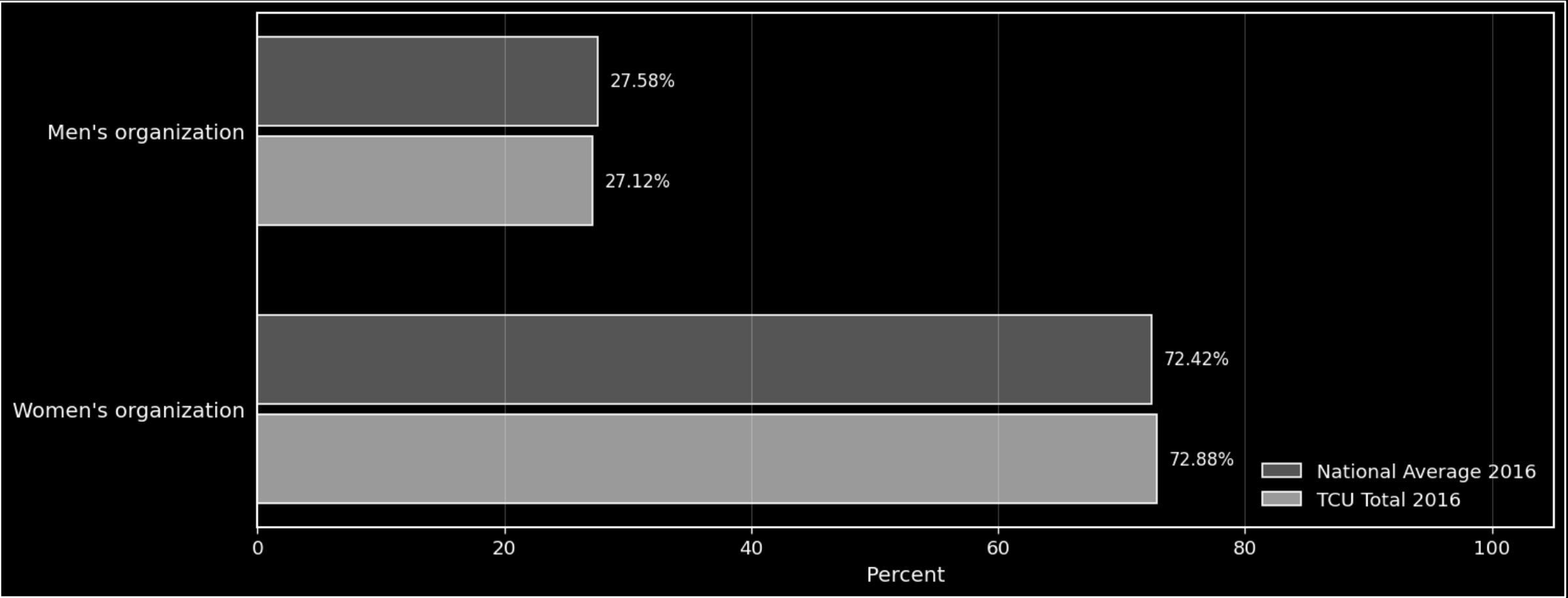


Chart 3. Which best describes your current participation in a fraternity or sorority at this institution?

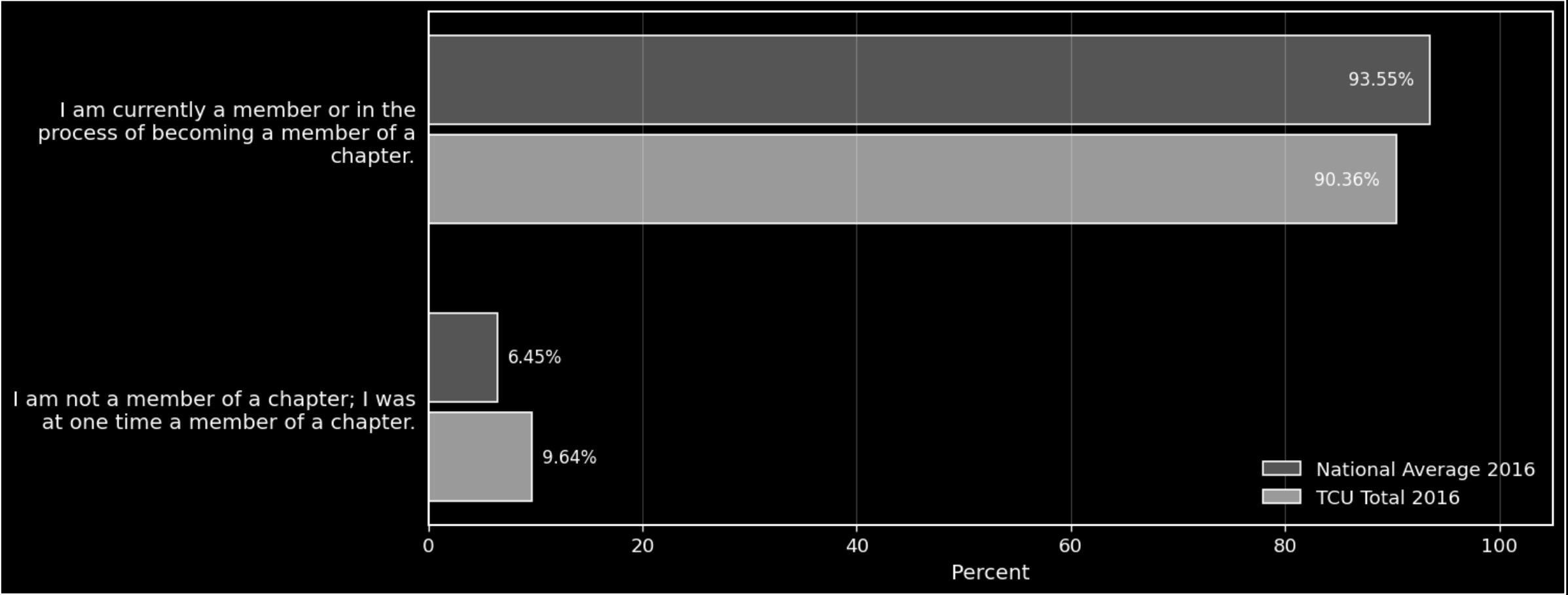


Chart 4. Have you ever considered joining a fraternity or sorority at this institution?

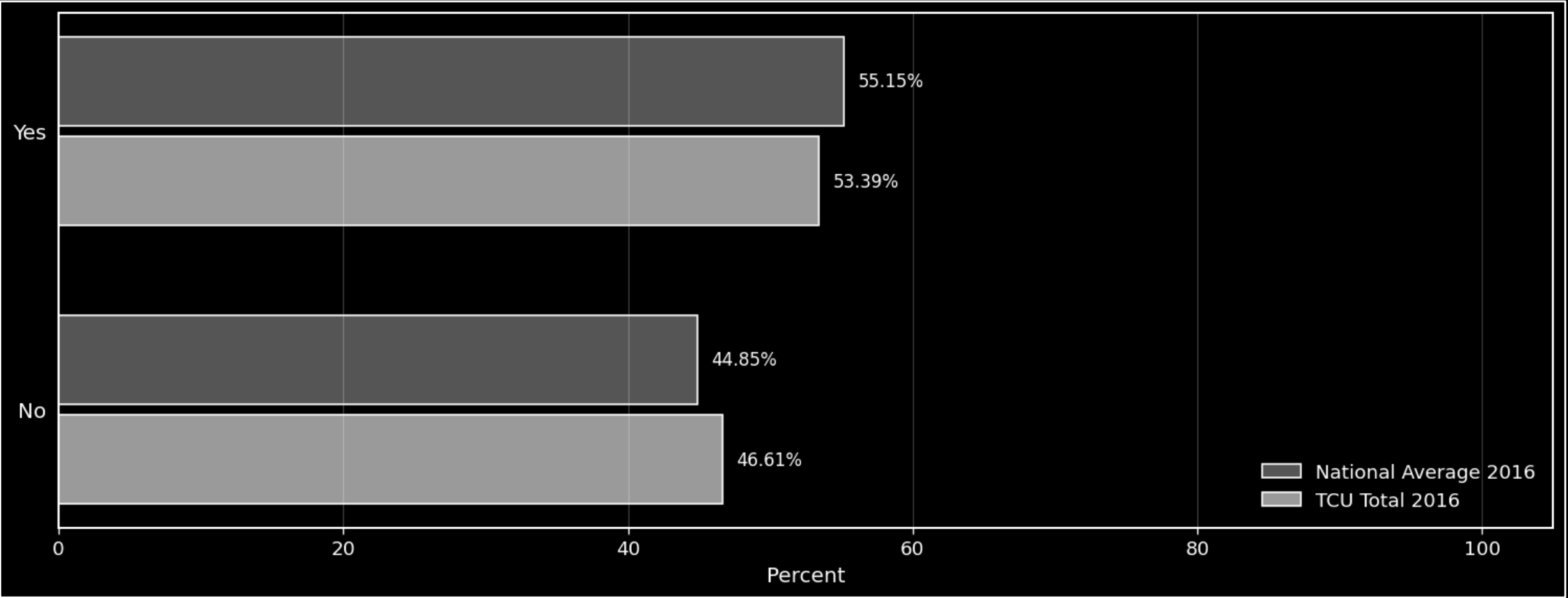


Chart 5. Have you participated in any formal or informal recruitment activities or intake activities (the process of visiting with and getting to know fraternities or sororities) at this institution?

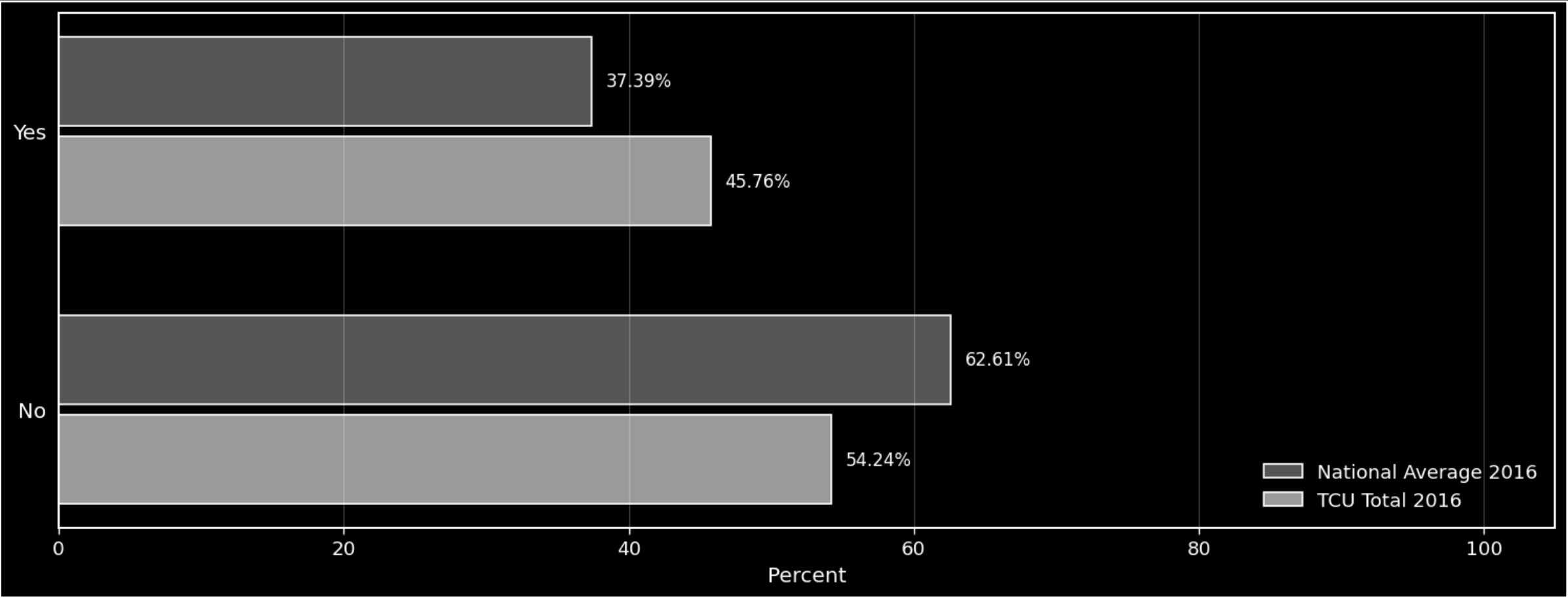


Chart 6. For which of the following reasons did you choose not to participate in a fraternity/sorority recruitment or intake process? (Check all that apply)

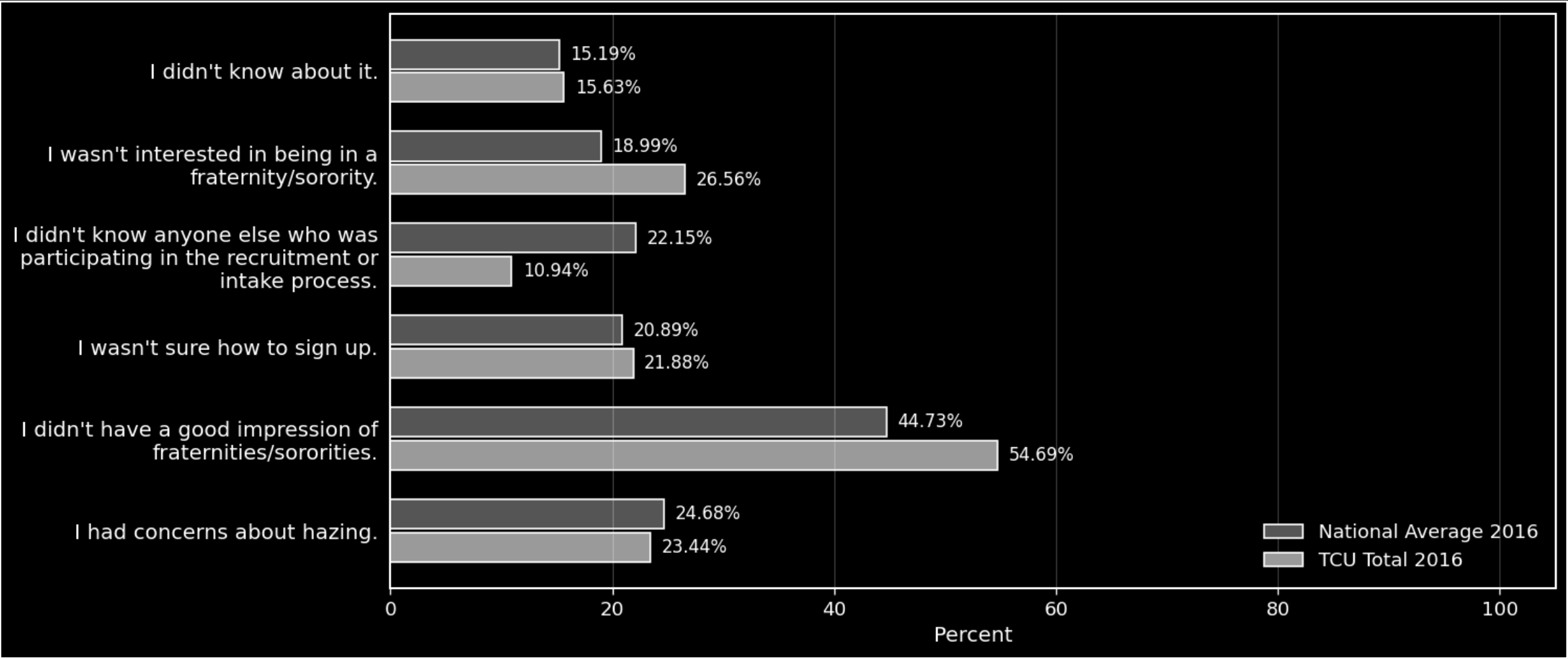


Chart 6. For which of the following reasons did you choose not to participate in a fraternity/sorority recruitment or intake process? (Check all that apply)

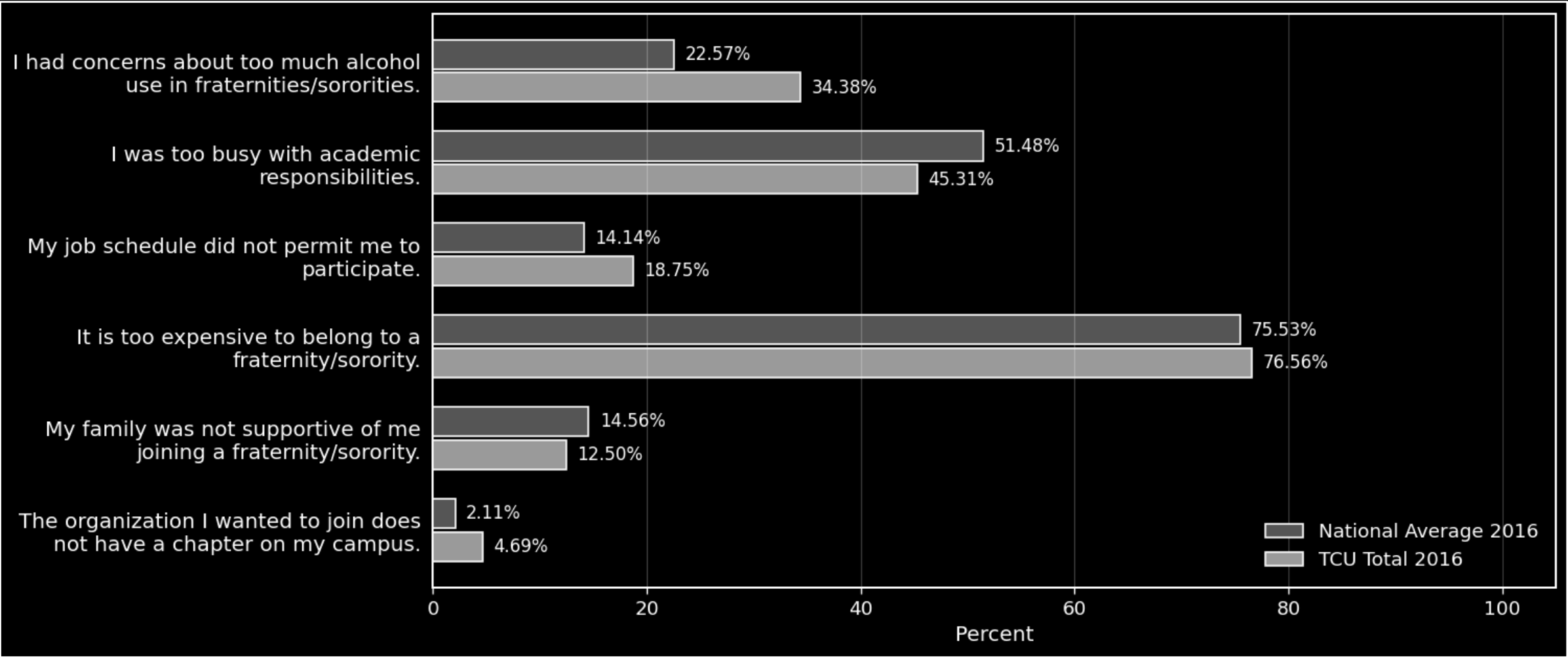


Chart 6. For which of the following reasons did you choose not to participate in a fraternity/sorority recruitment or intake process? (Check all that apply)

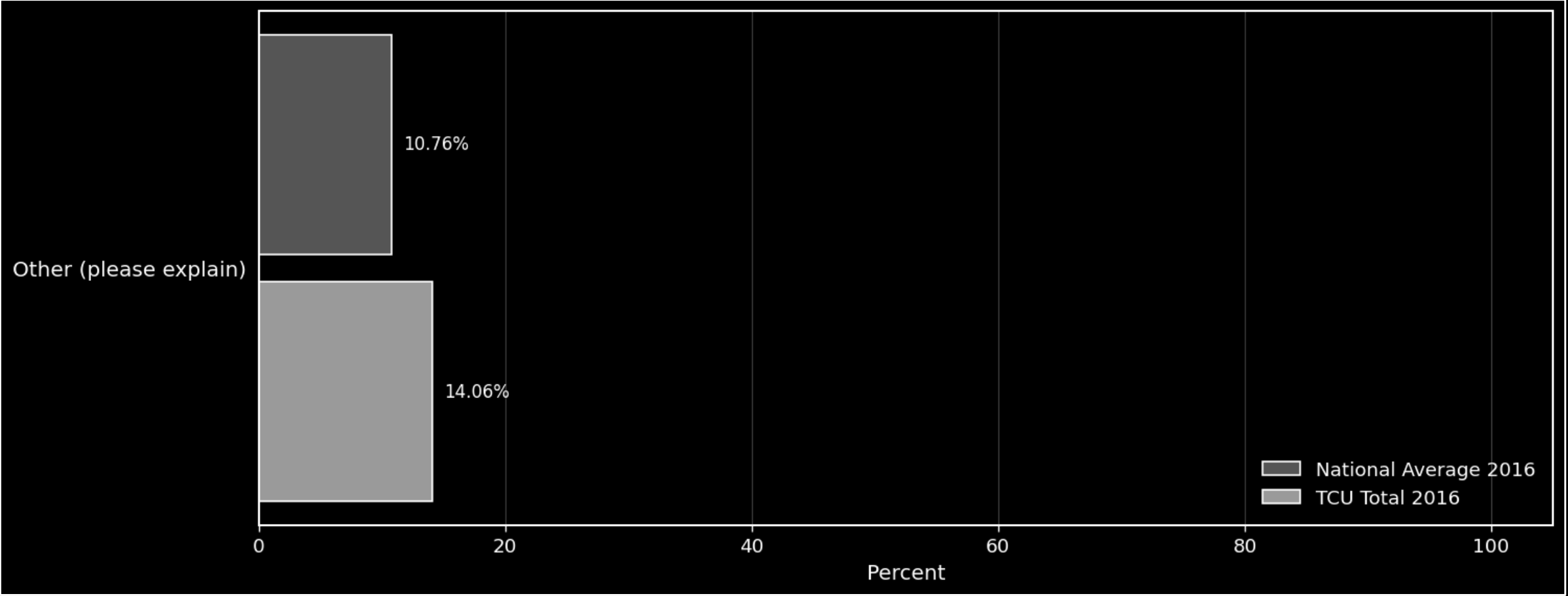

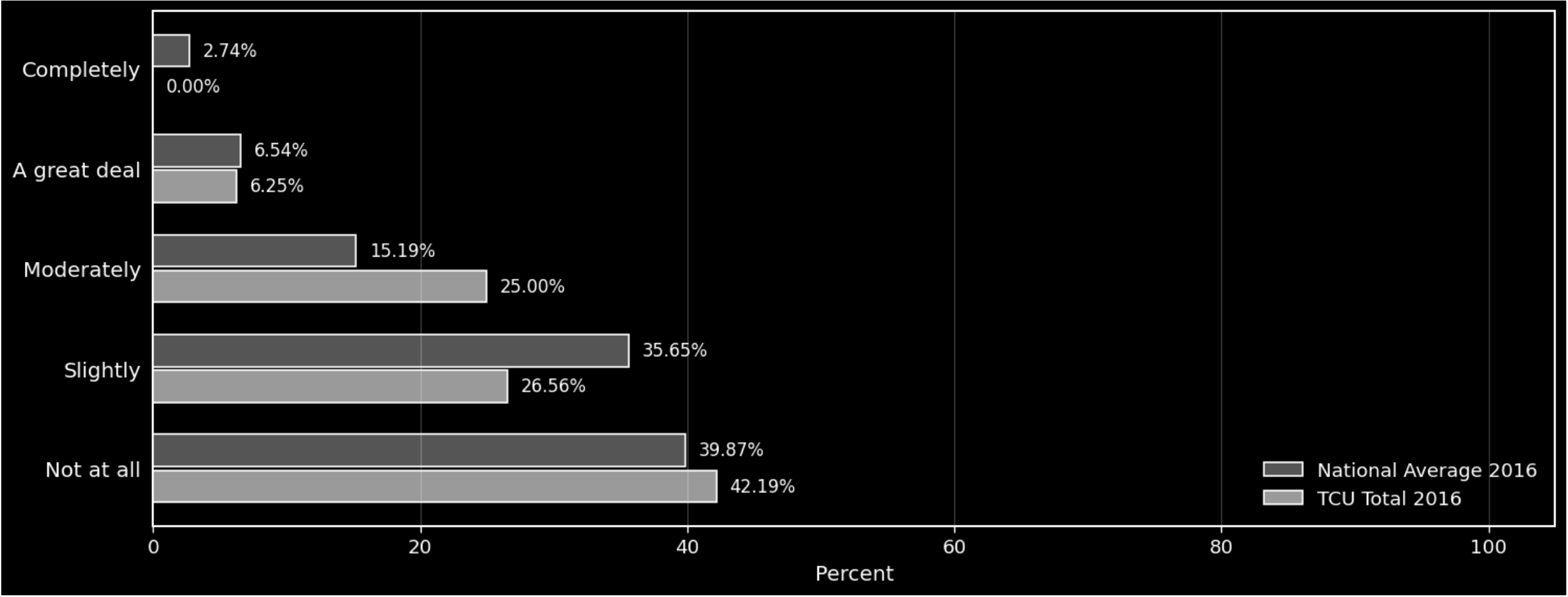


Chart 8. How did you hear about formal or informal recruitment and/or intake activities for fraternities/sororities at this institution? (Check all that apply)

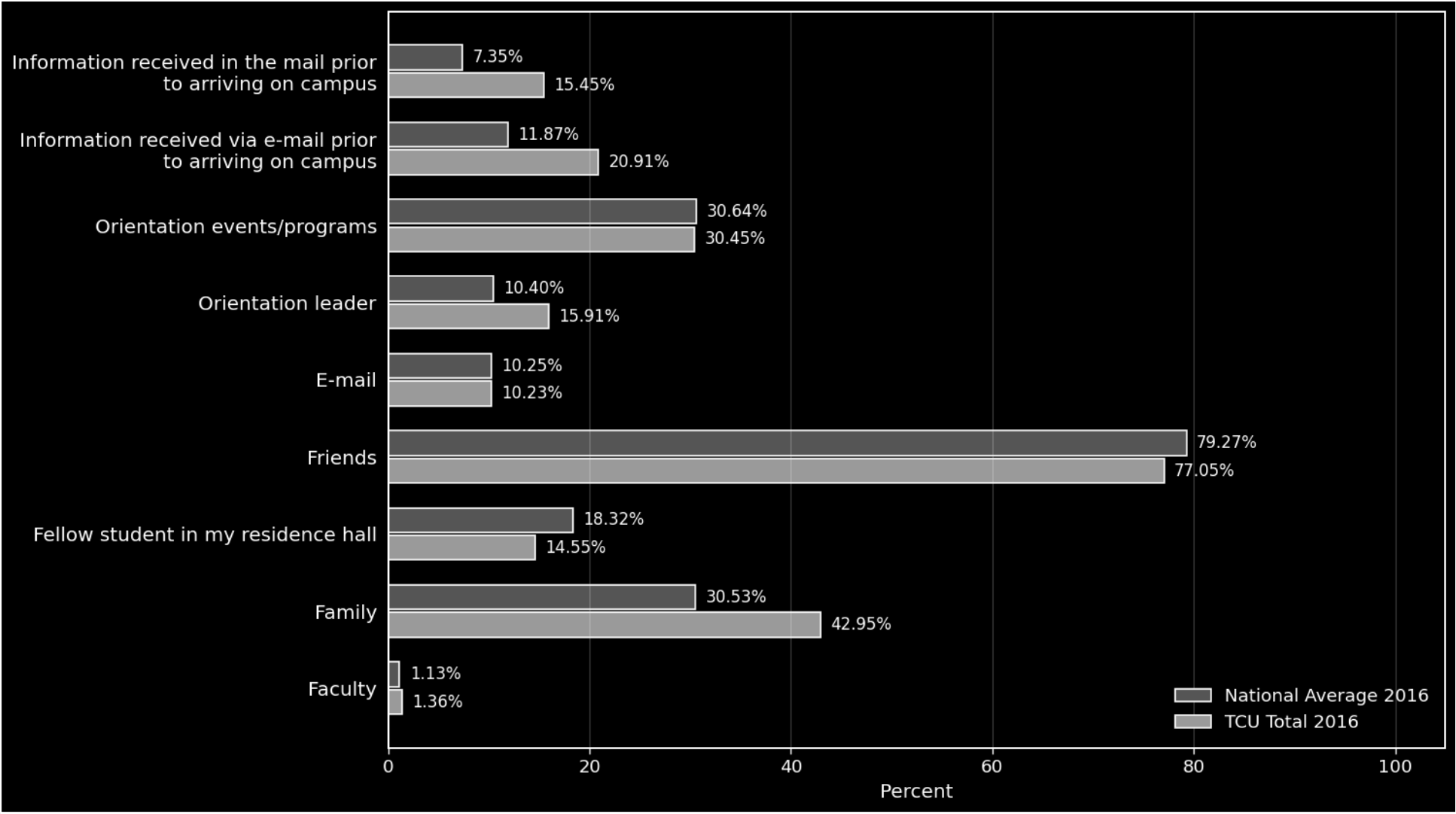


Chart 8. How did you hear about formal or informal recruitment and/or intake activities for fraternities/sororities at this institution? (Check all that apply)

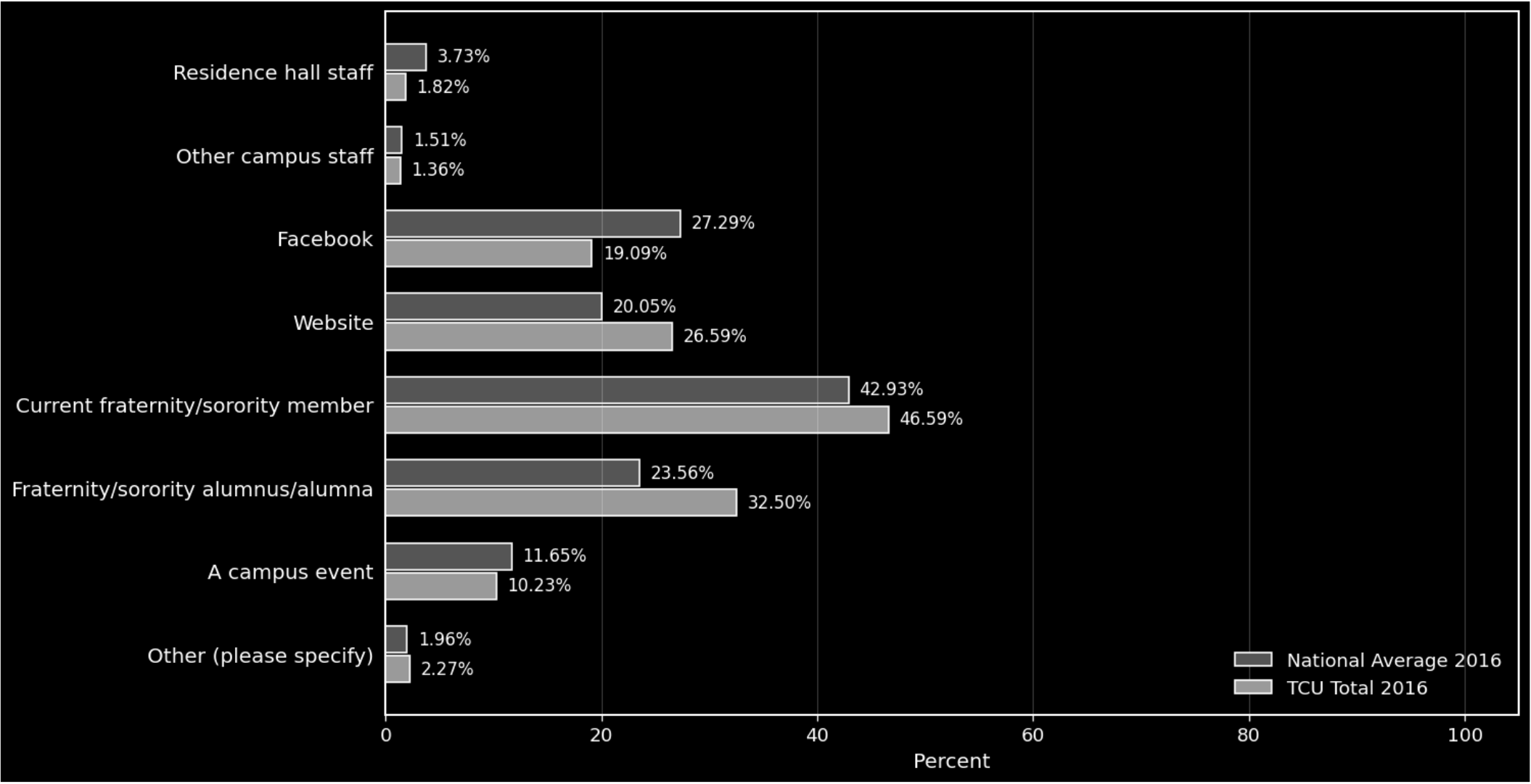


Chart 9. For which of the following reasons did you participate in recruitment/intake? (Check all that apply) (Part 1 of 2)

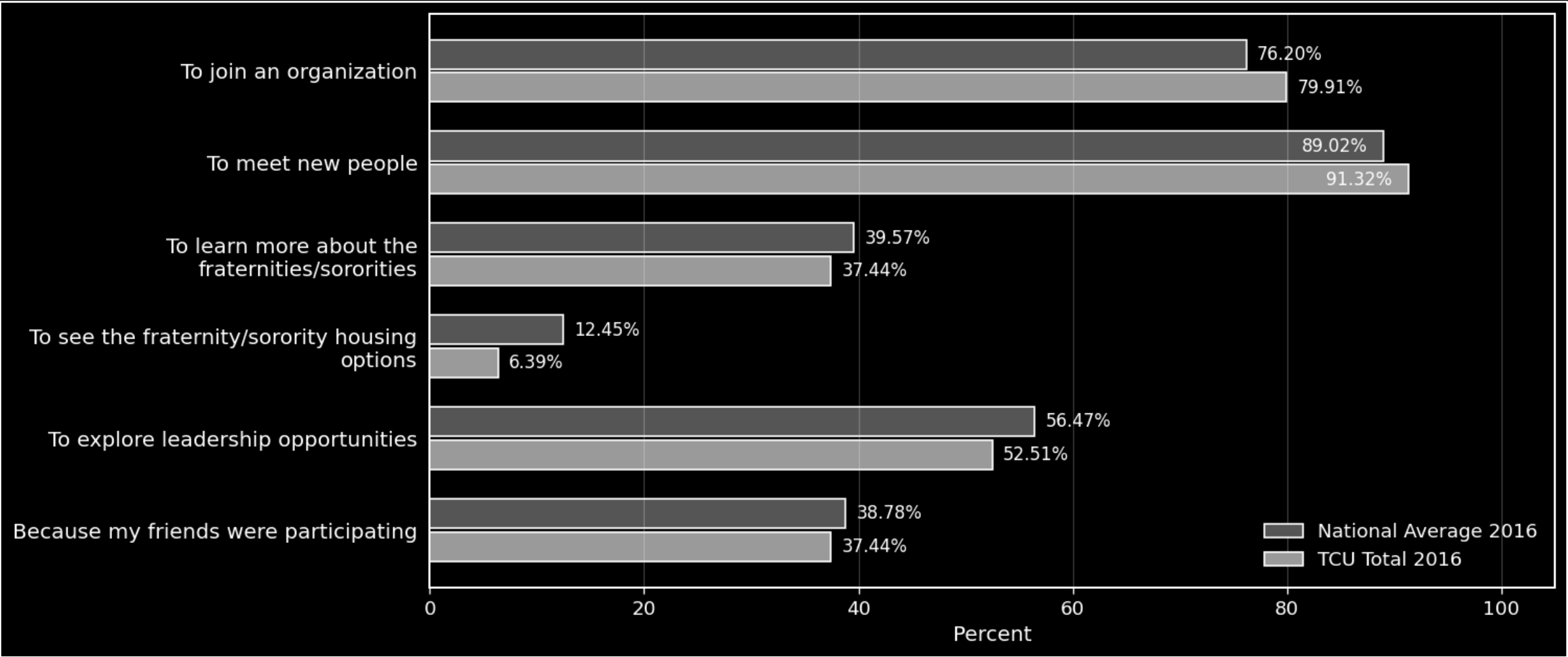


Chart 9. For which of the following reasons did you participate in recruitment/intake? (Check all that apply) (Part 2 of 2)

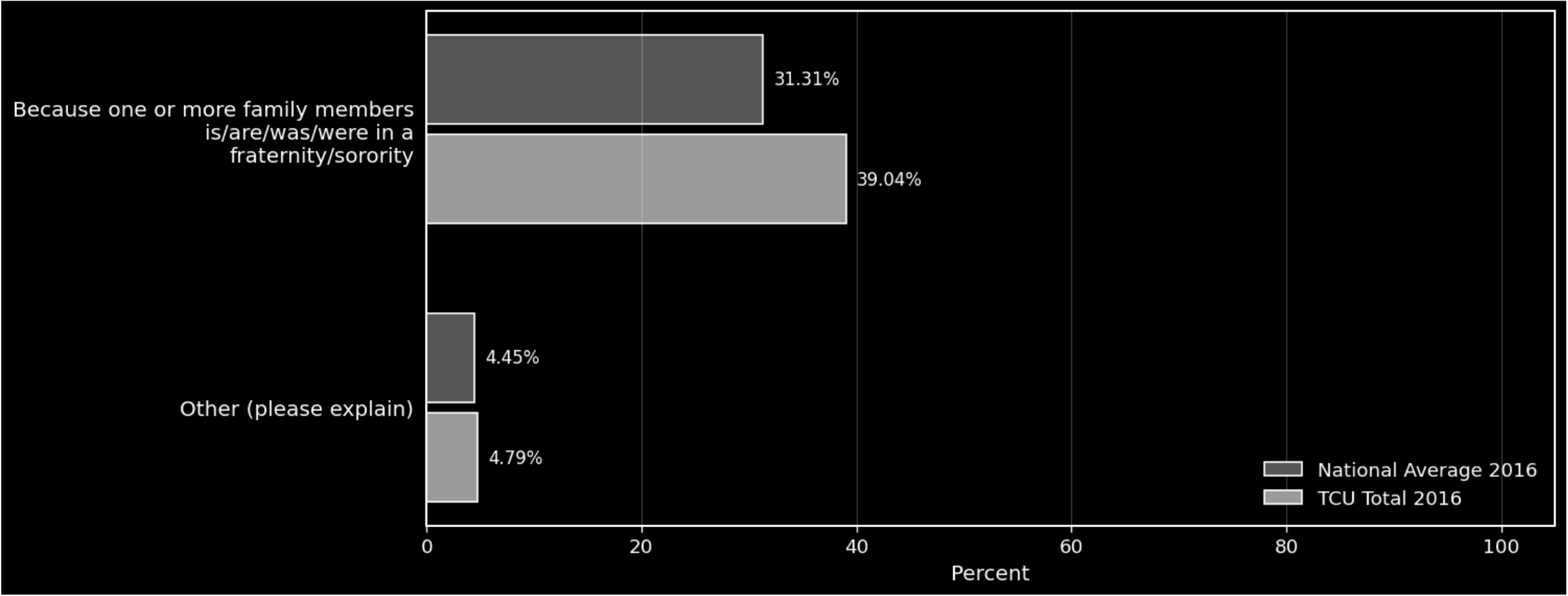


Chart 10. Please indicate your academic classification for the most recent time you participated in recruitment/intake activities:

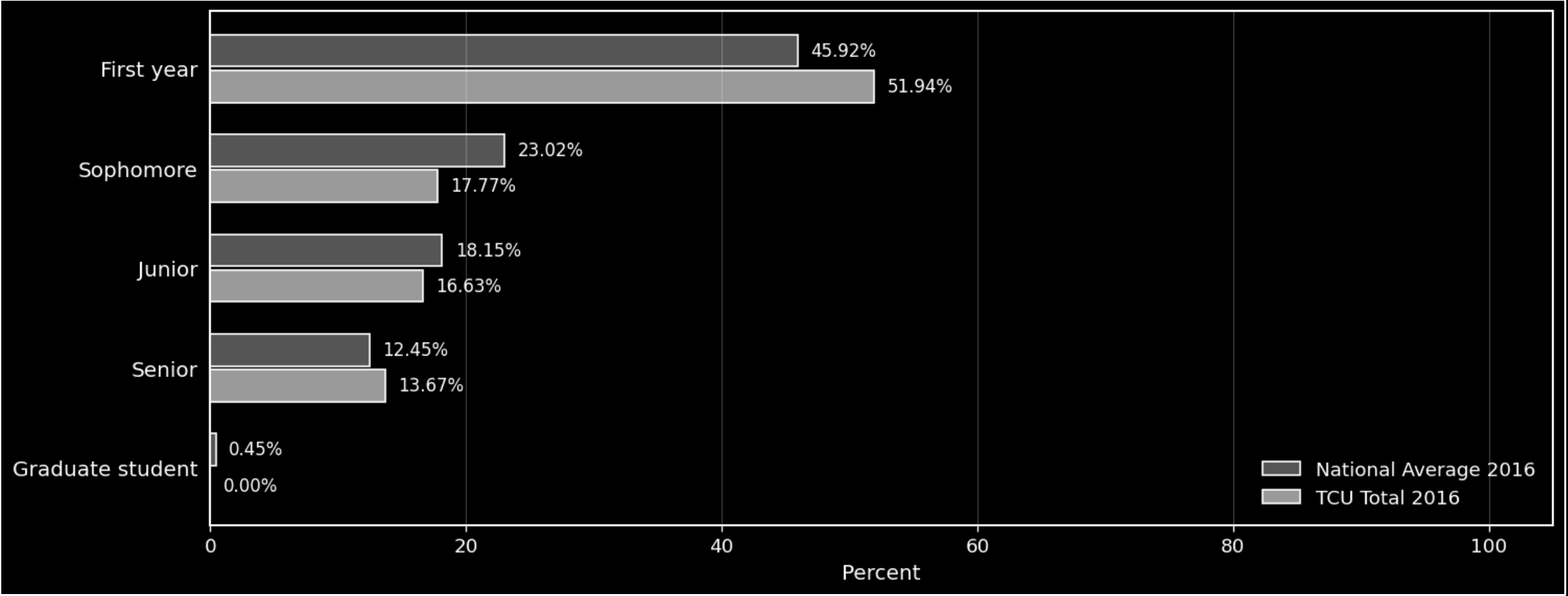

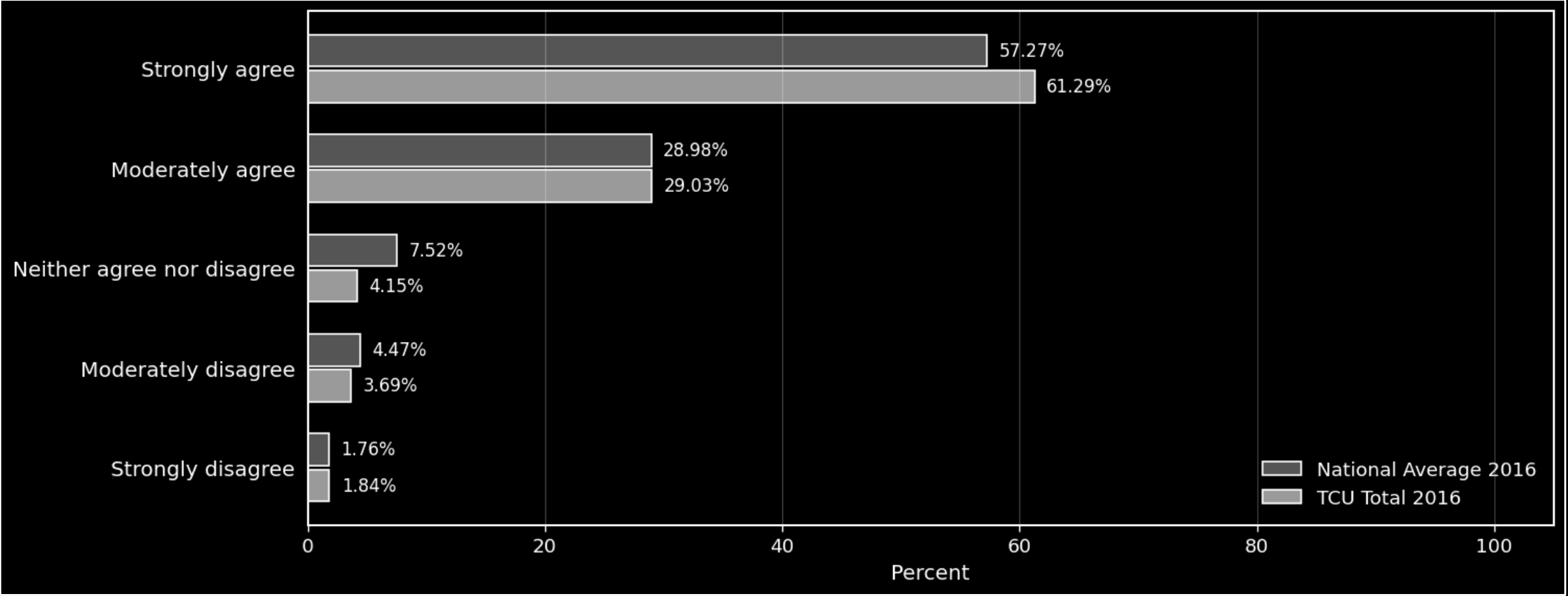

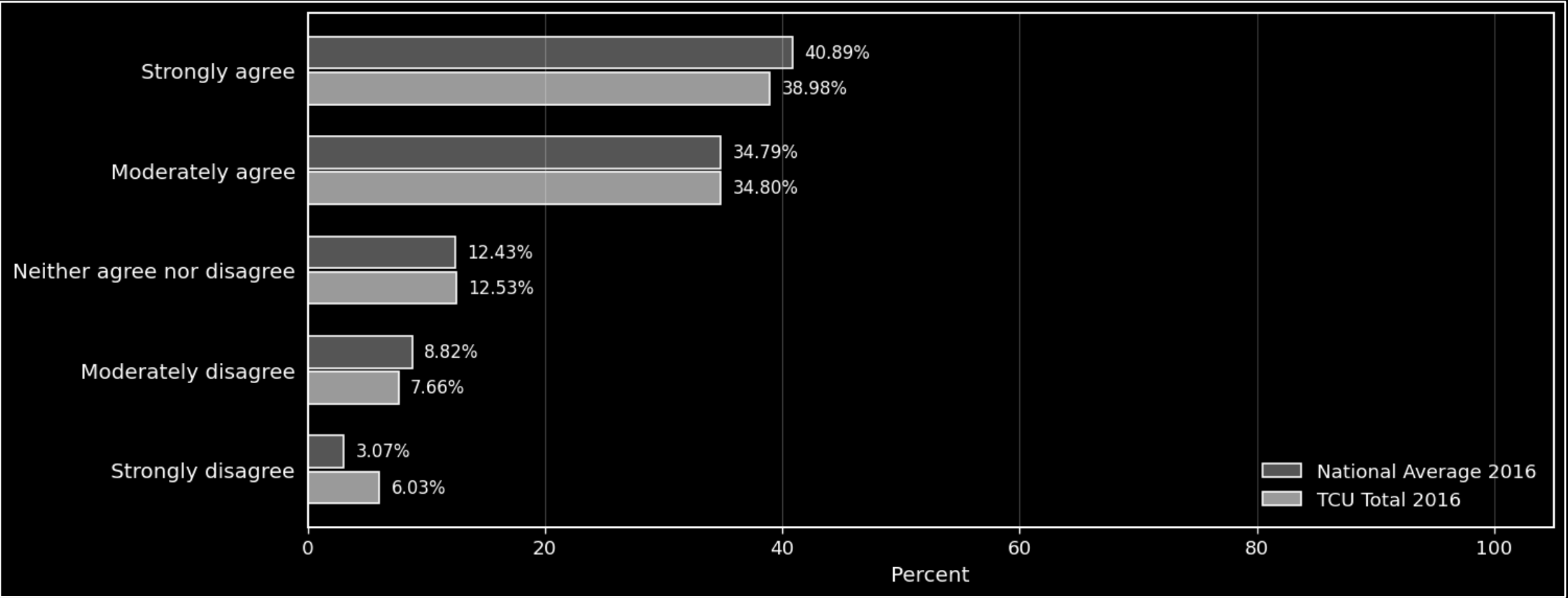

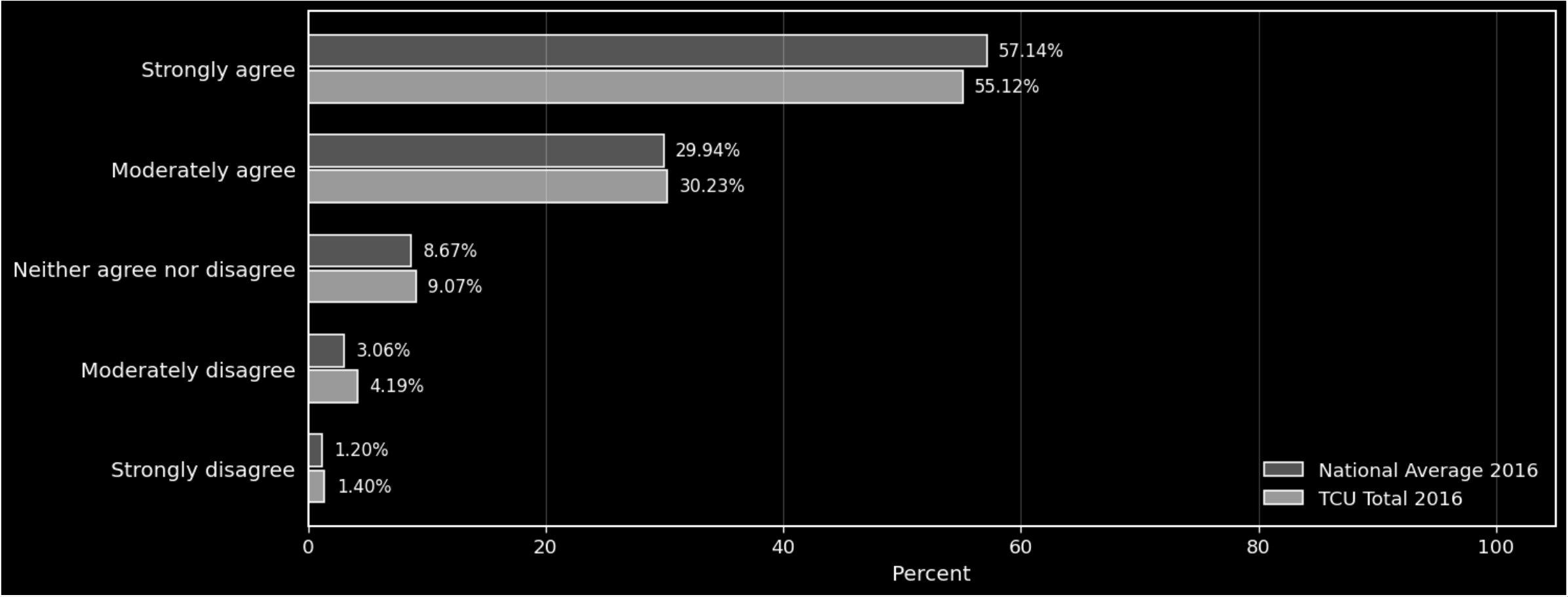

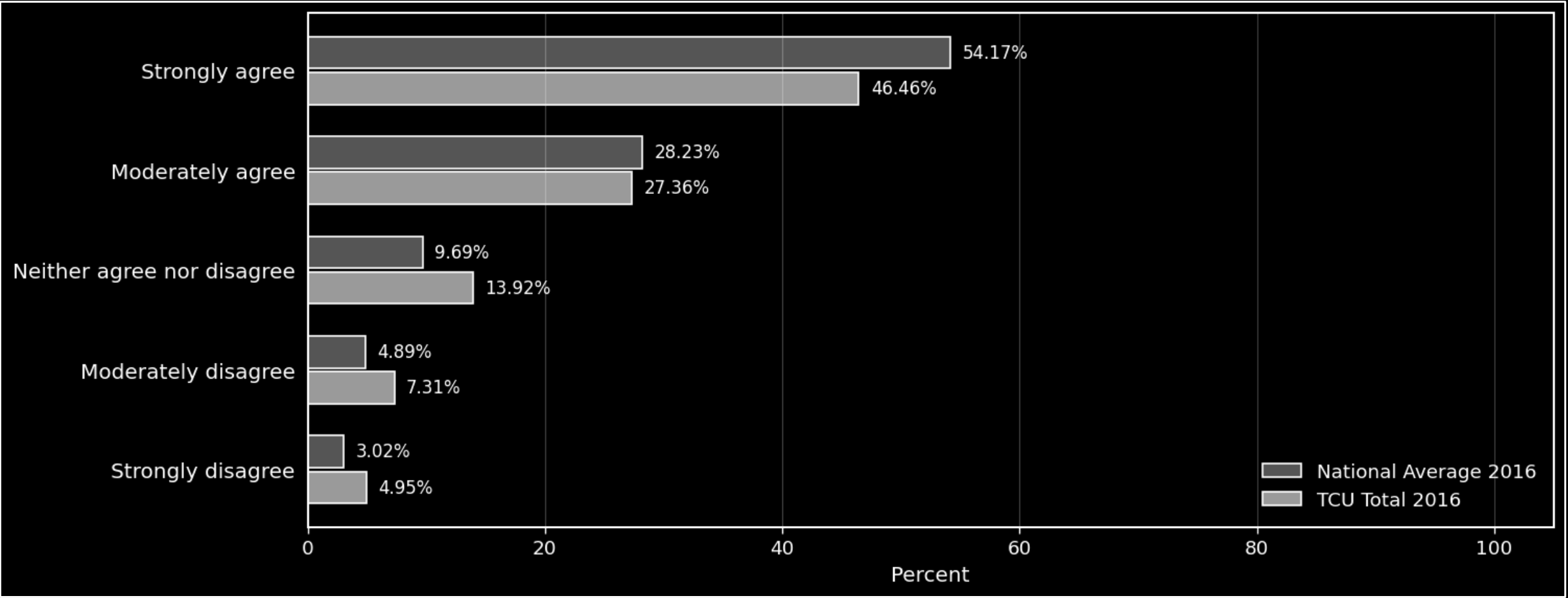

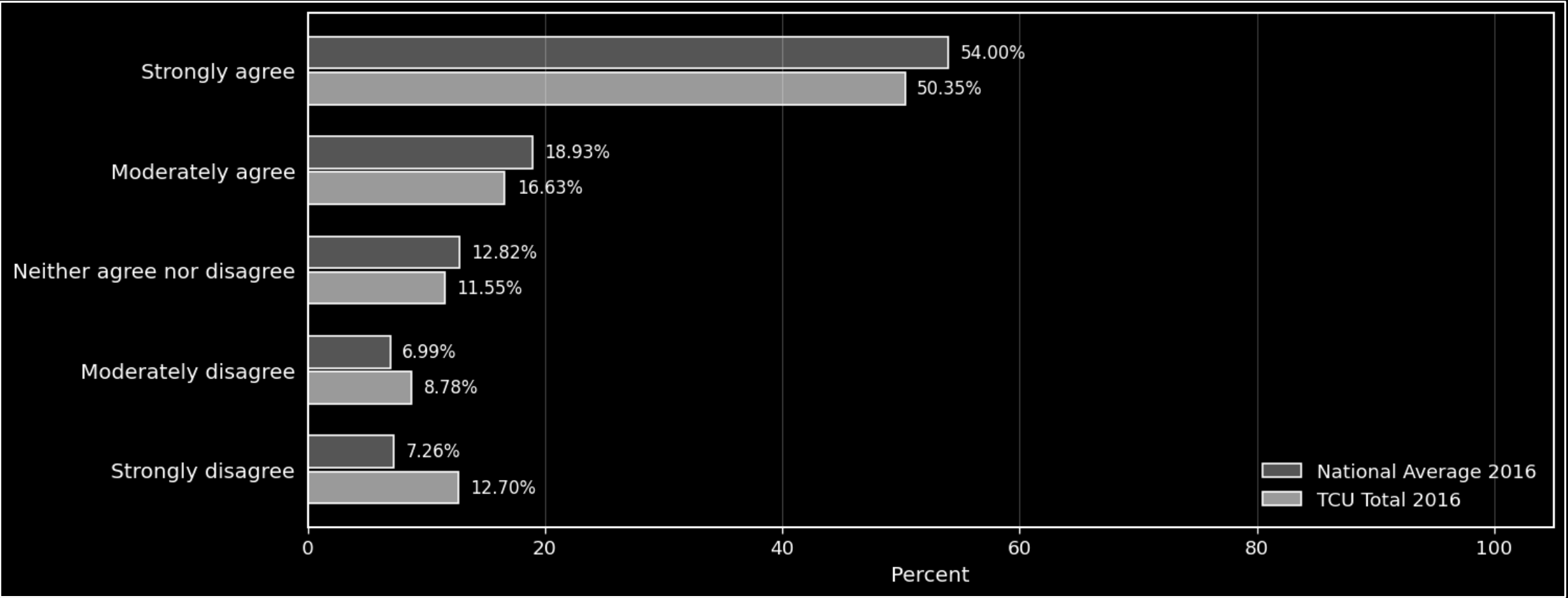


Chart 16. How would you say your participation in recruitment/intake impacted your impression of fraternities and sororities on this campus? -0.24* 1.15

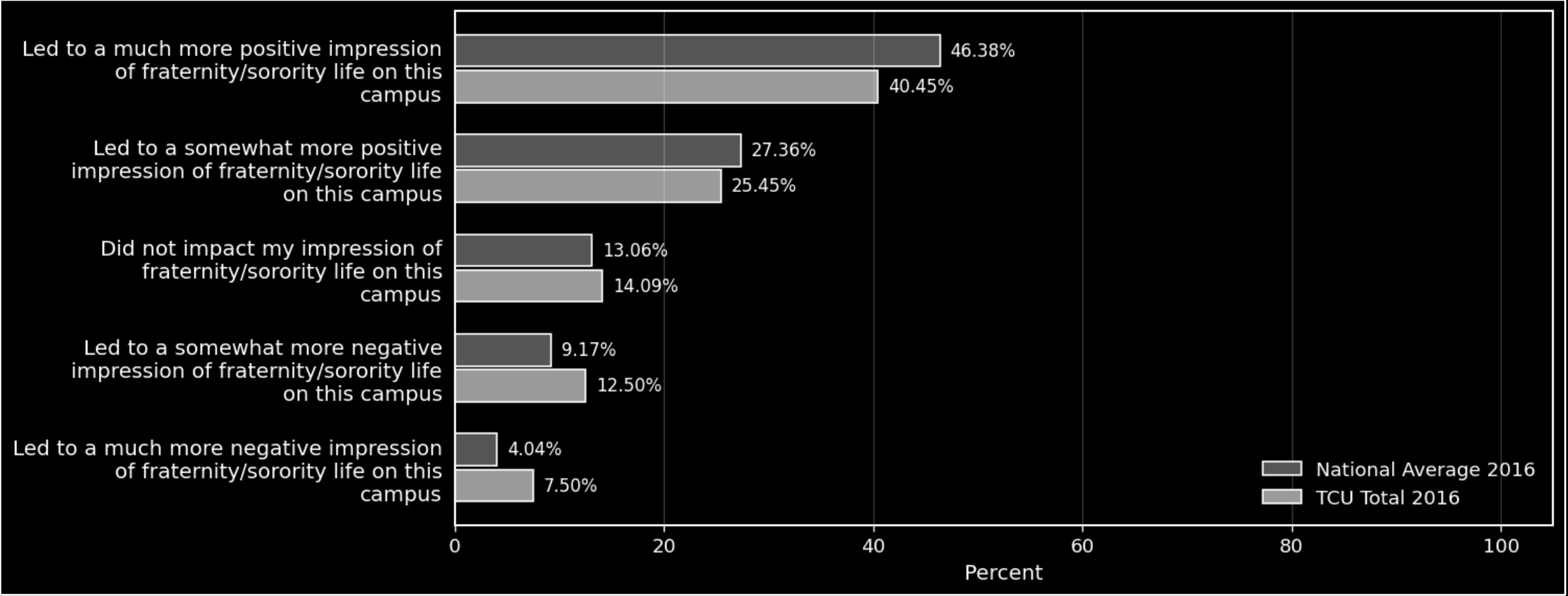


Chart 17. Did you receive a bid or invitation to join a fraternity/sorority as a result of participating in recruitment/intake activities?

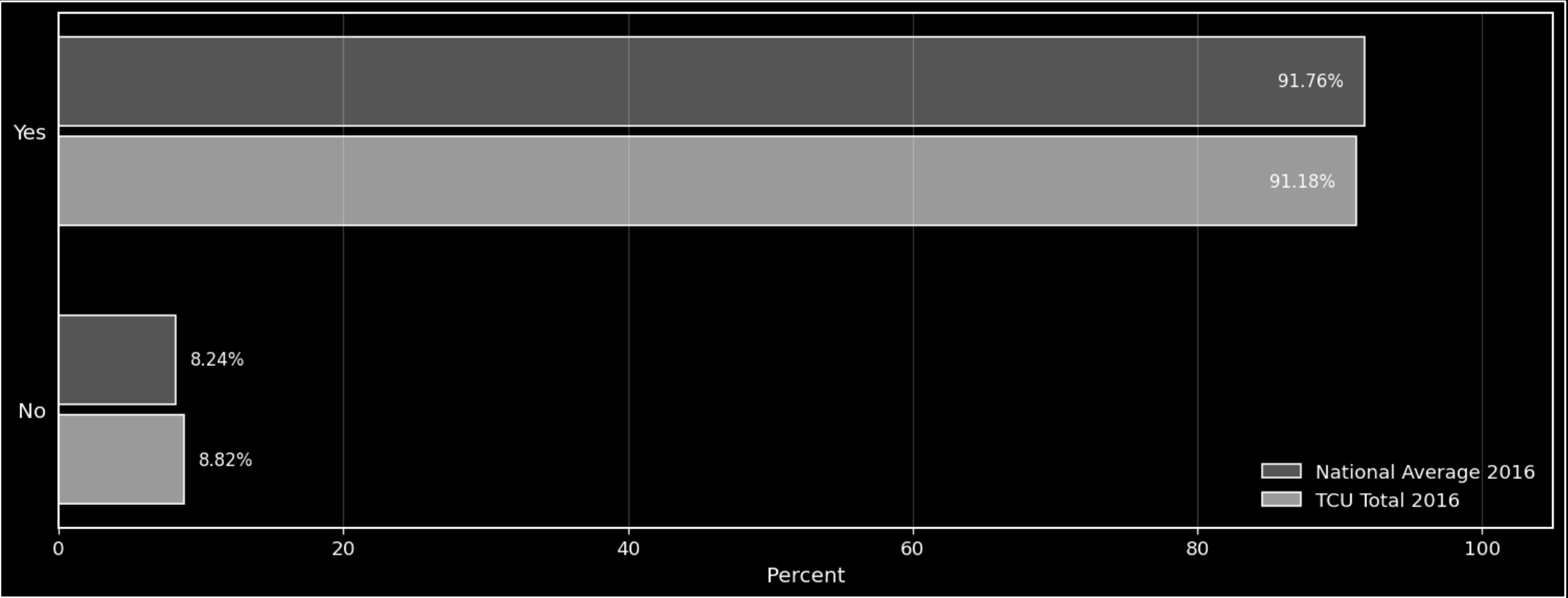


Chart 18. Did you choose to stop pursuing membership in a fraternity/sorority or withdraw from the recruitment/intake process at any time?

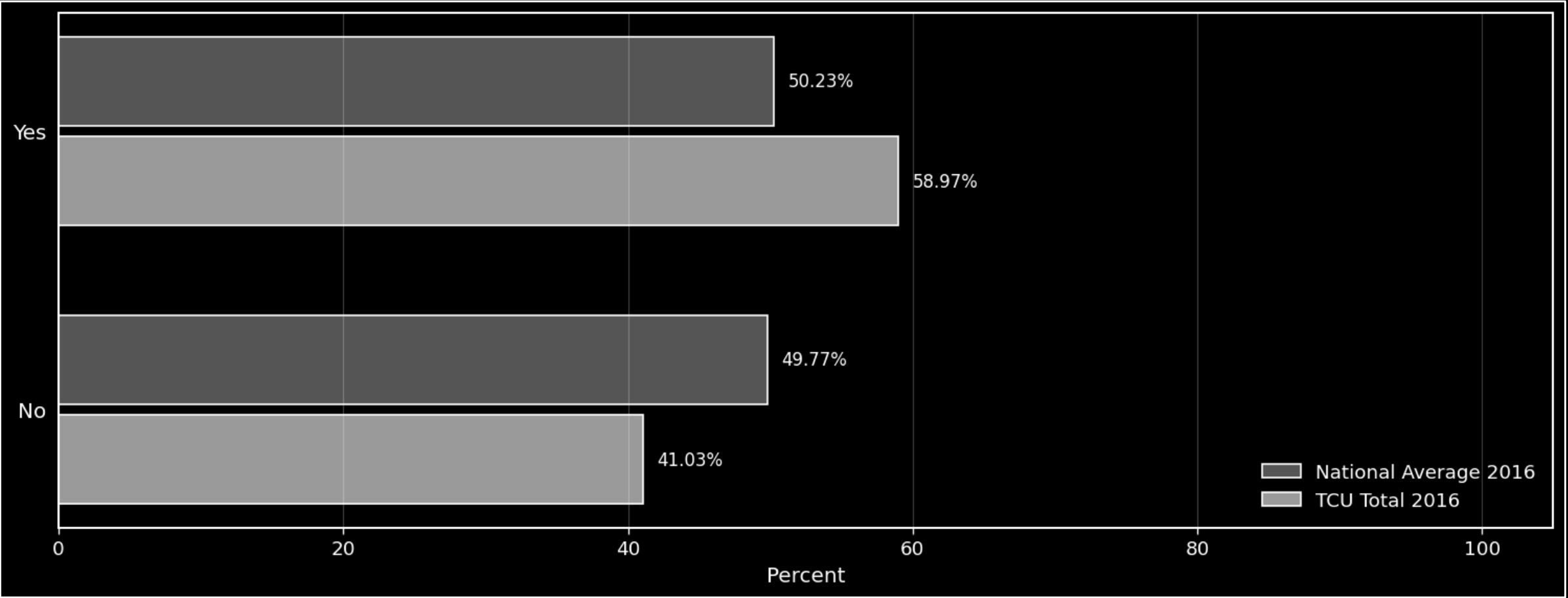


Chart 19. For what reason(s) did you choose not to finish pursuing fraternity/sorority membership? (Check all that apply) (Part 1 of 2)

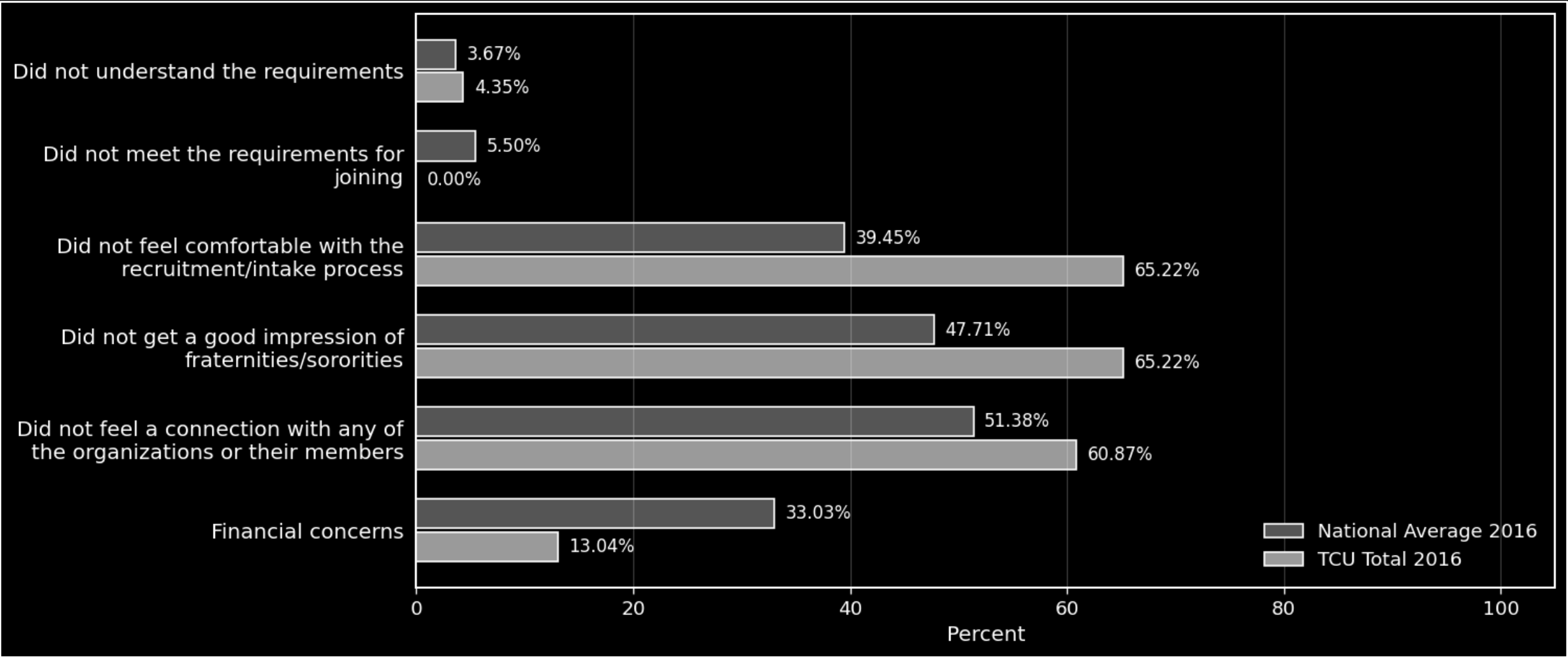


Chart 19. For what reason(s) did you choose not to finish pursuing fraternity/sorority membership? (Check all that apply) (Part 2 of 2)

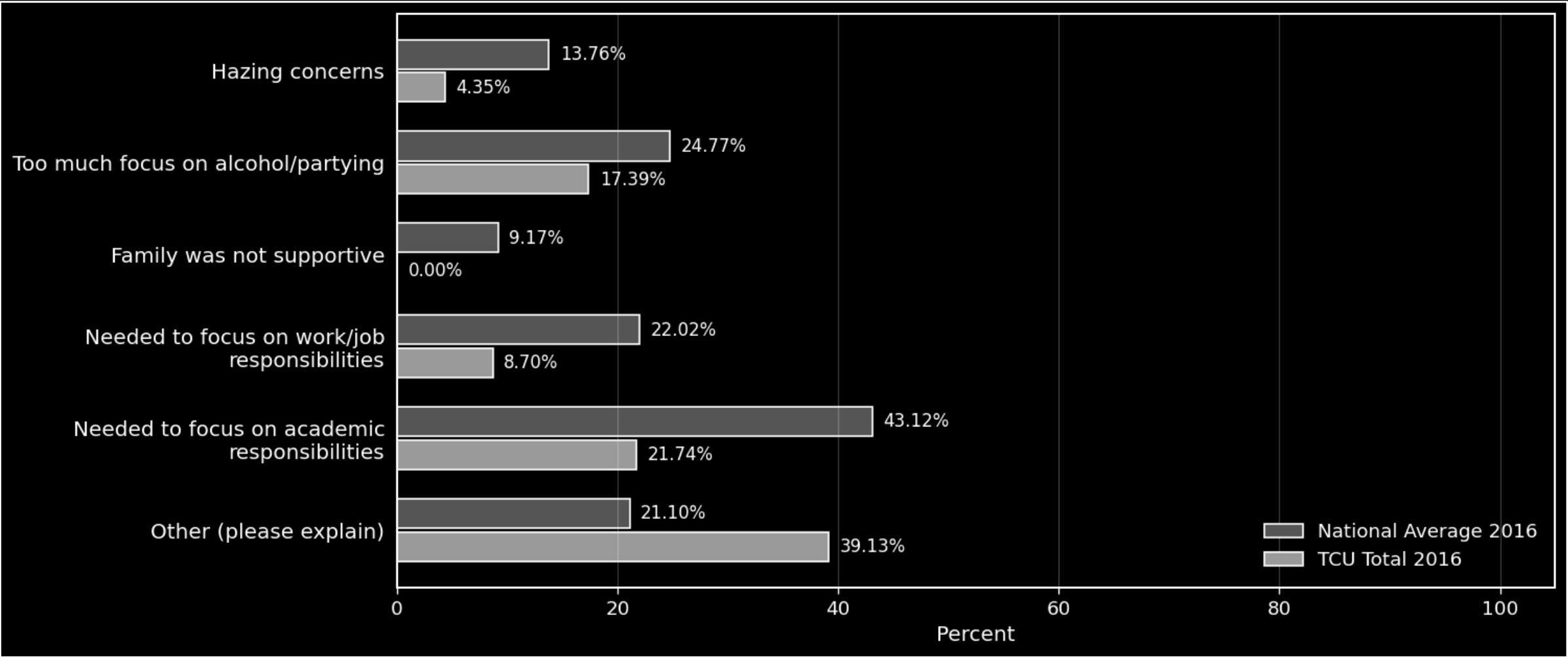

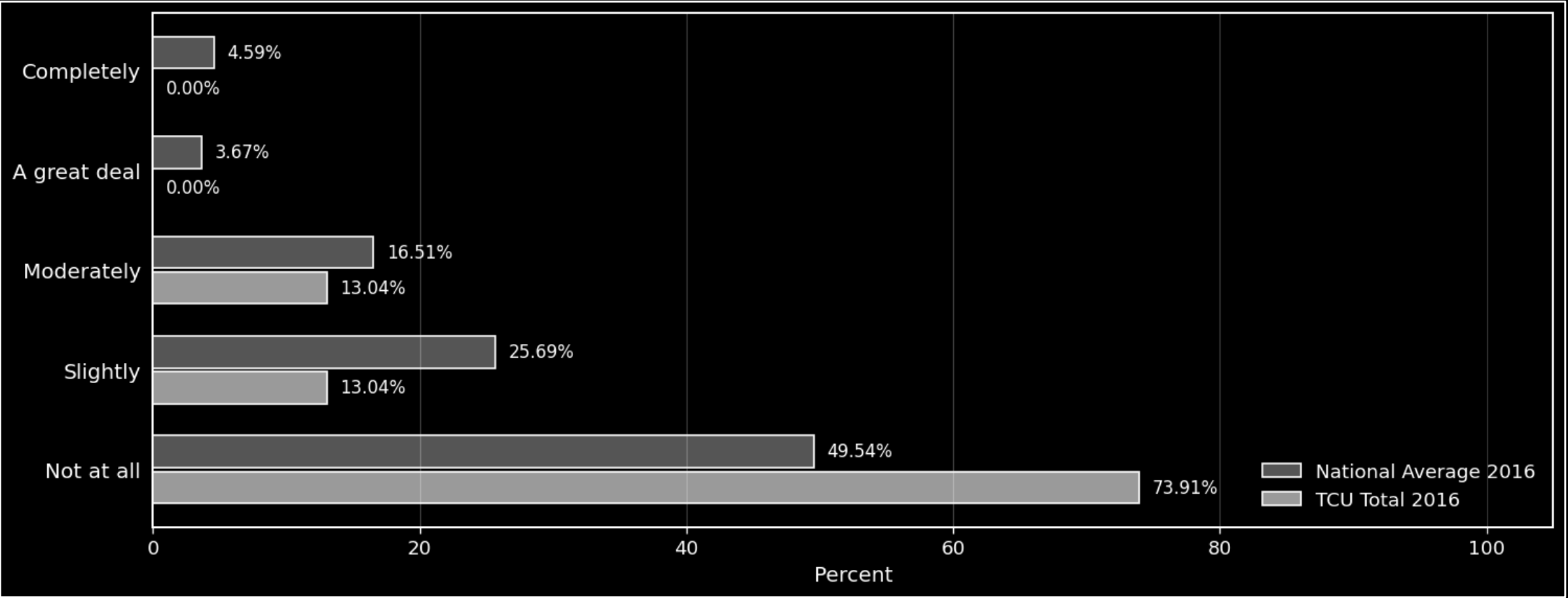


Chart 21. Did you accept a bid or invitation to join a fraternity/sorority as a result of participating in recruitment/intake activities?

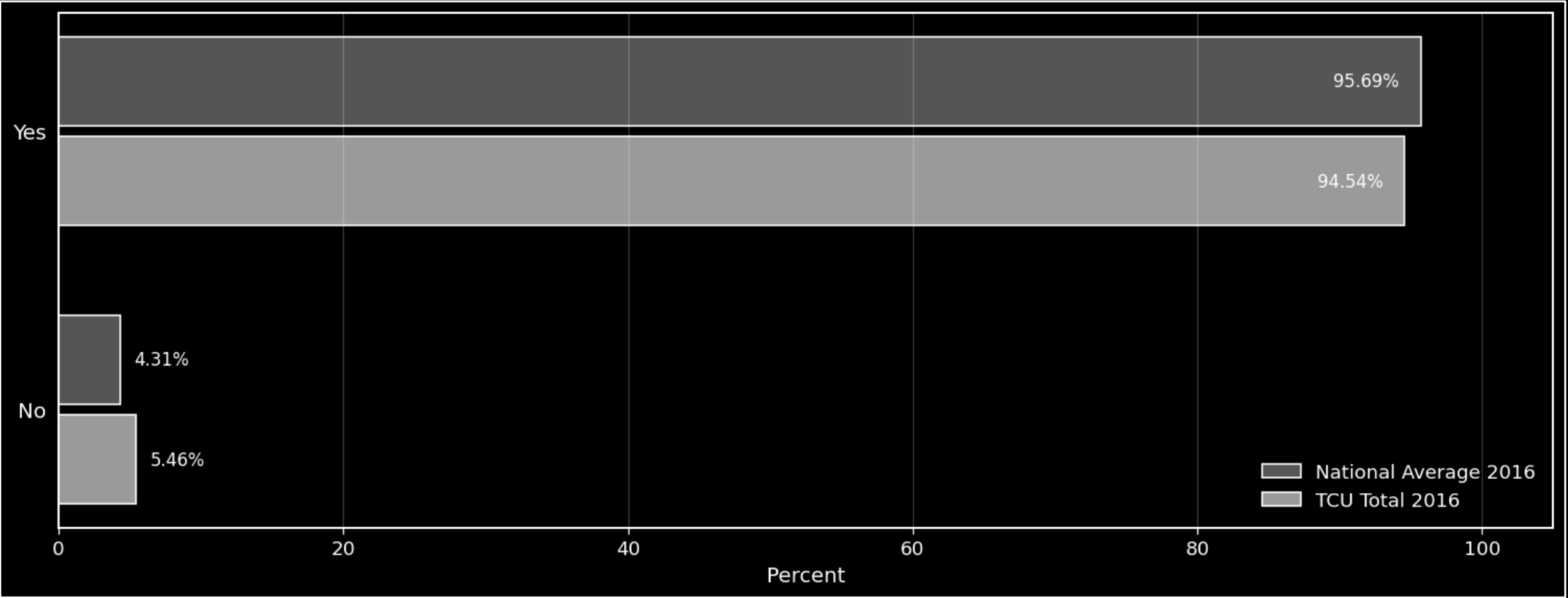


Chart 22. How confident were you in your decision to join a fraternity/sorority as a result of participating in recruitment/intake activities? 0.96 2274 74.27%

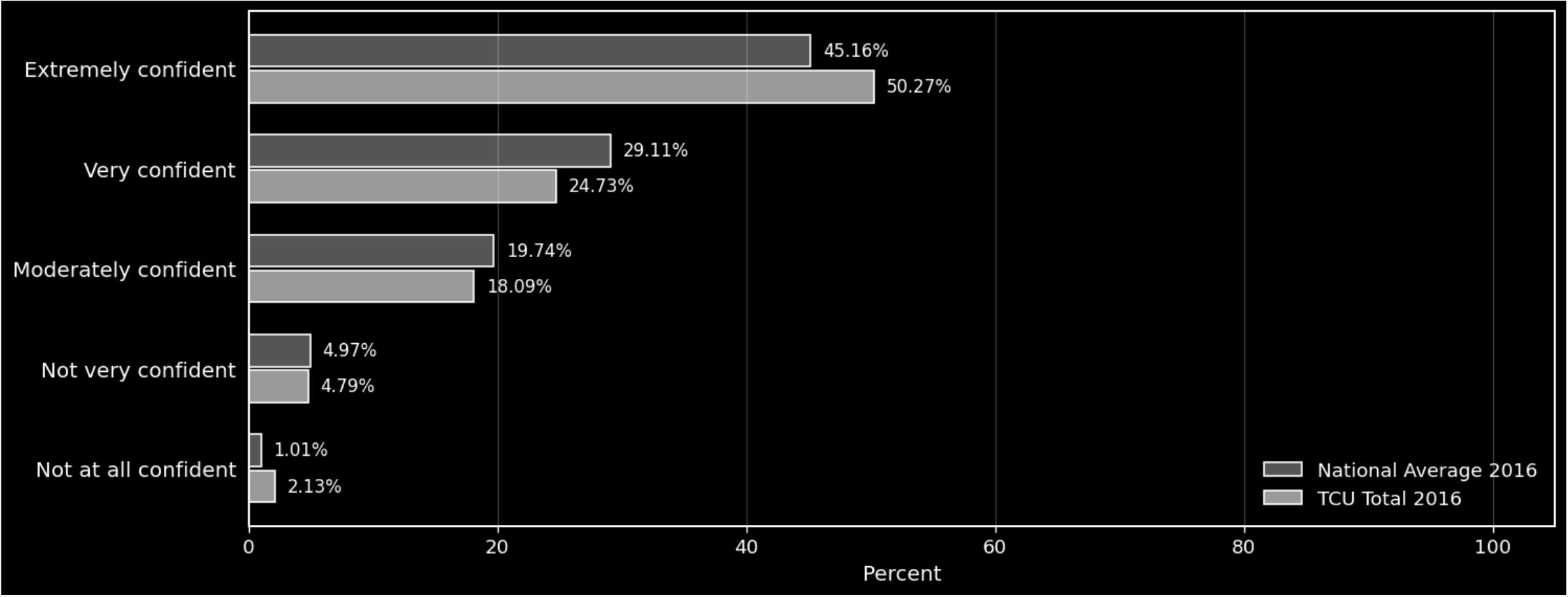


Chart 23. Did you have any reservations about joining a fraternity/sorority?

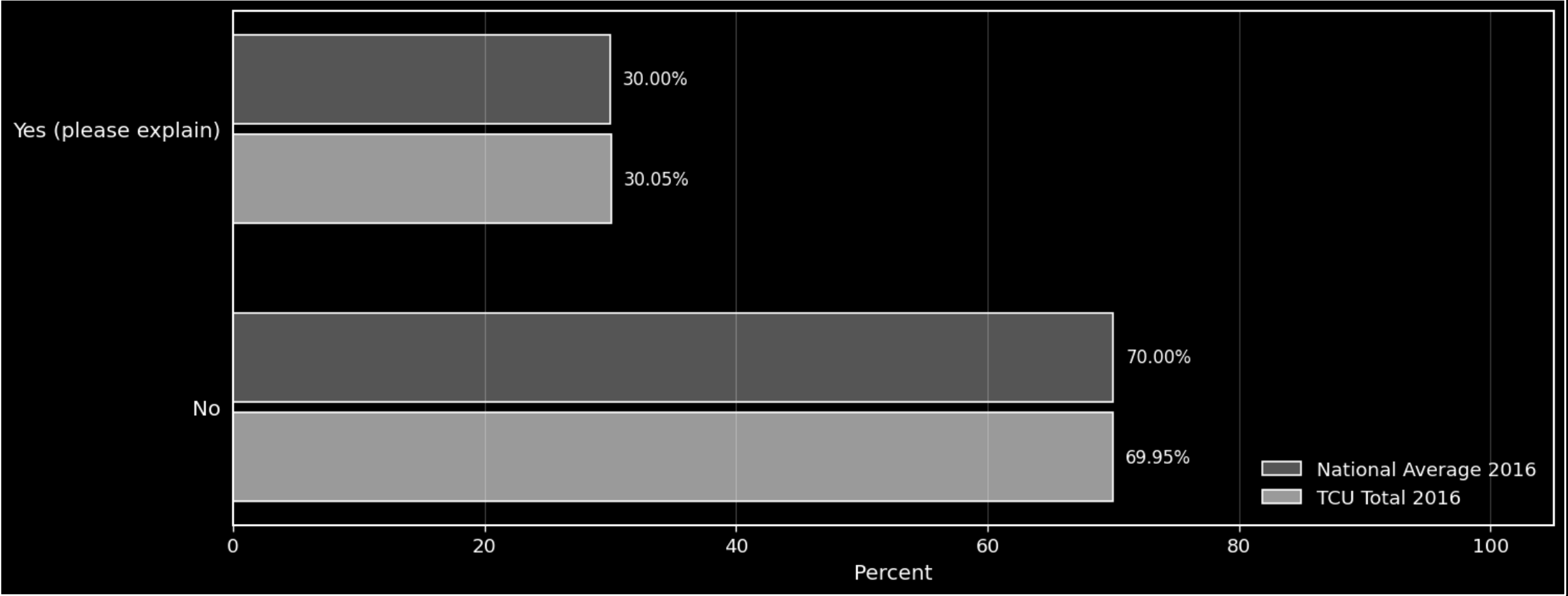


Chart 24. Which of the following are reasons why you chose to join a fraternity/sorority? (Check all that apply) (Part 1 of 2)

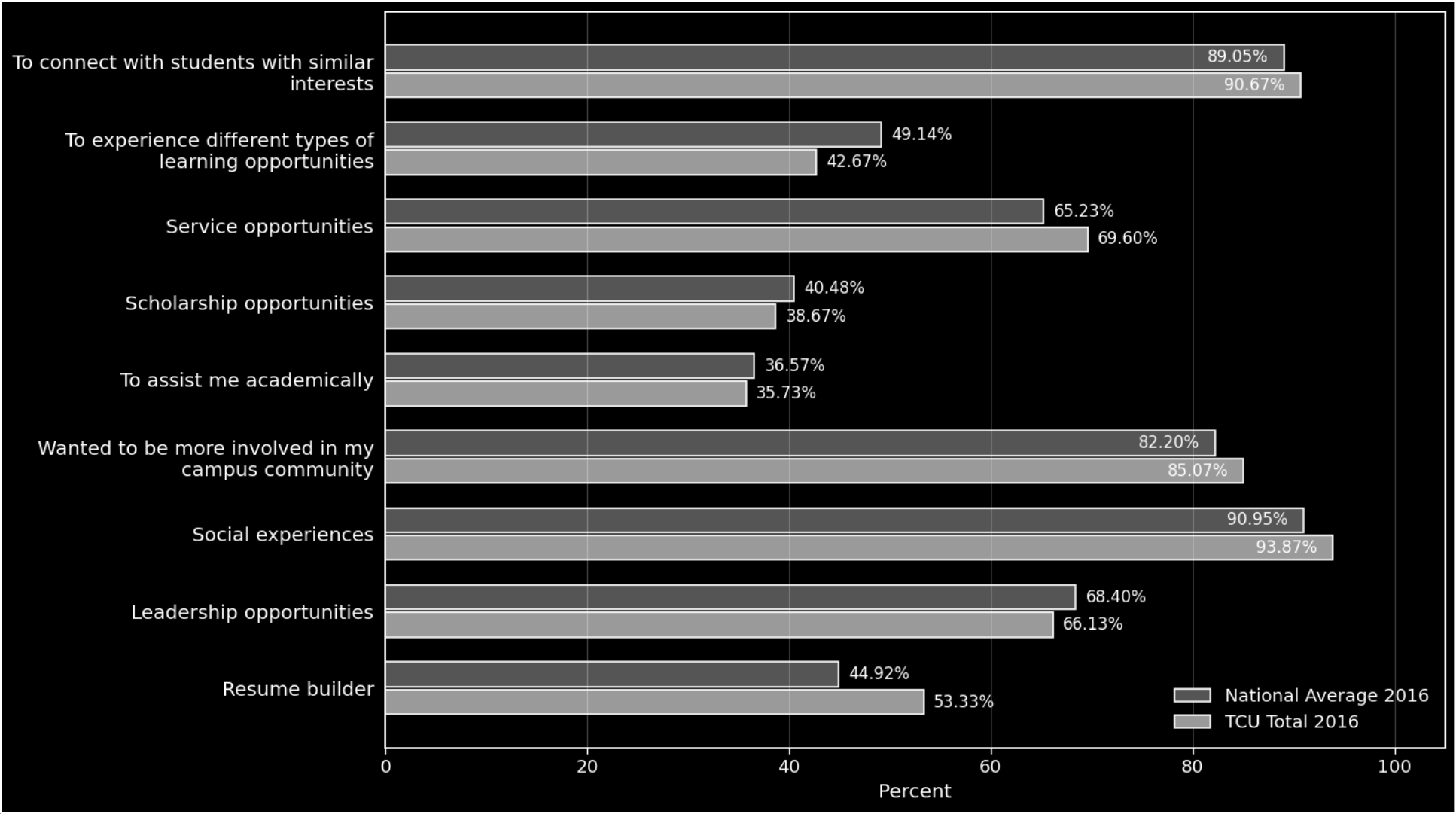


Chart 24. Which of the following are reasons why you chose to join a fraternity/sorority? (Check all that apply) (Part 2 of 2)

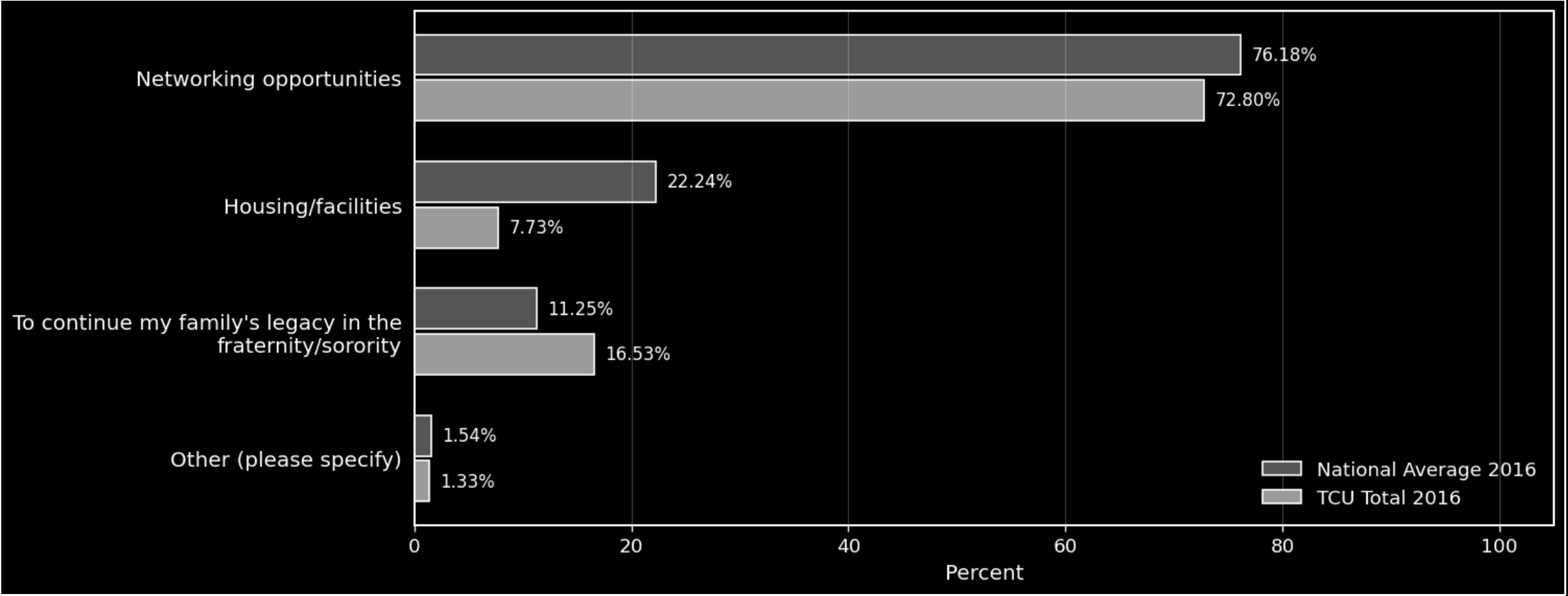


Chart 25. What is the number one reason you chose to join a fraternity/sorority? (Part 1 of 2)

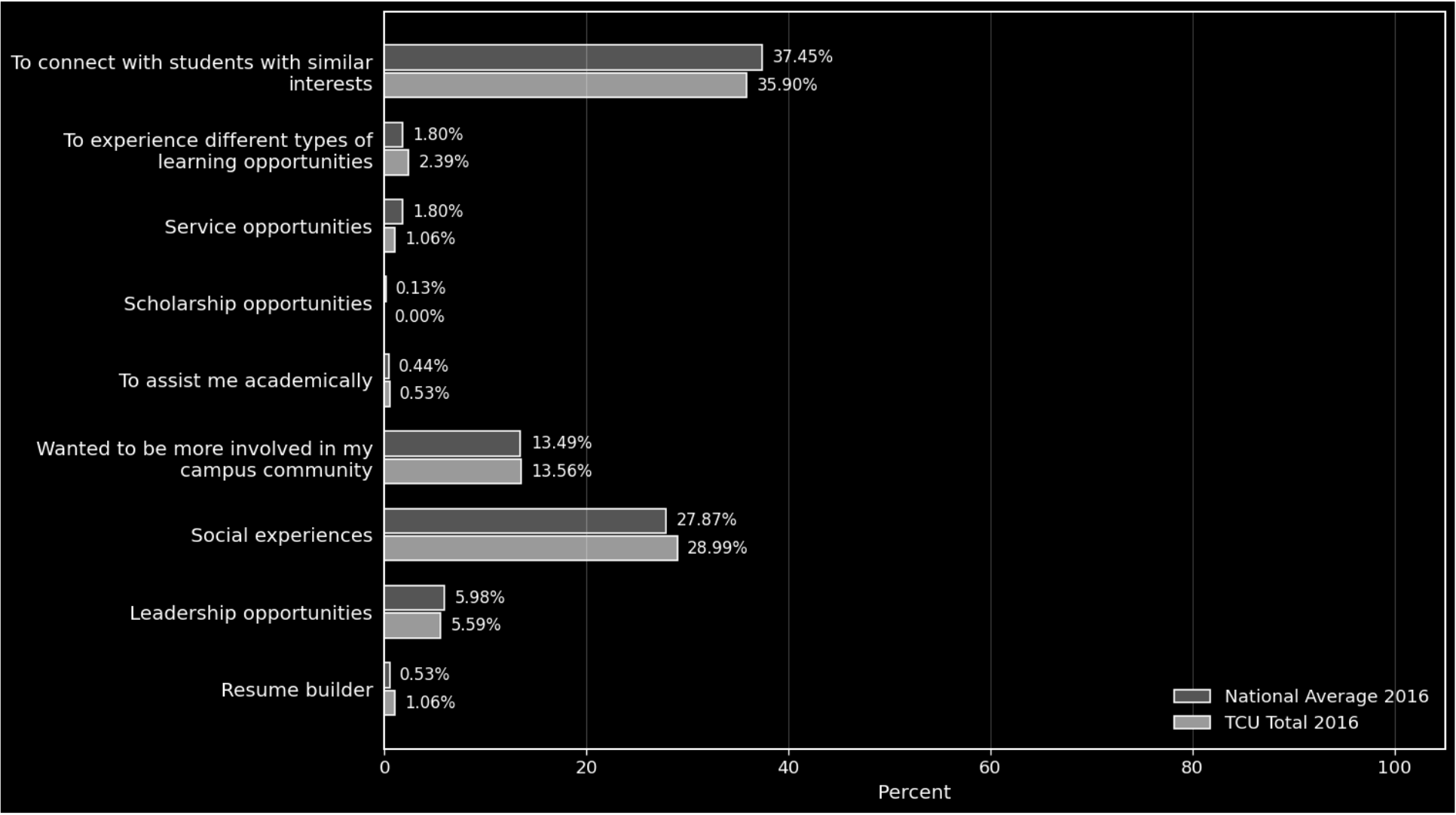


Chart 25. What is the number one reason you chose to join a fraternity/sorority? (Part 2 of 2)

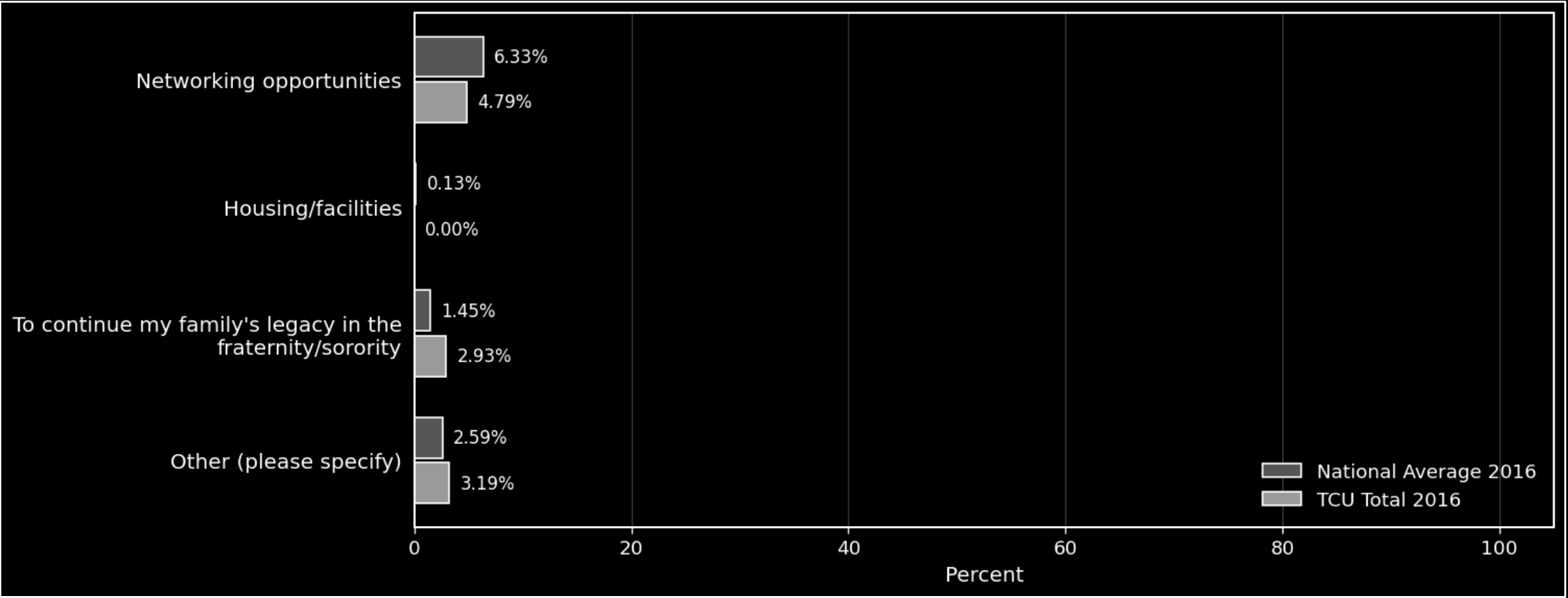


Chart 26. For which of the following reasons are you no longer affiliated with the fraternity/sorority you joined?

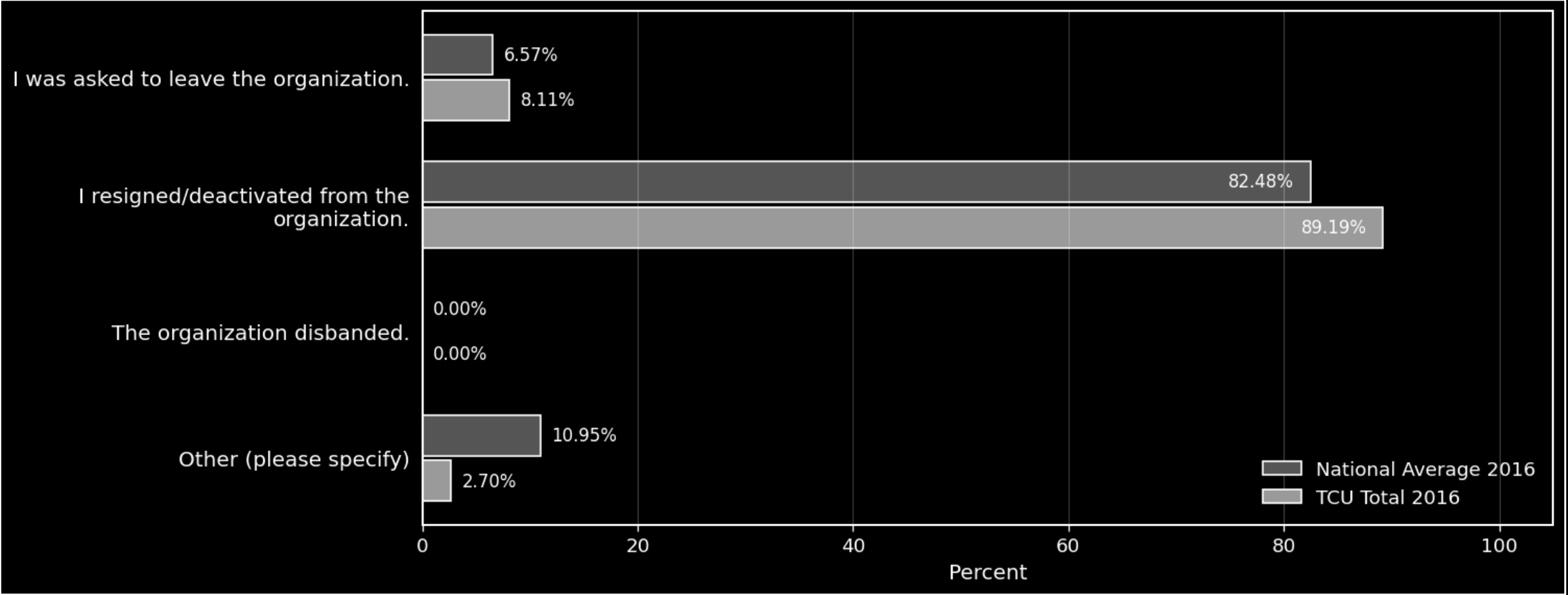


Chart 27. Were you an initiated member of the fraternity/sorority?

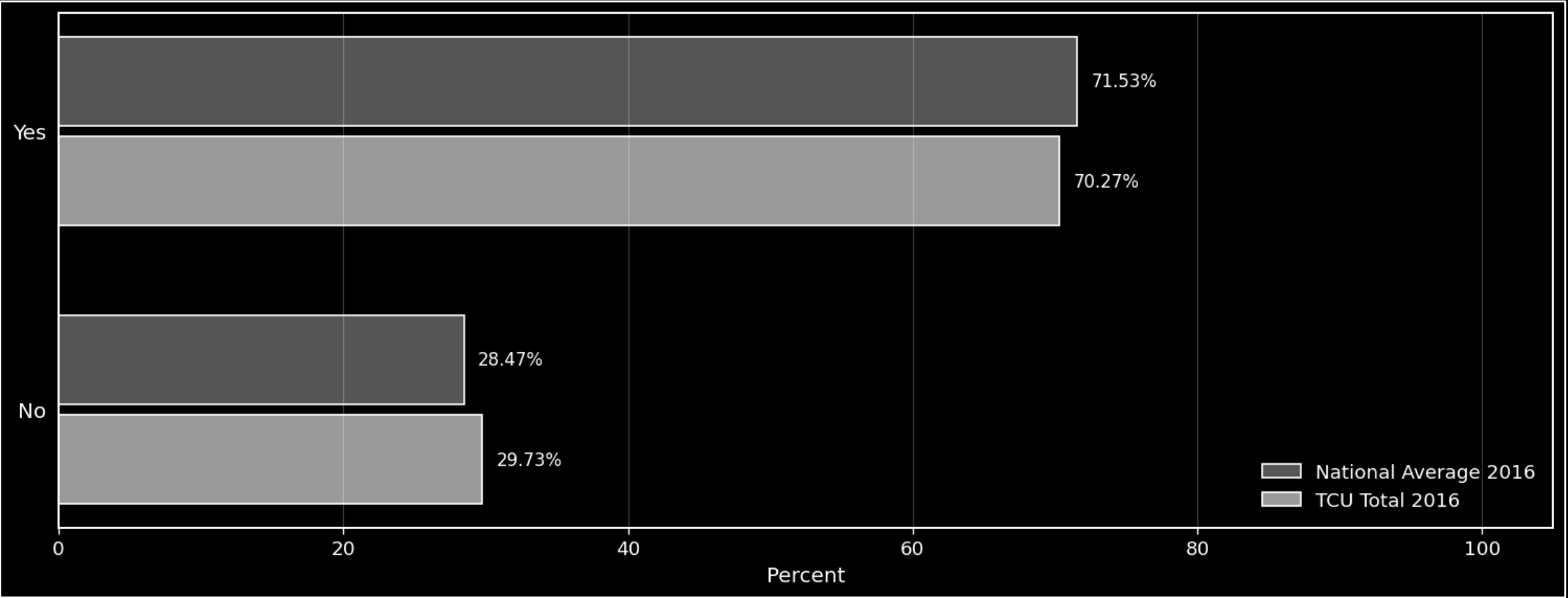


Chart 28. Did you hold any leadership positions during your membership?

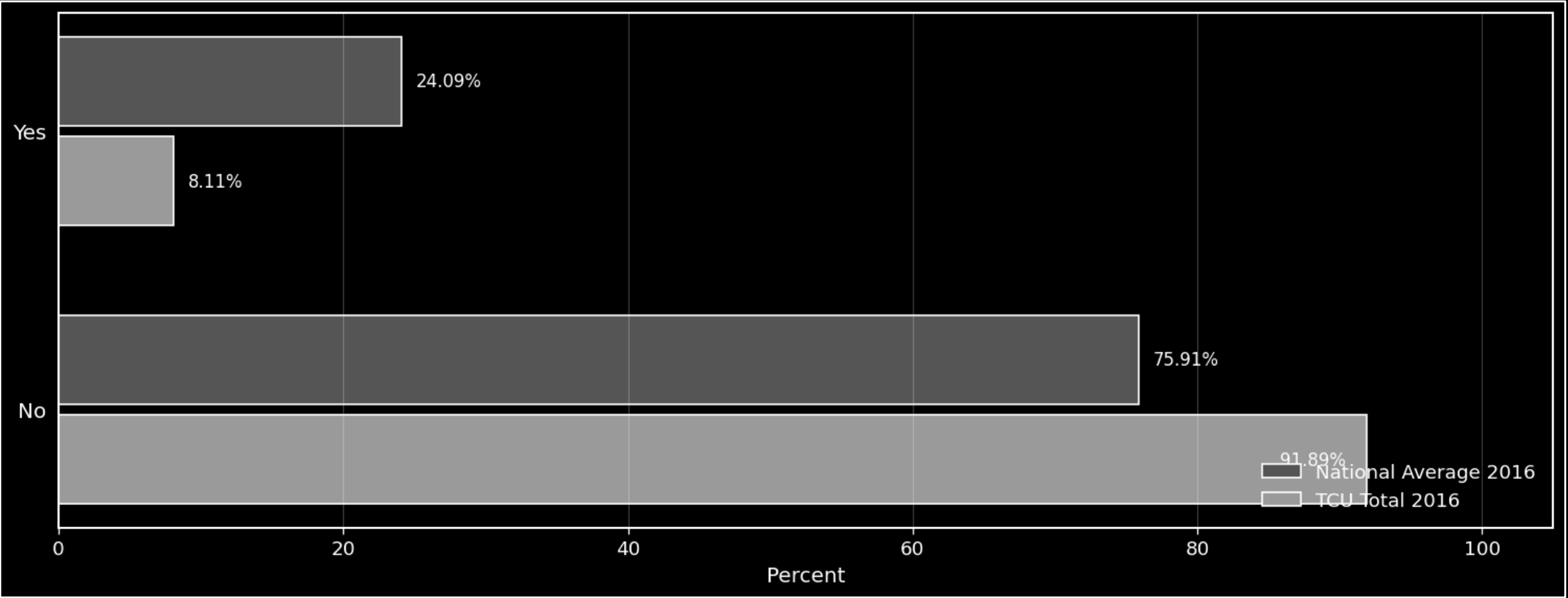


Chart 29. For which of the following reasons did you choose to leave your fraternity/sorority? (Check all that apply) (Part 1 of 2)

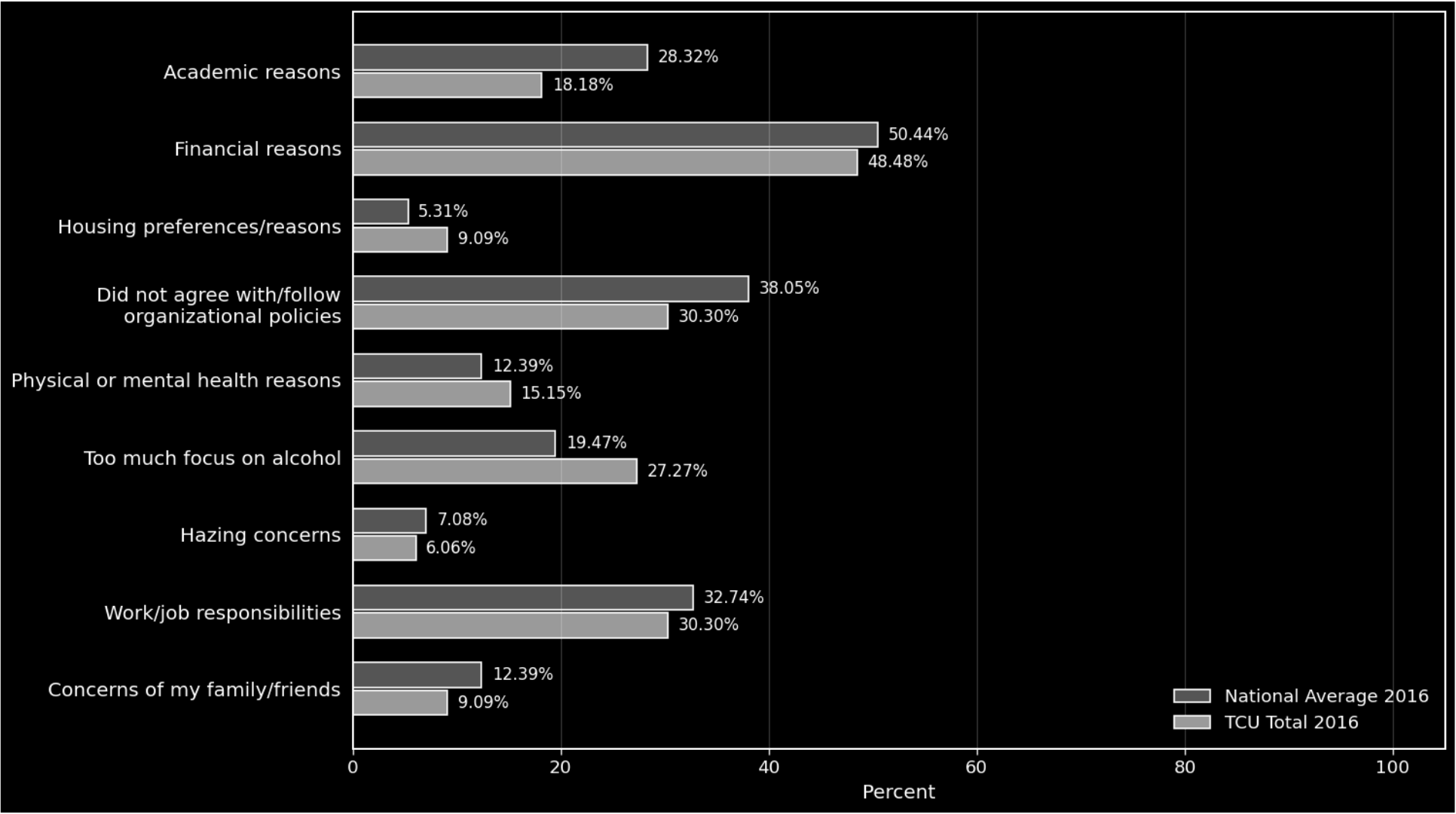


Chart 29. For which of the following reasons did you choose to leave your fraternity/sorority? (Check all that apply) (Part 2 of 2)

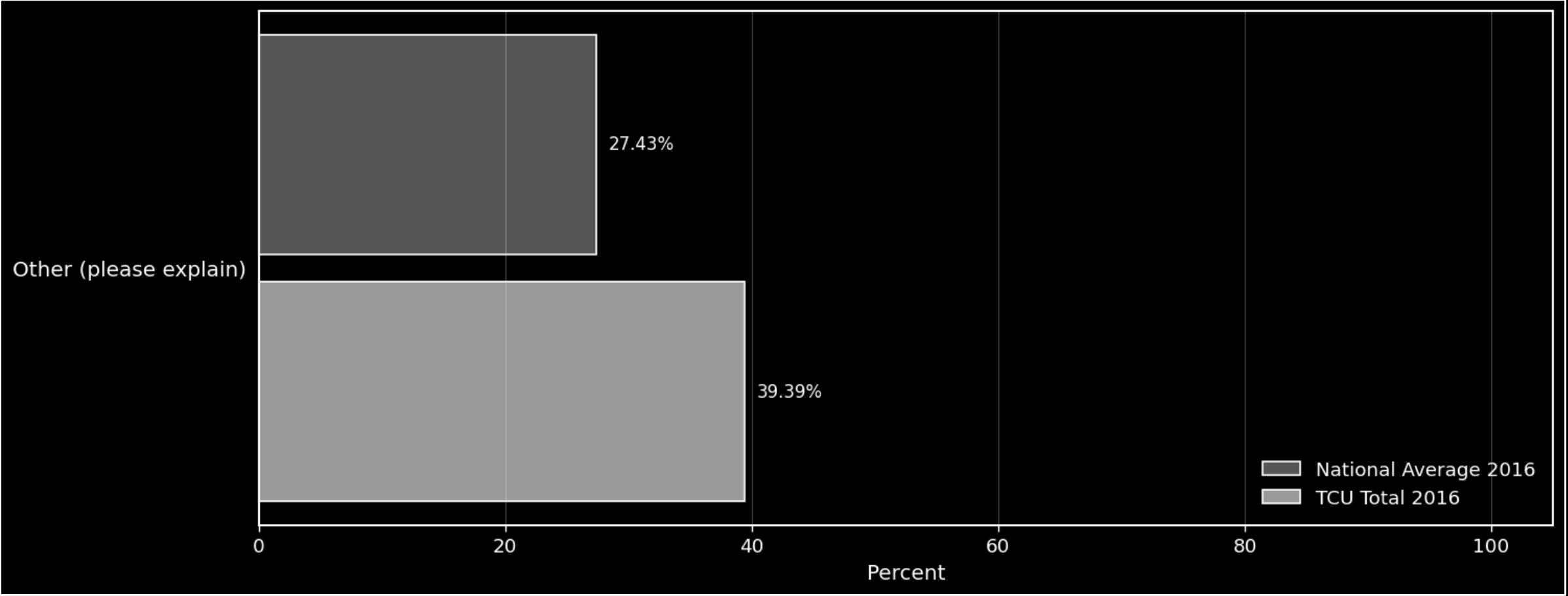


Chart 30. Approximately when did you depledge/deactivate/leave the organization? 1.46 112 43.75% 1.44 33 39.39%

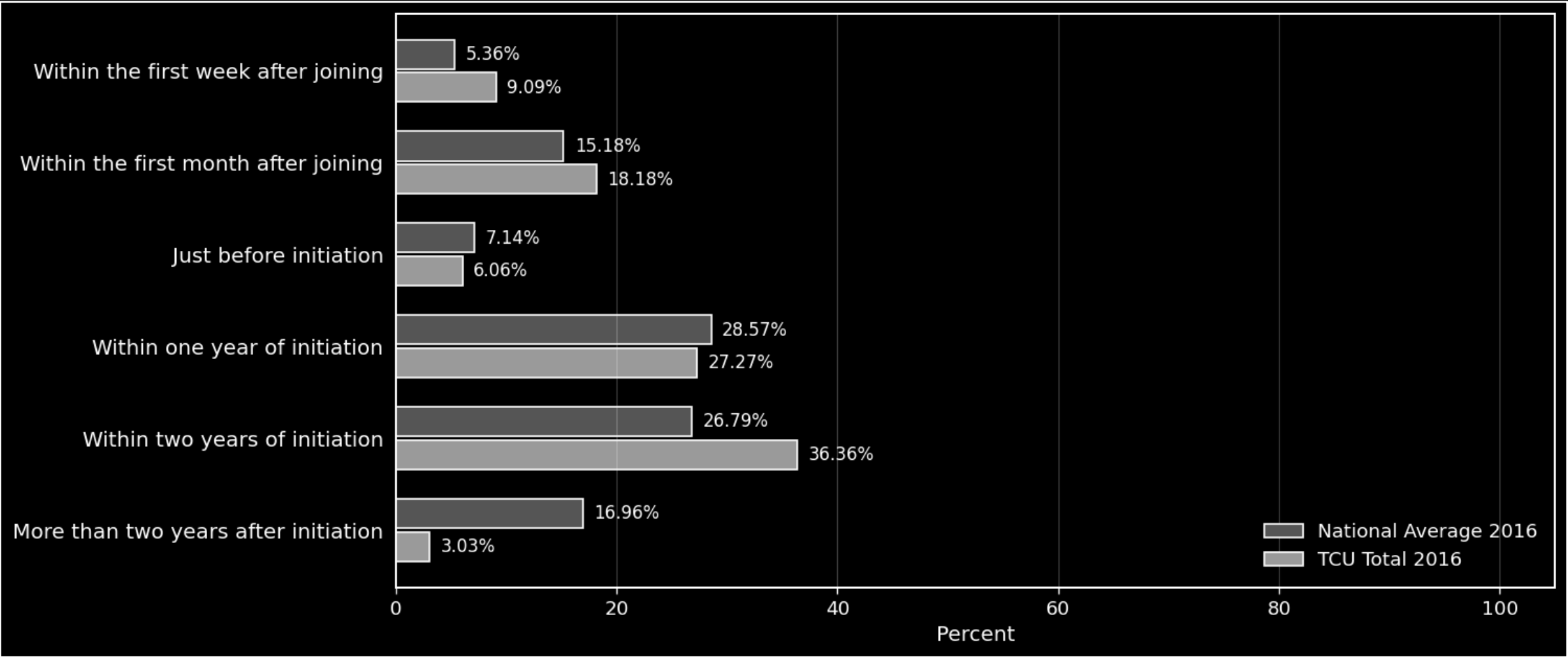


Chart 31. To what extent, if any, do you regret your decision to depledge/deactivate/leave the organization? 0.86 113 4.42% 0.90 33 6.06%

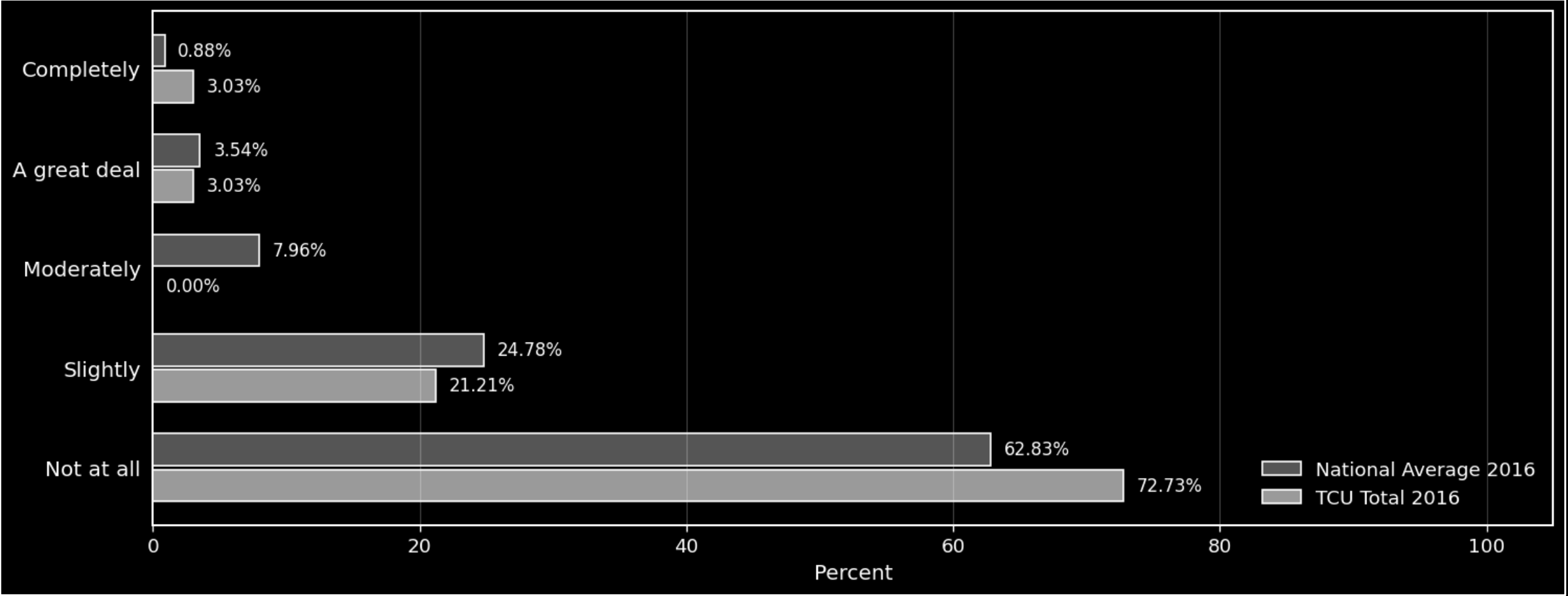


Chart 32. Do you still participate in any activities associated with your former chapter?

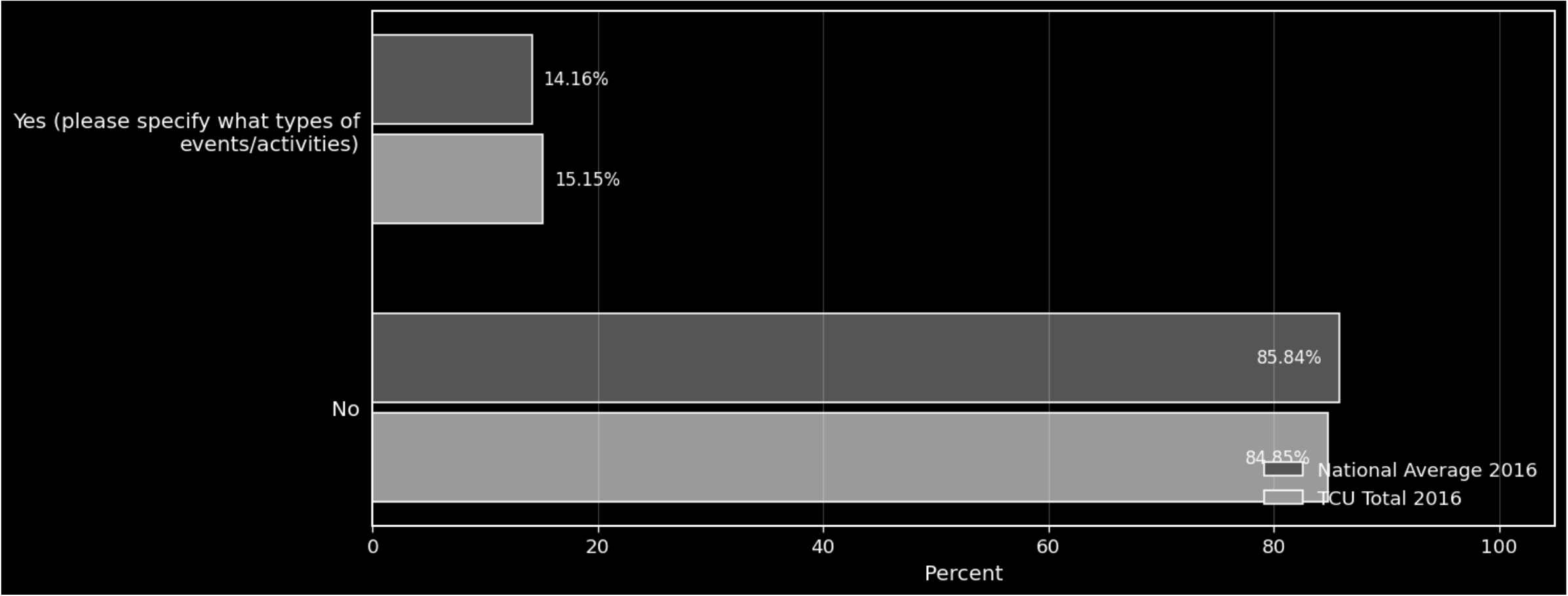


Chart 33. What was your class standing when you joined your fraternity/sorority?

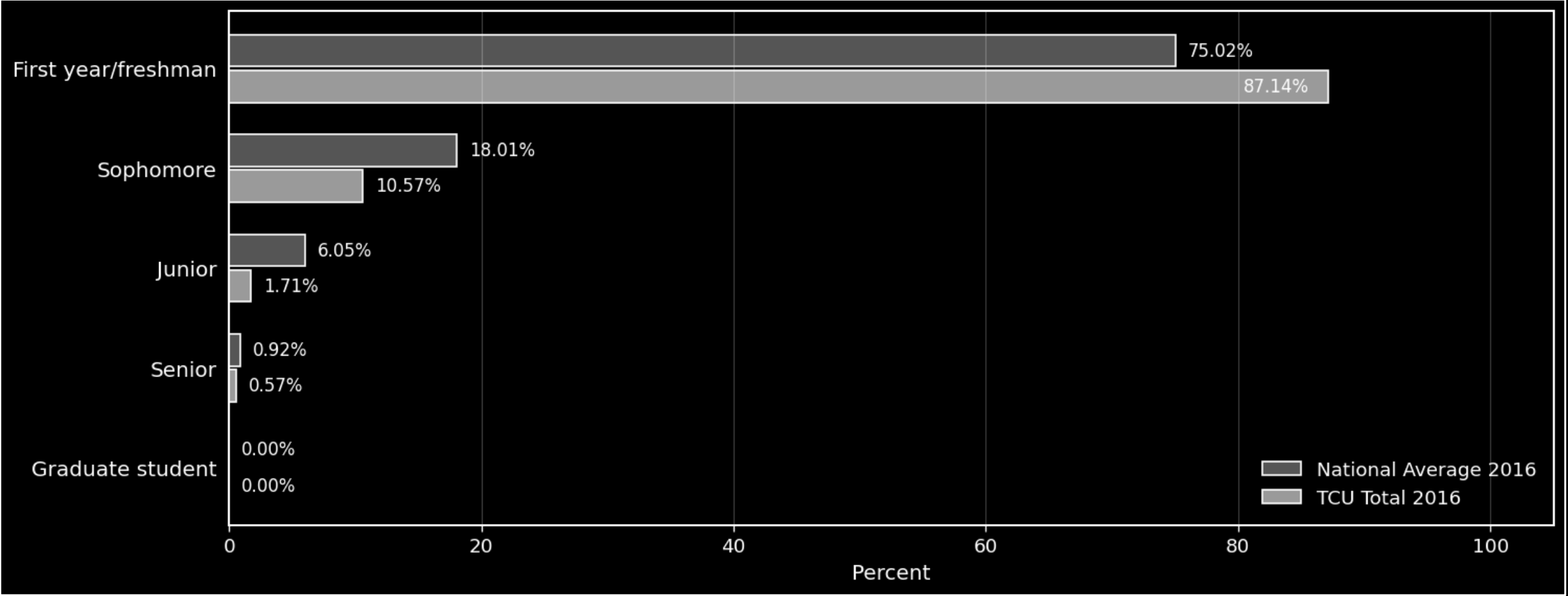


Chart 34. Have you been initiated into your fraternity/sorority?

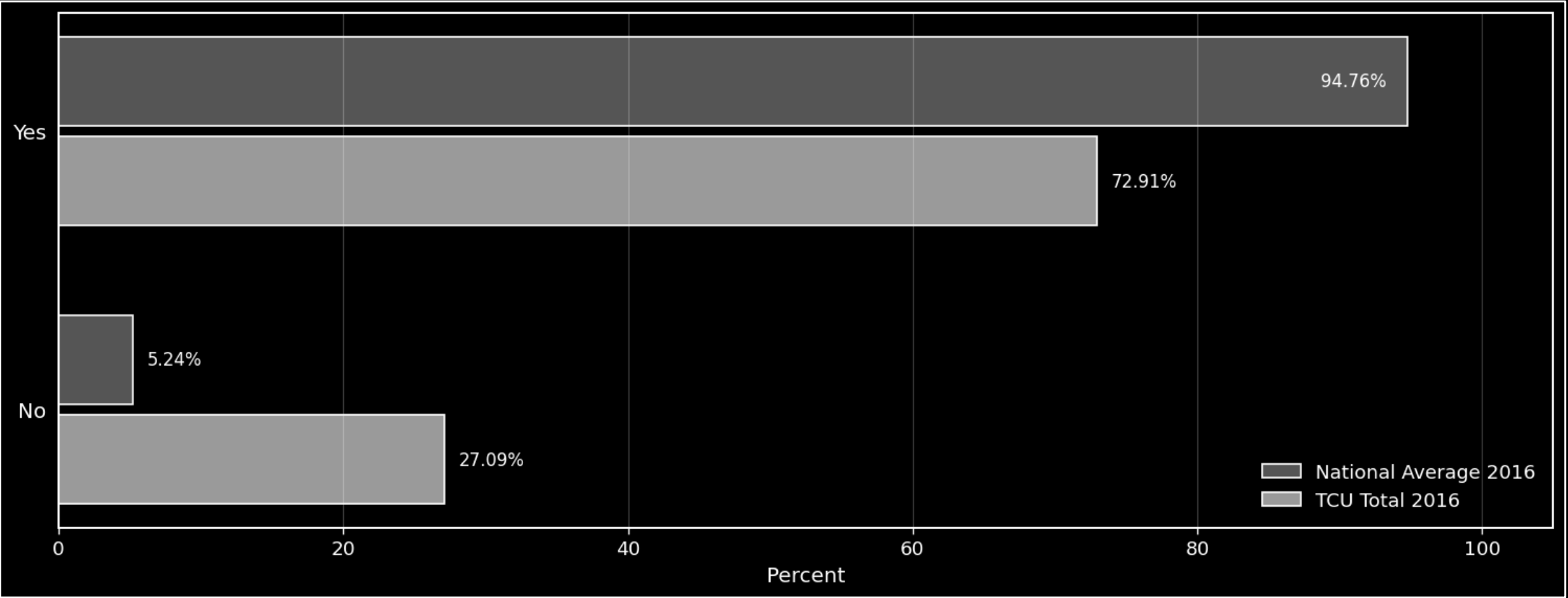


Chart 35. How involved are you in your fraternity/sorority? 0.95 2184 55.77% 0.92 350 55.43%

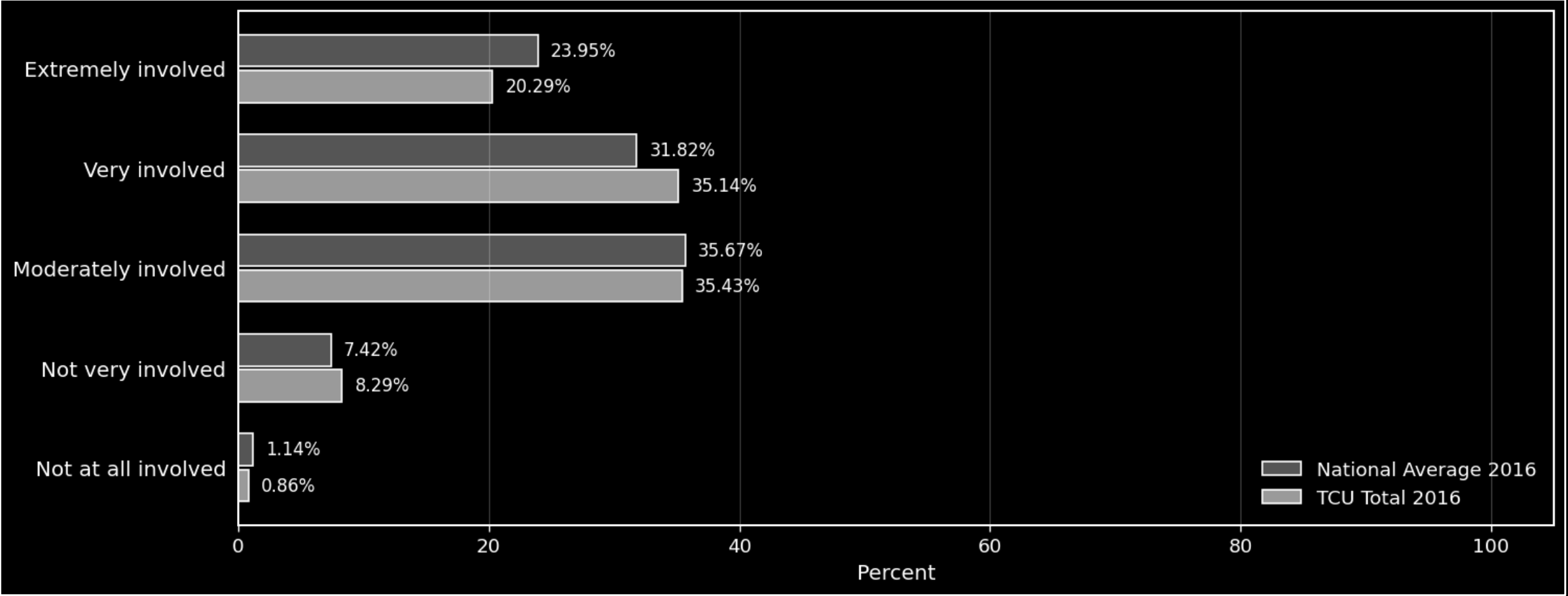

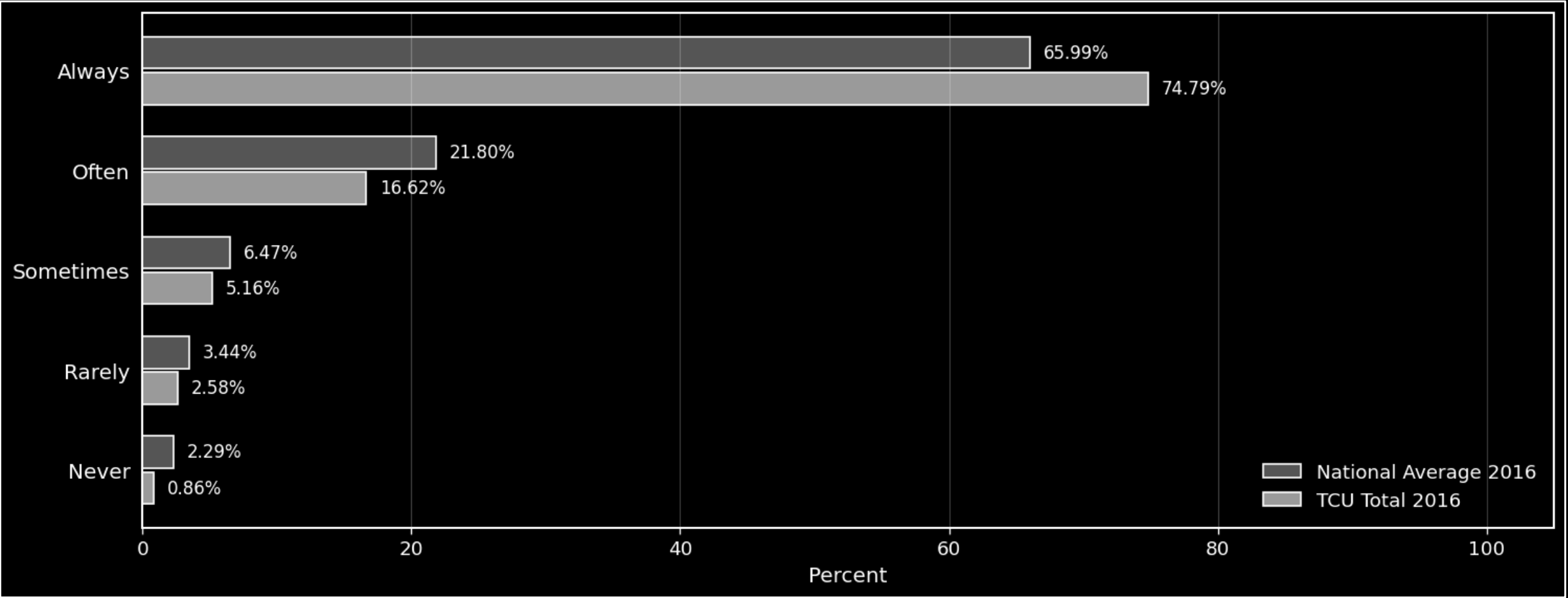

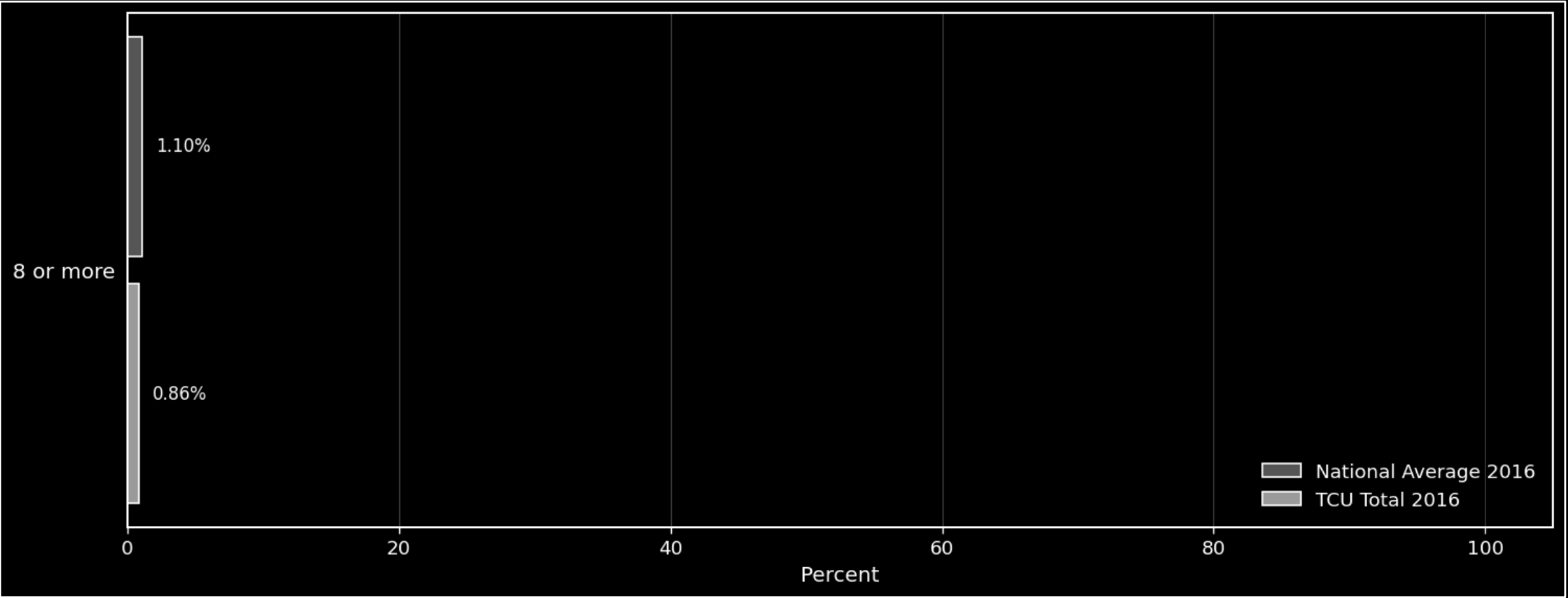

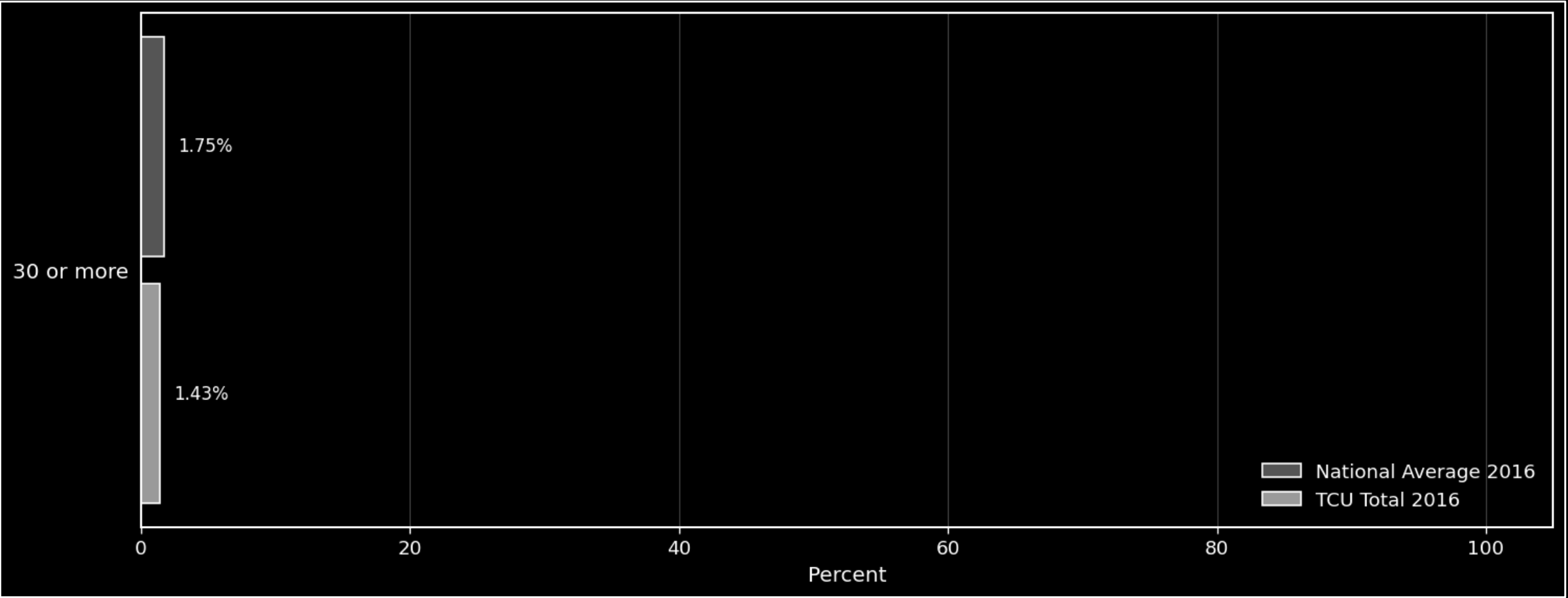


Chart 39. Do you currently hold, or have you ever held, a leadership position in your fraternity/sorority?

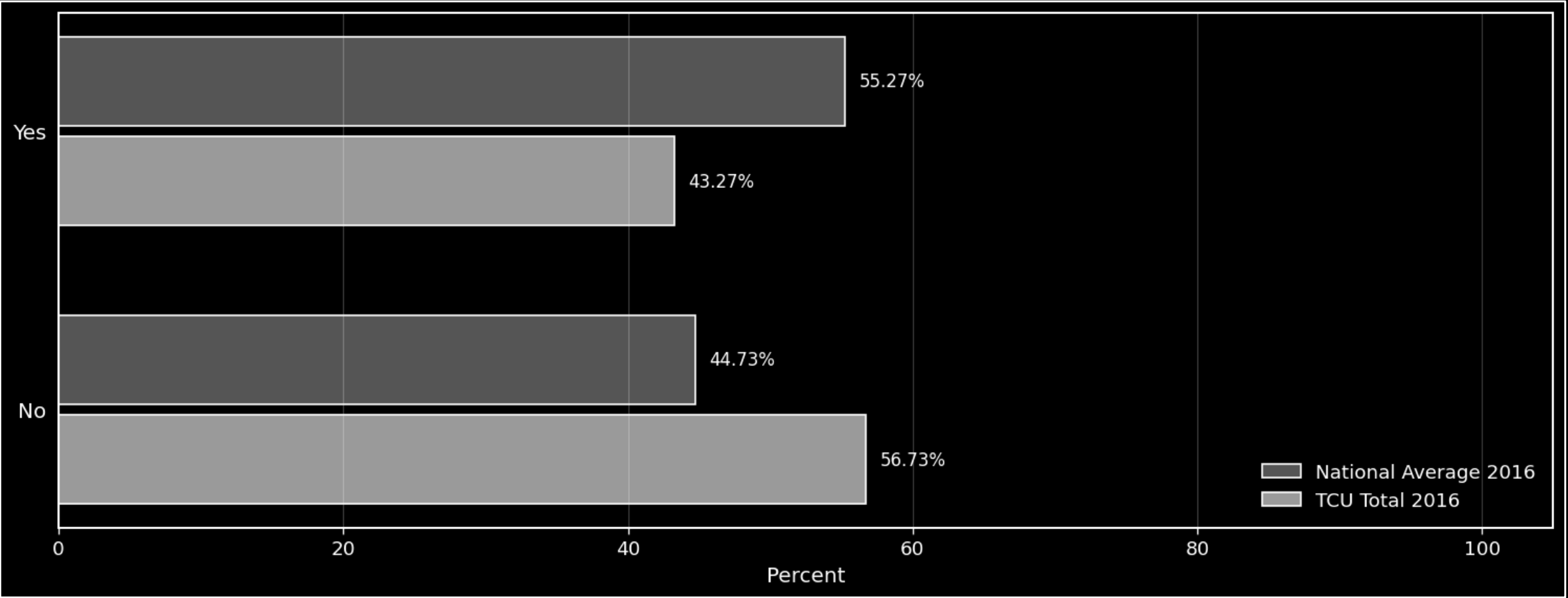


Chart 40. Do you currently hold, or have you ever held, a position on your chapter executive or leadership board/chapter council?

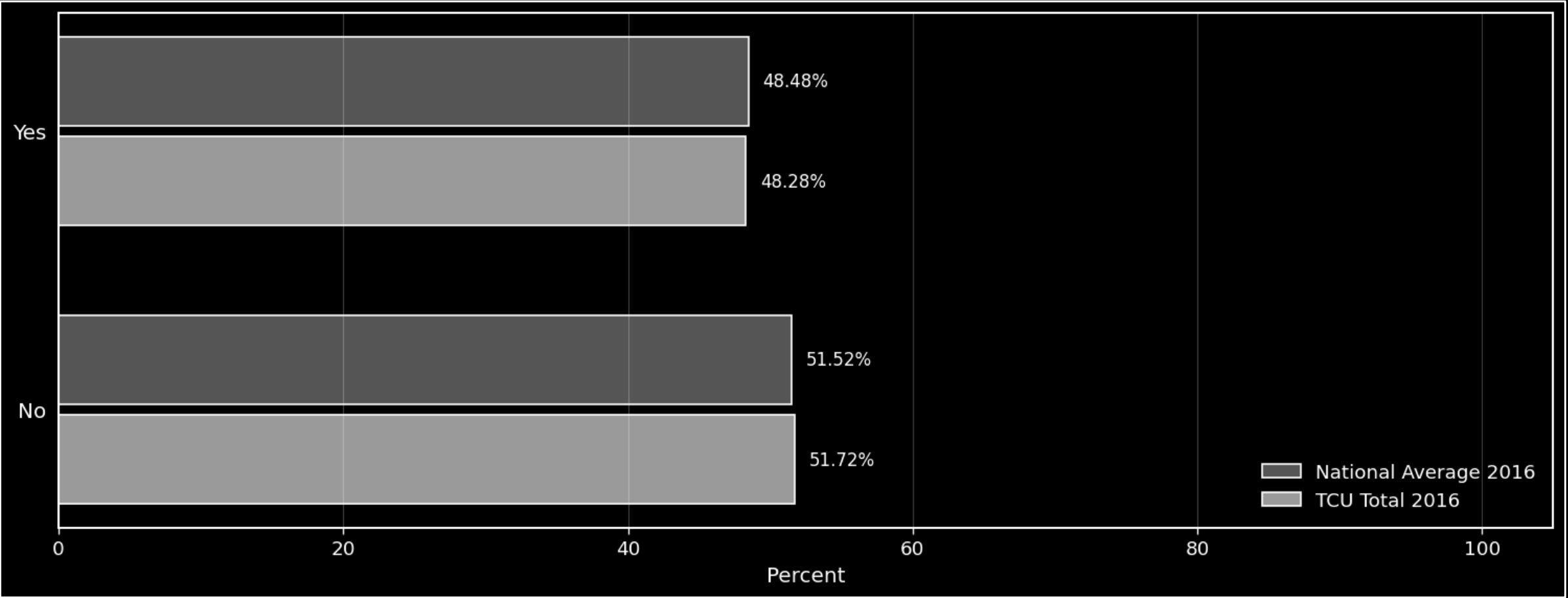

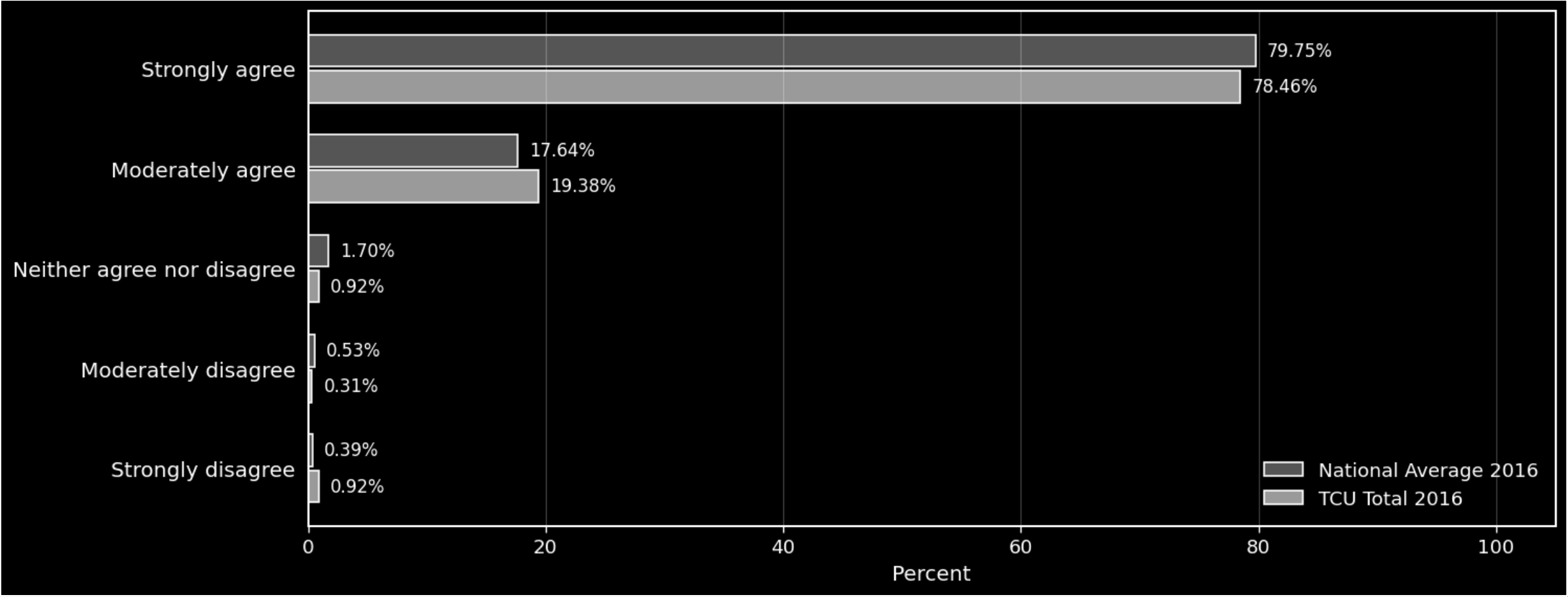

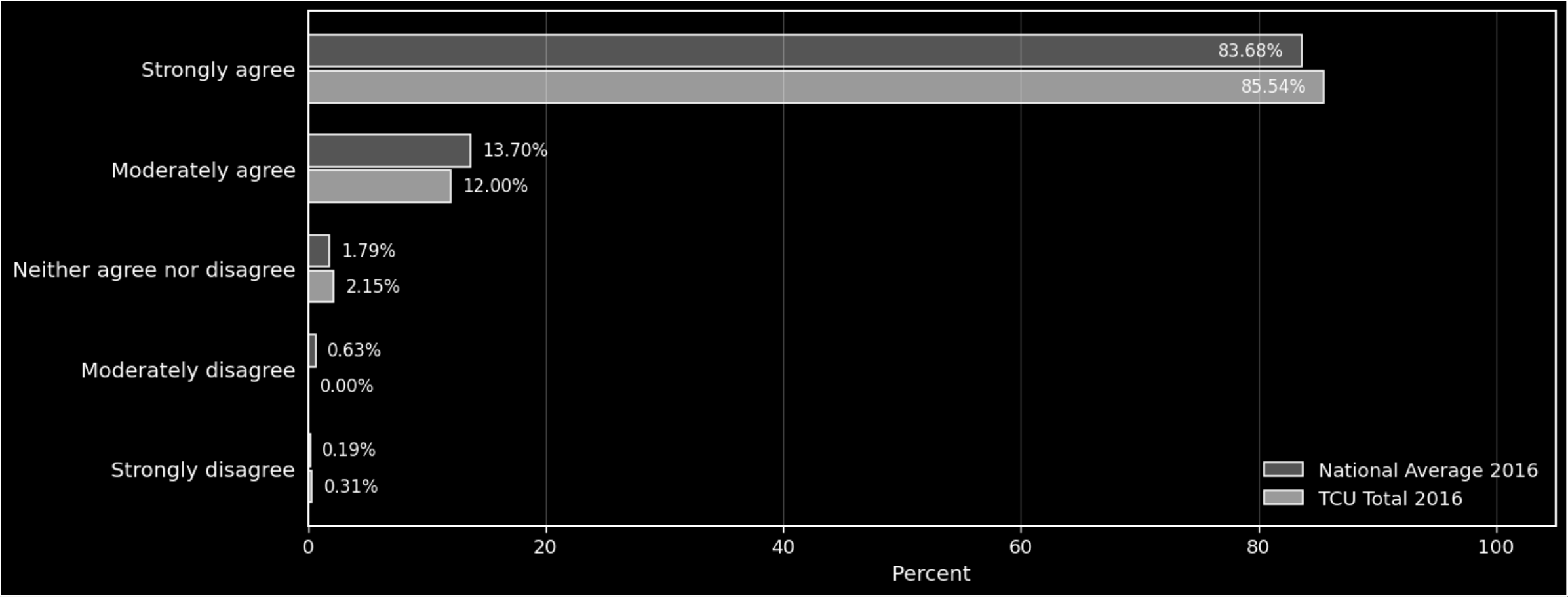

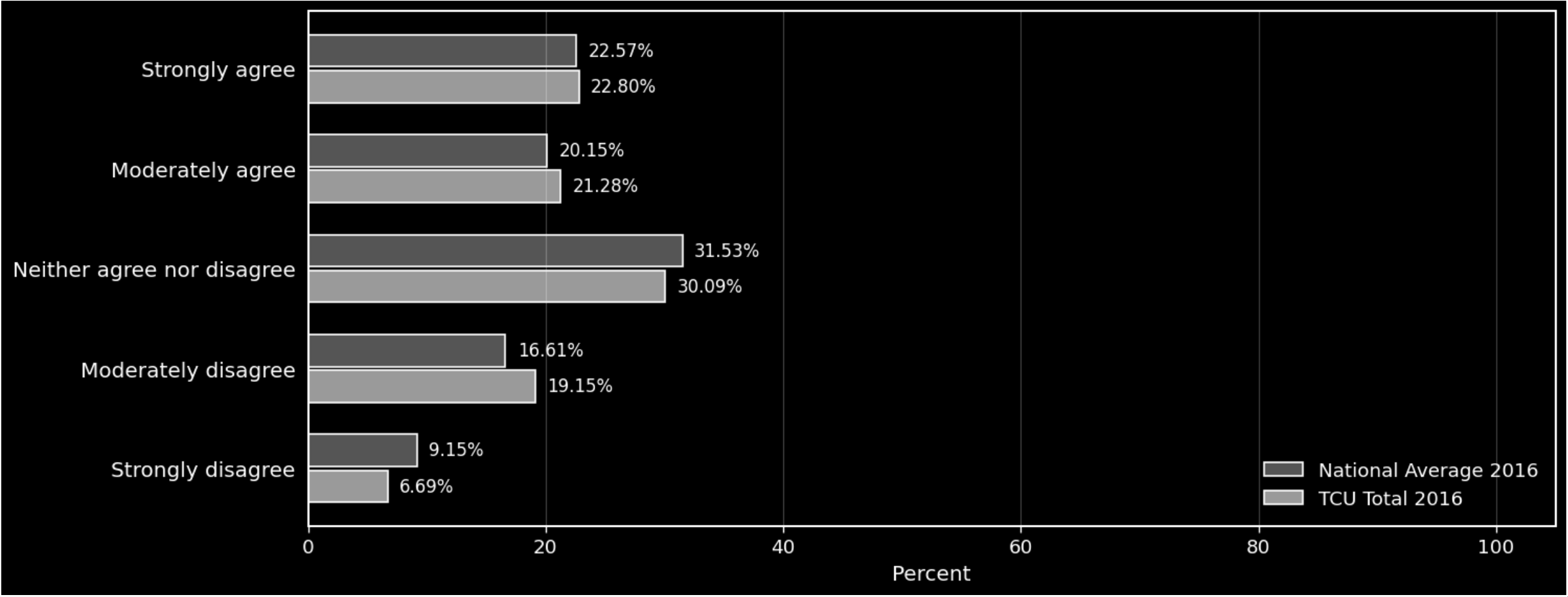

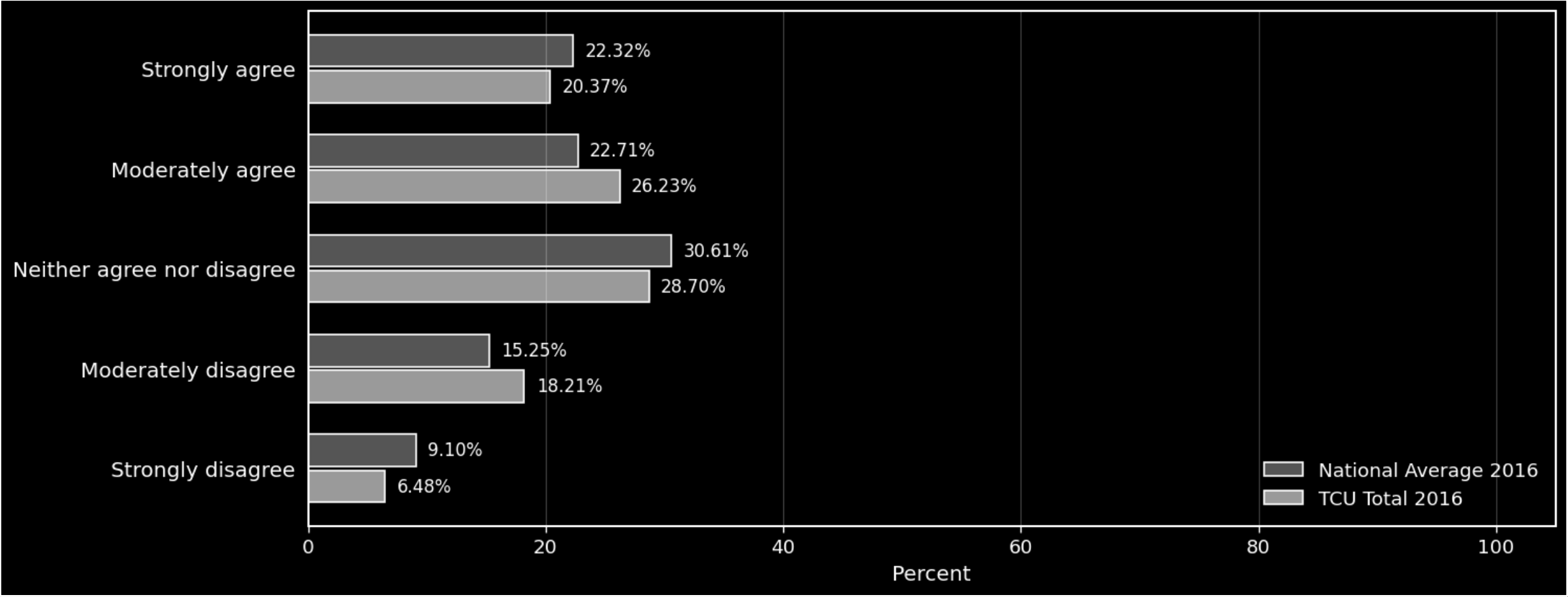

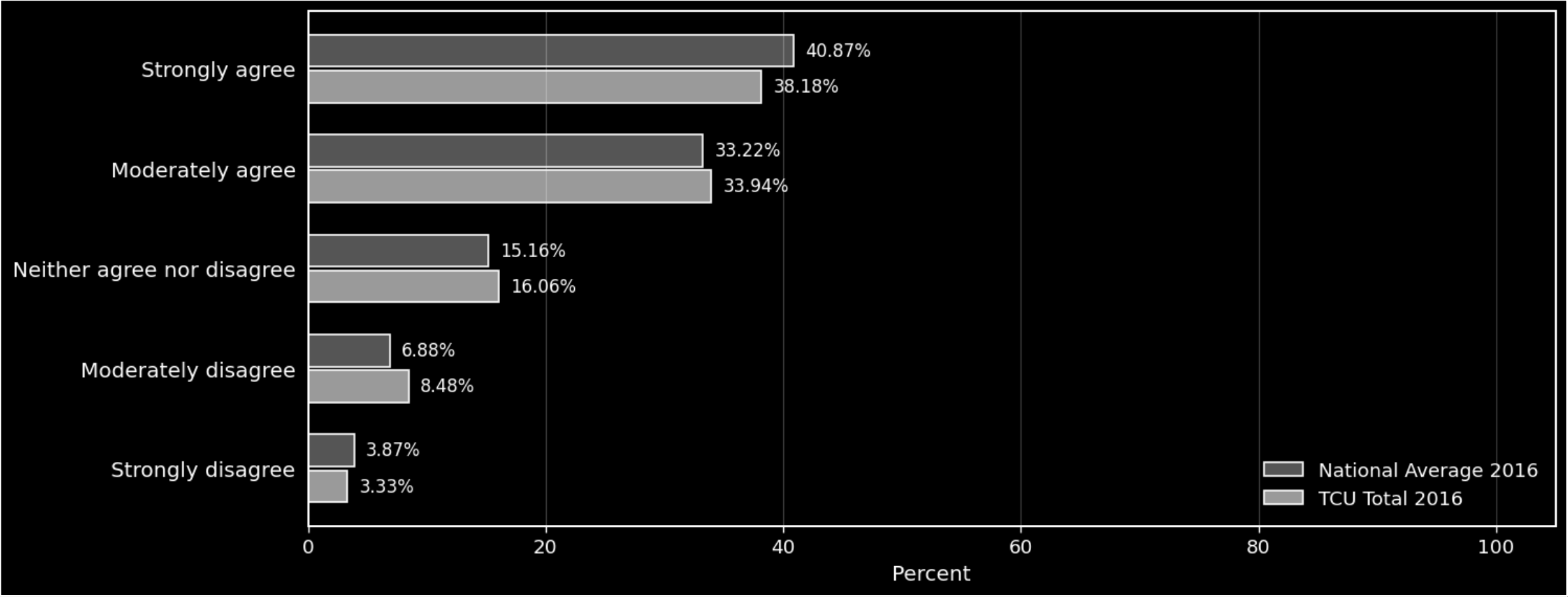

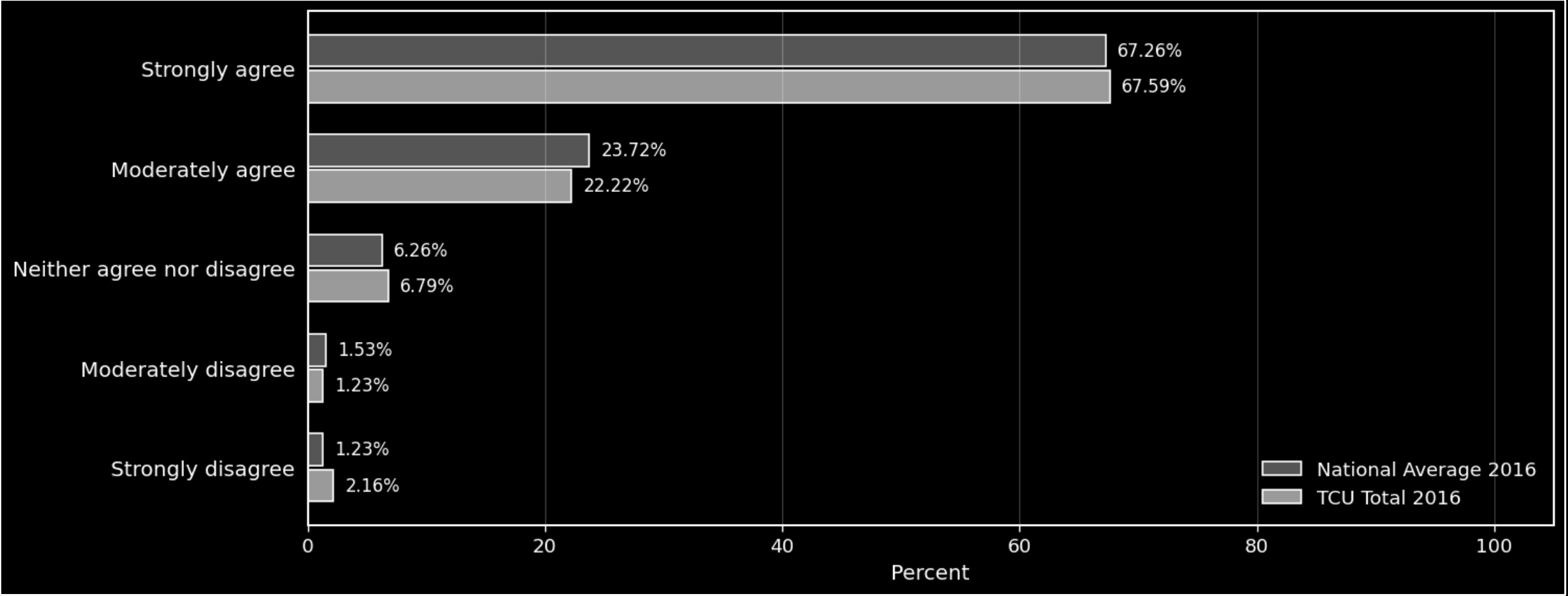

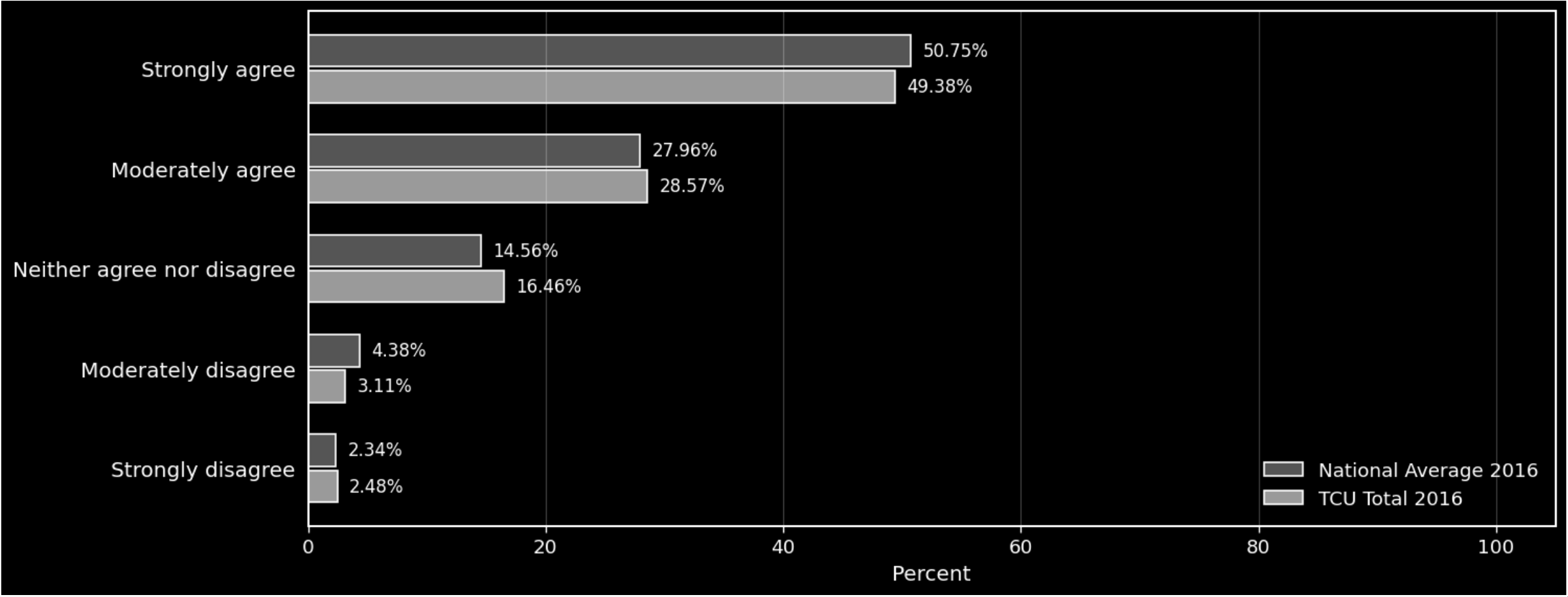

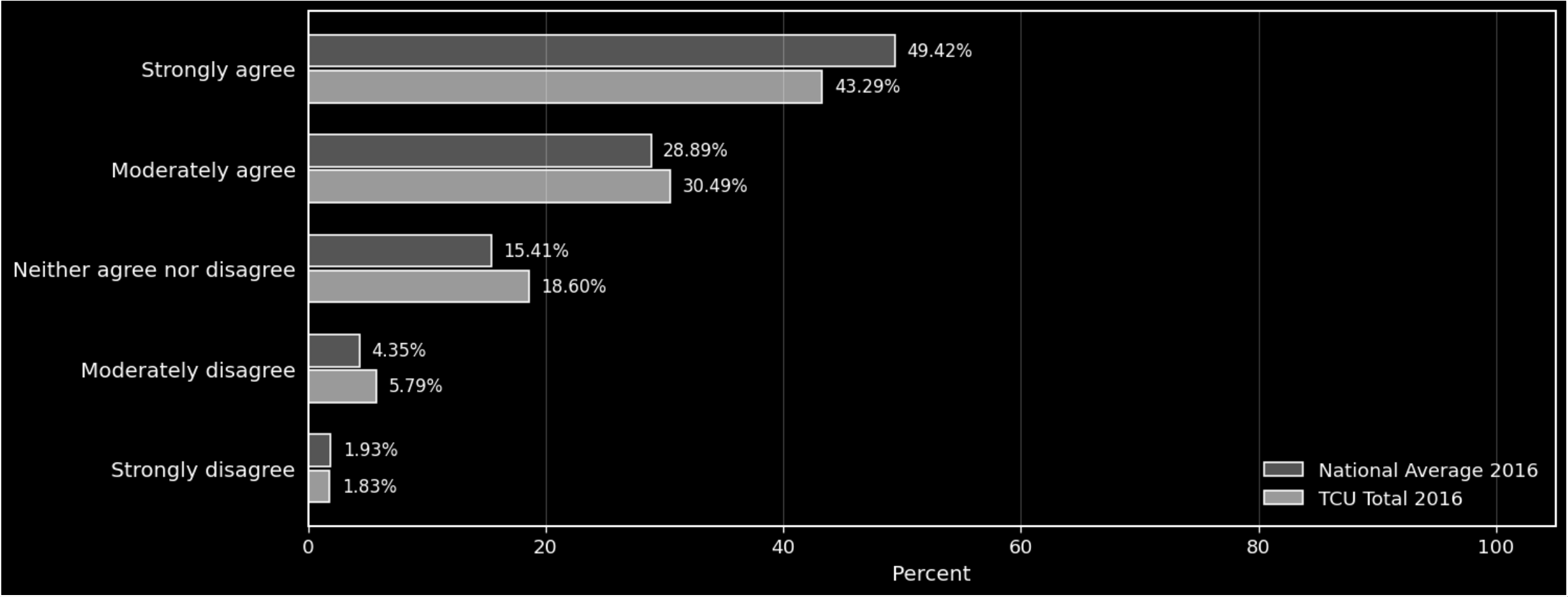

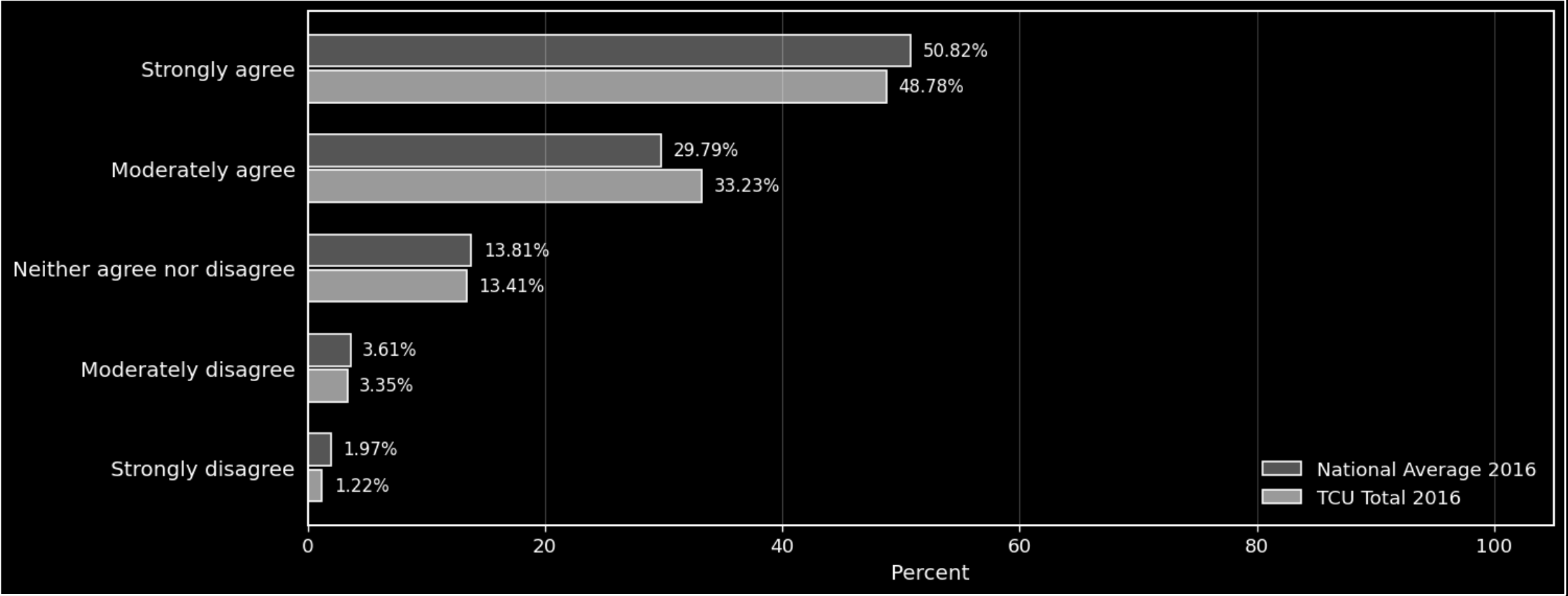

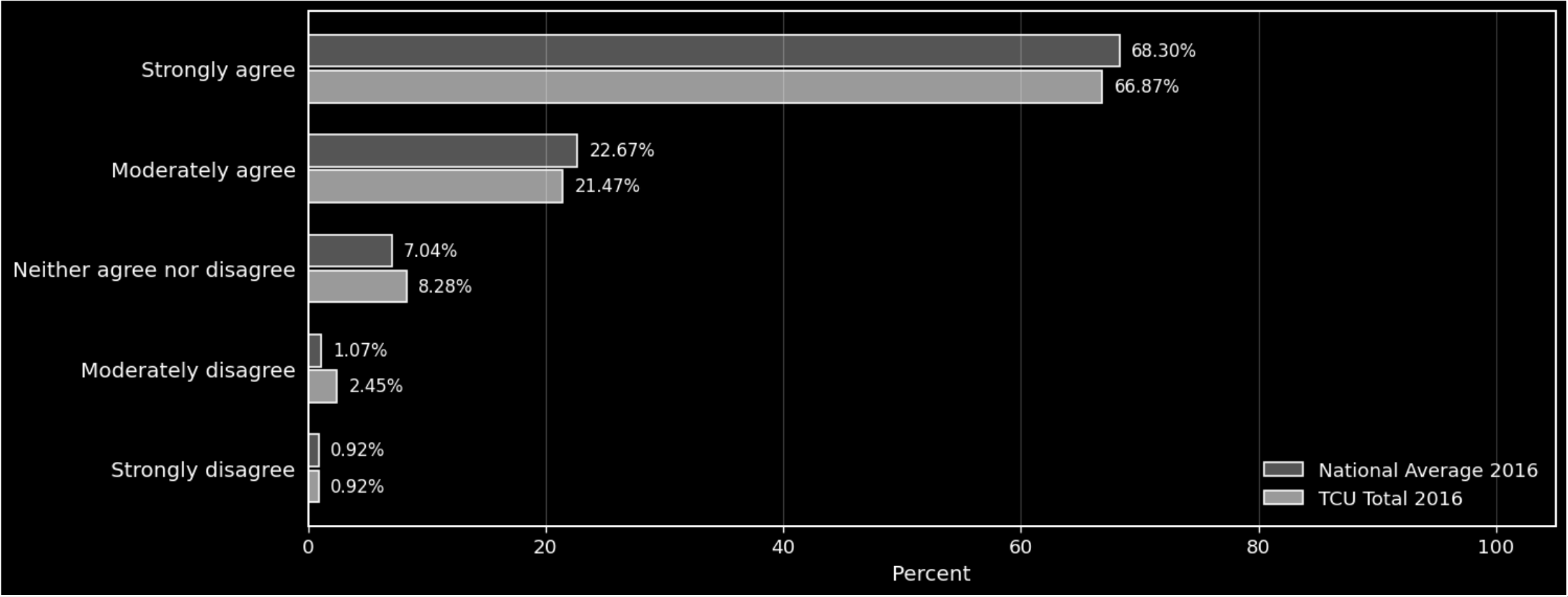

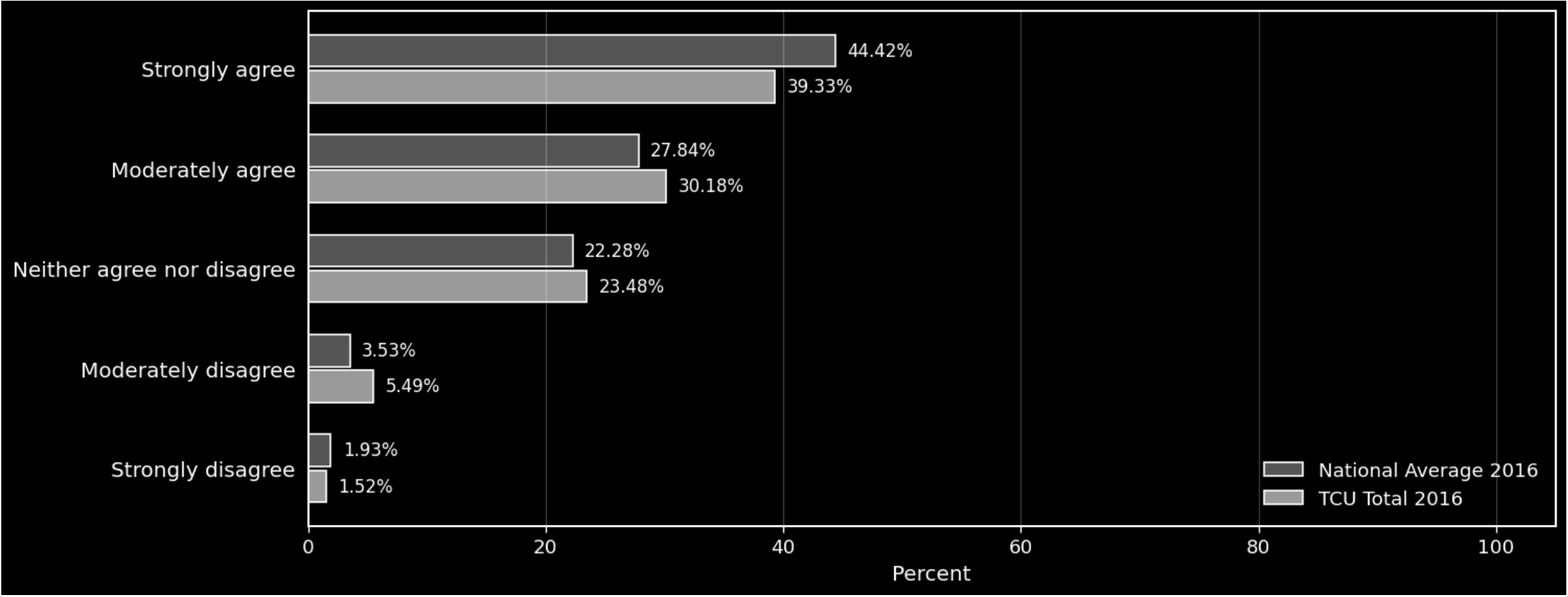

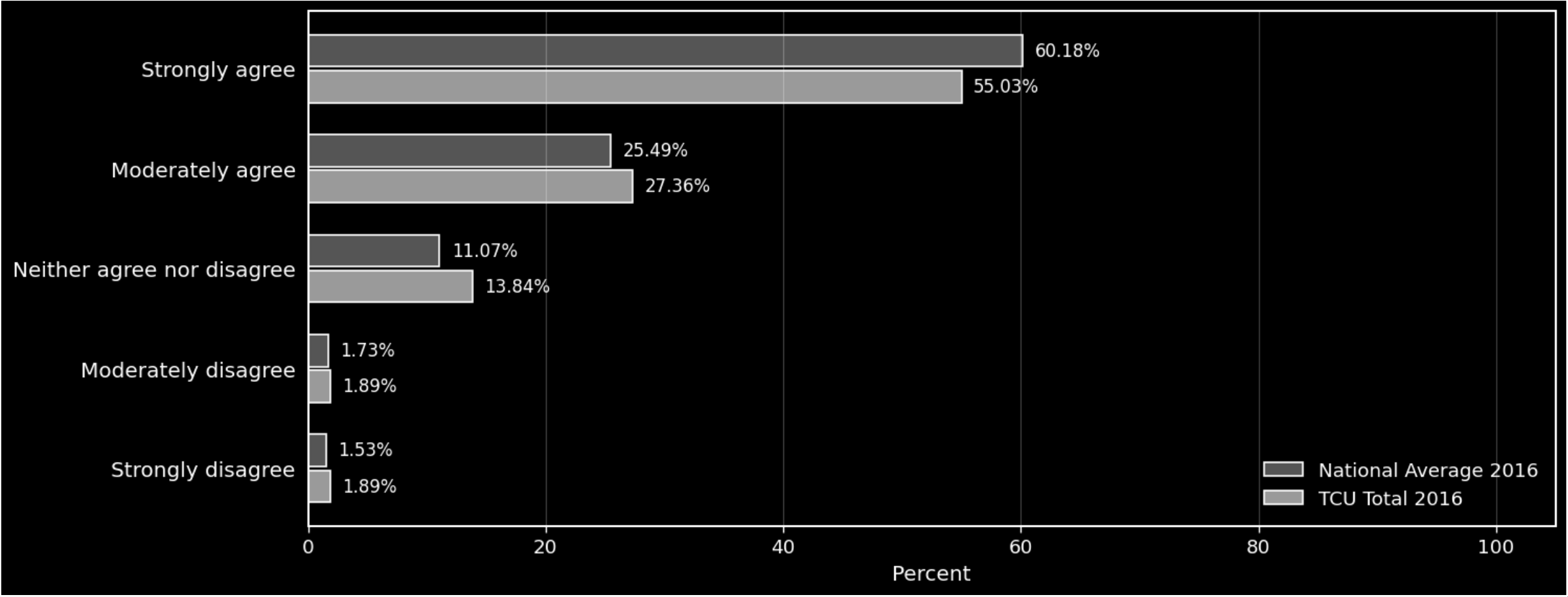

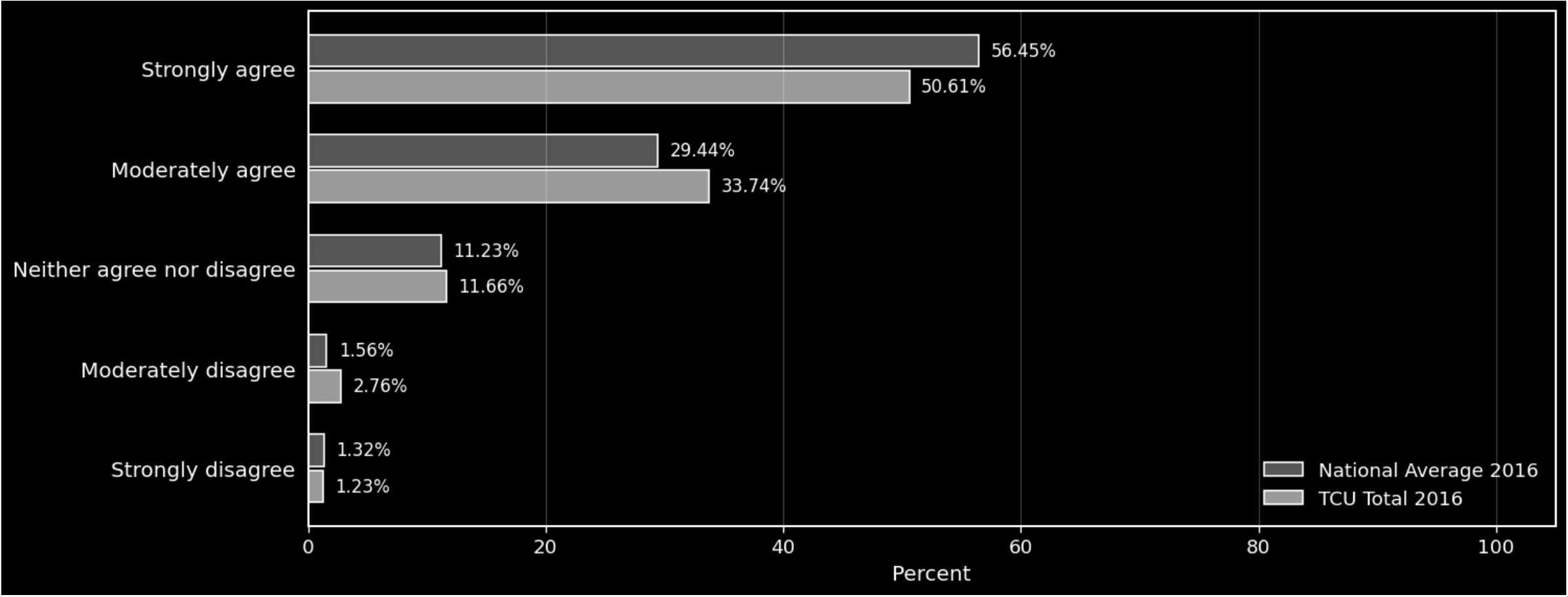

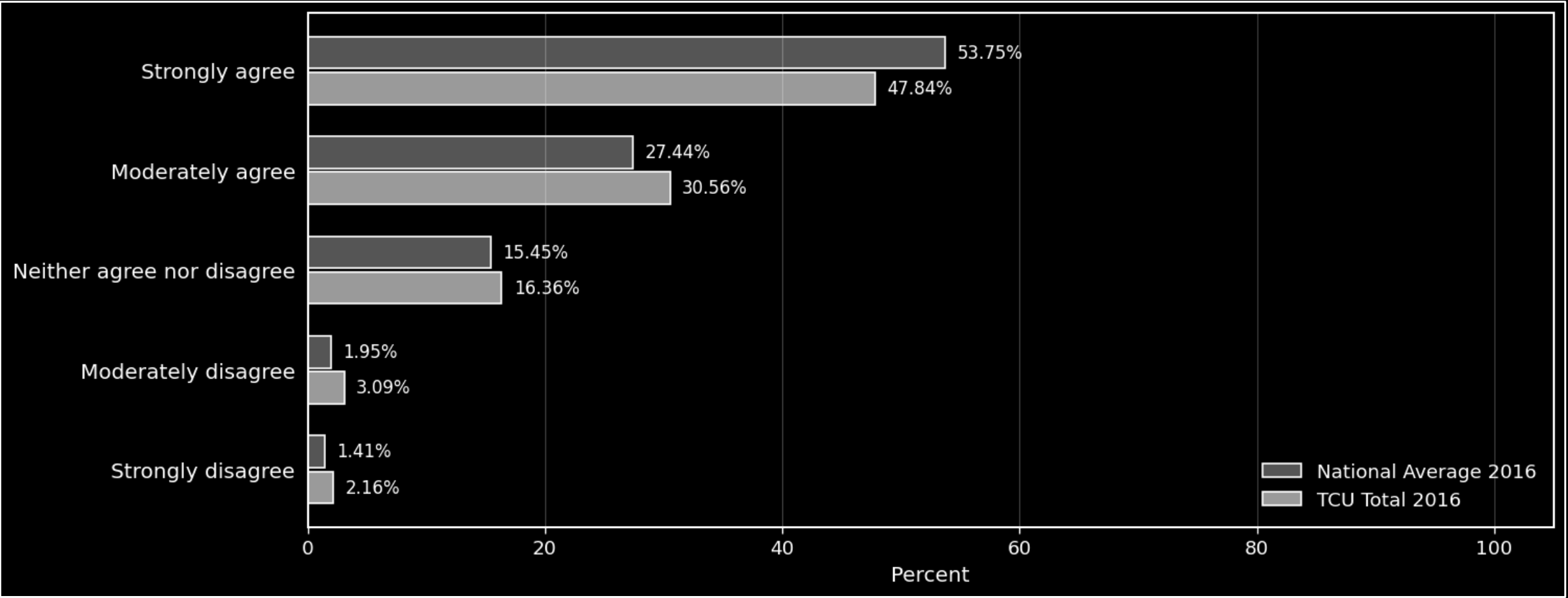

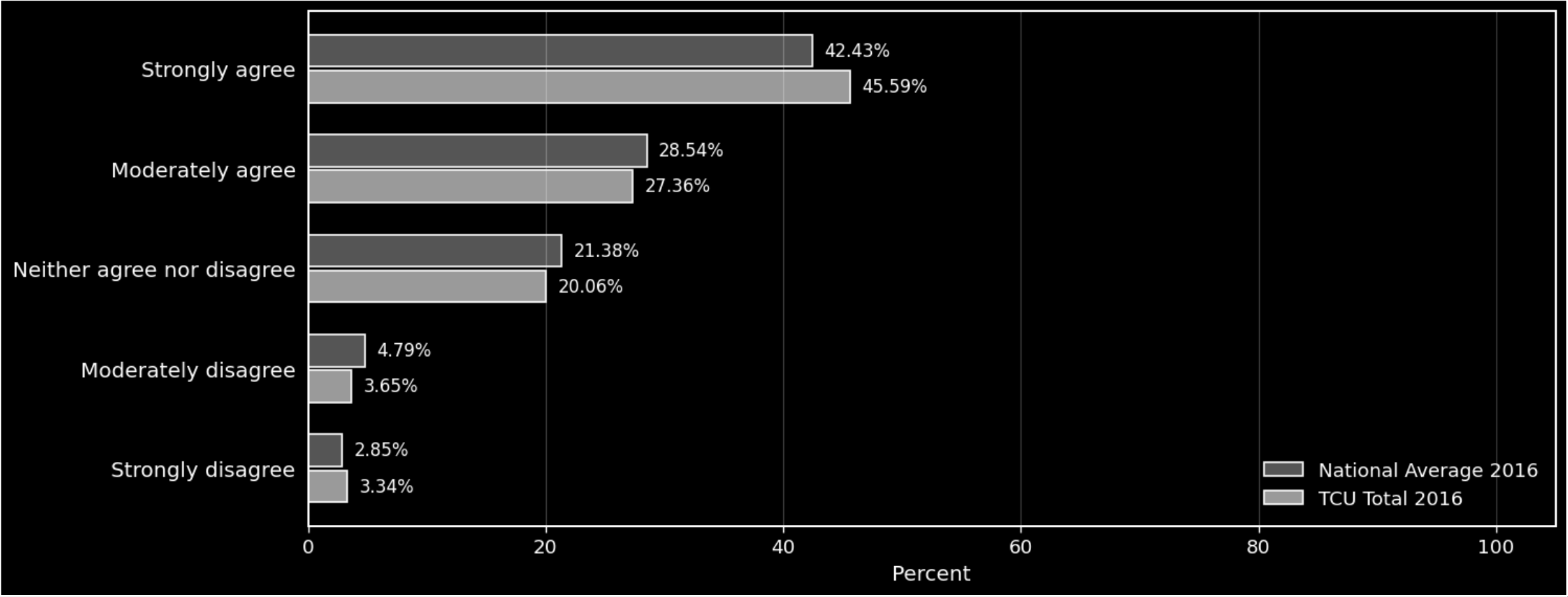

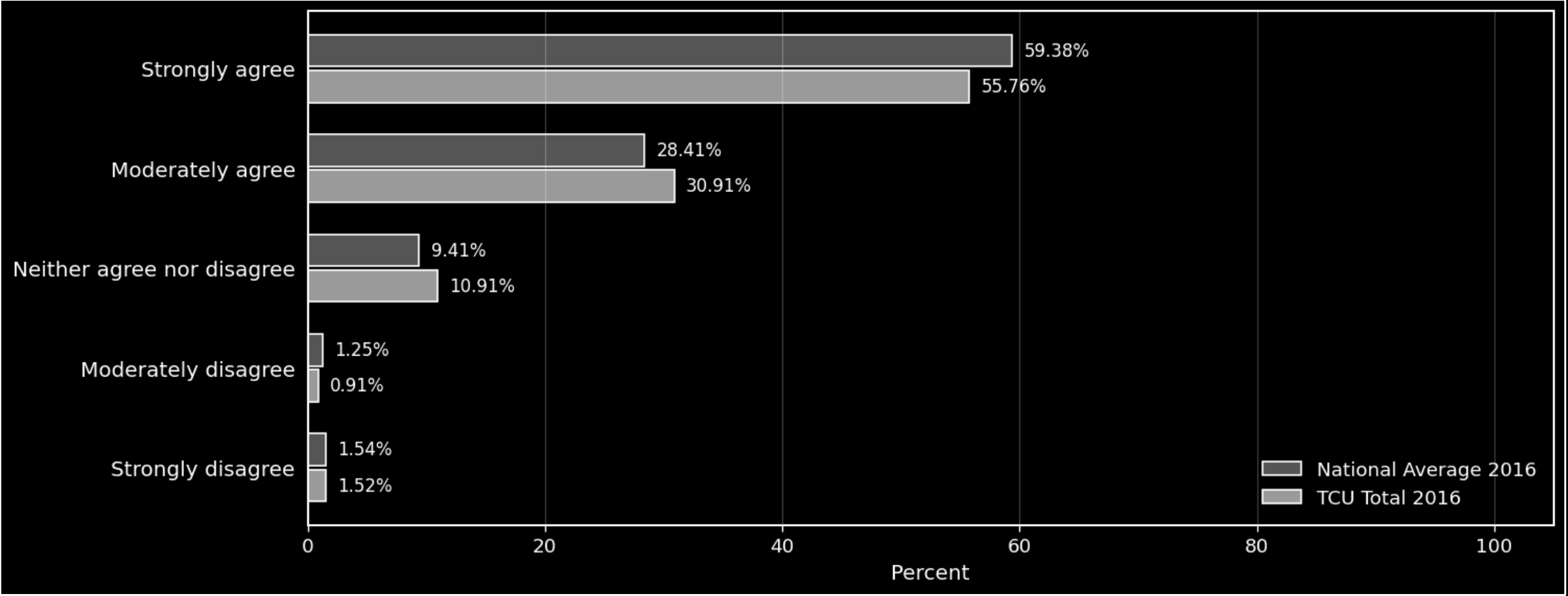

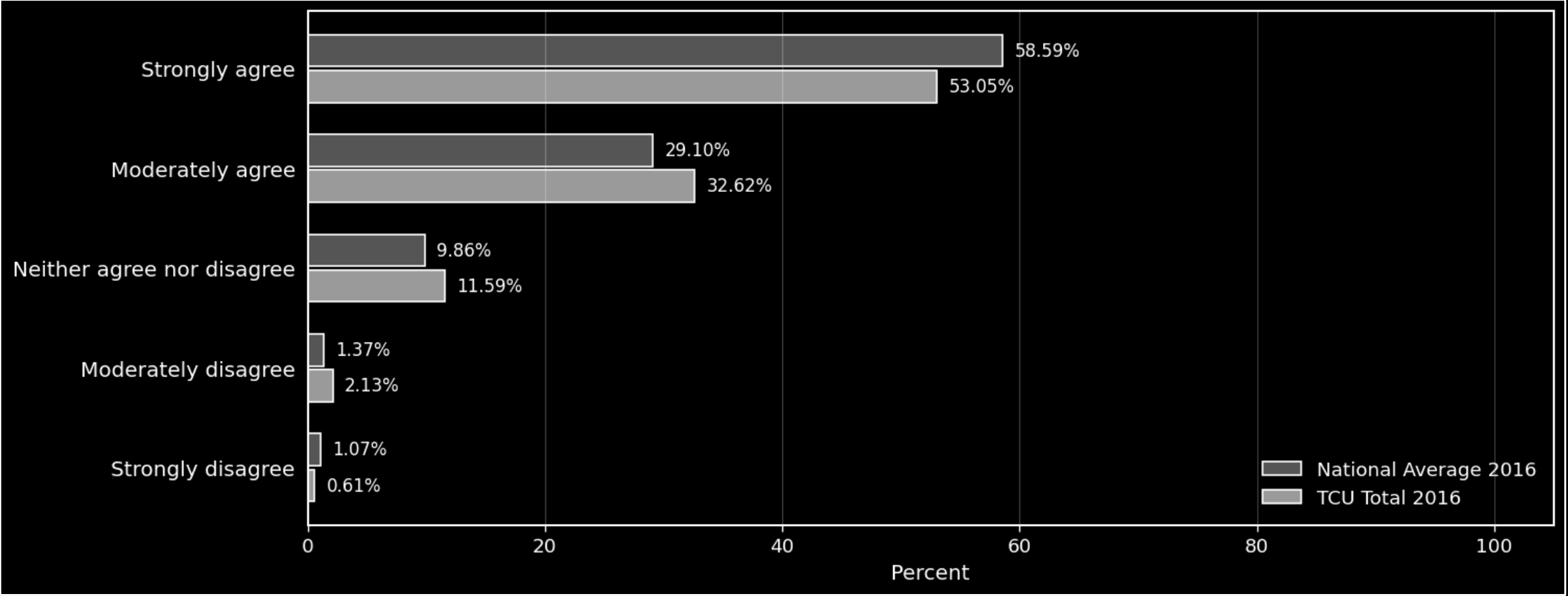

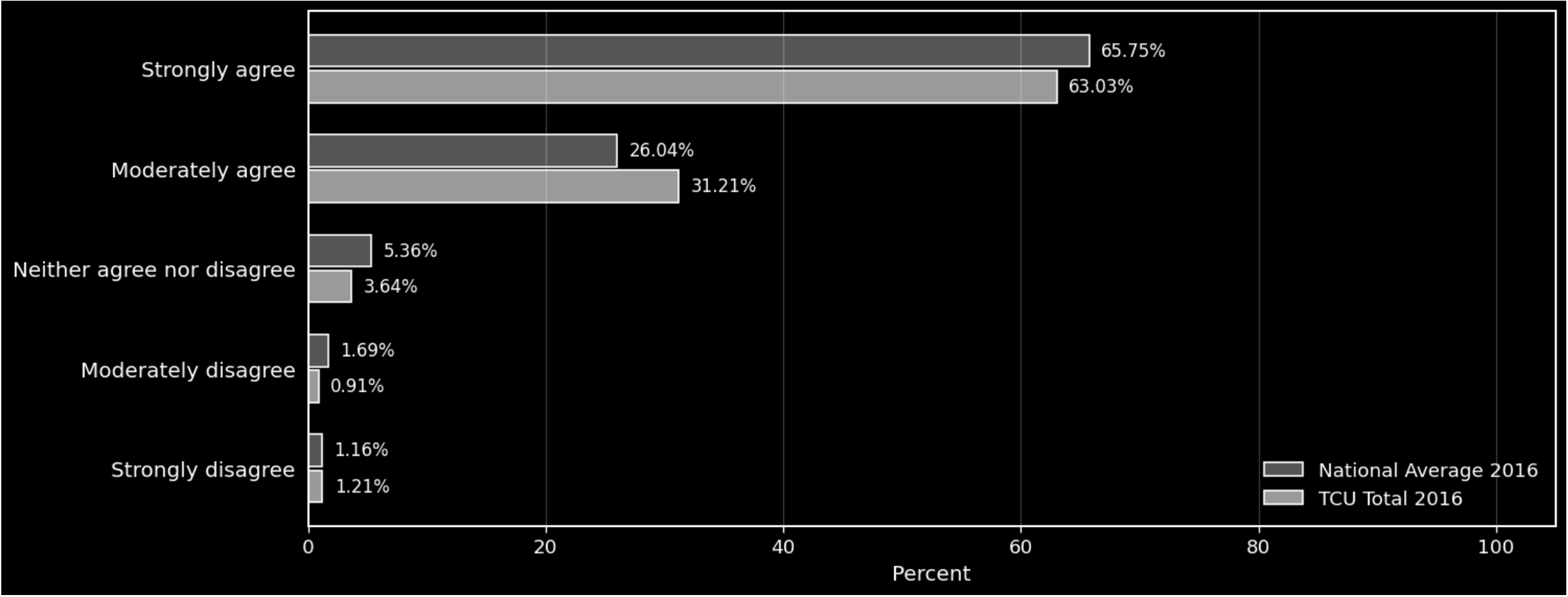

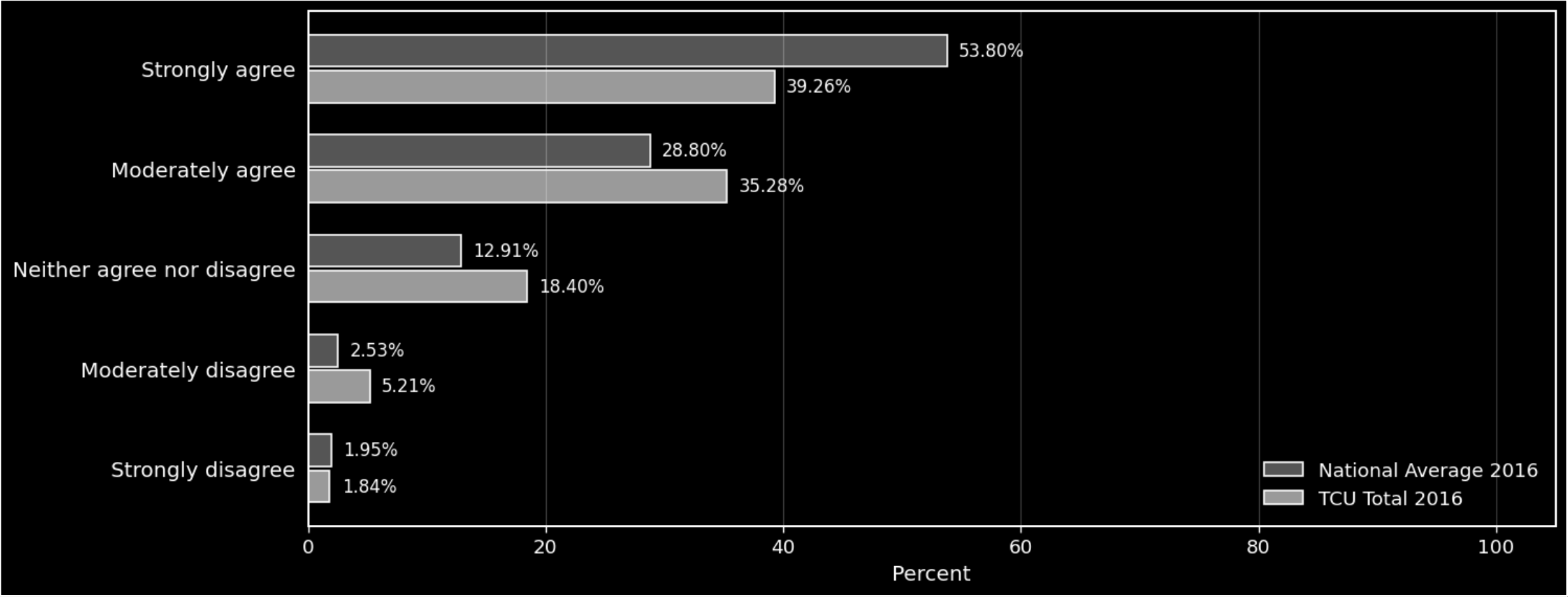

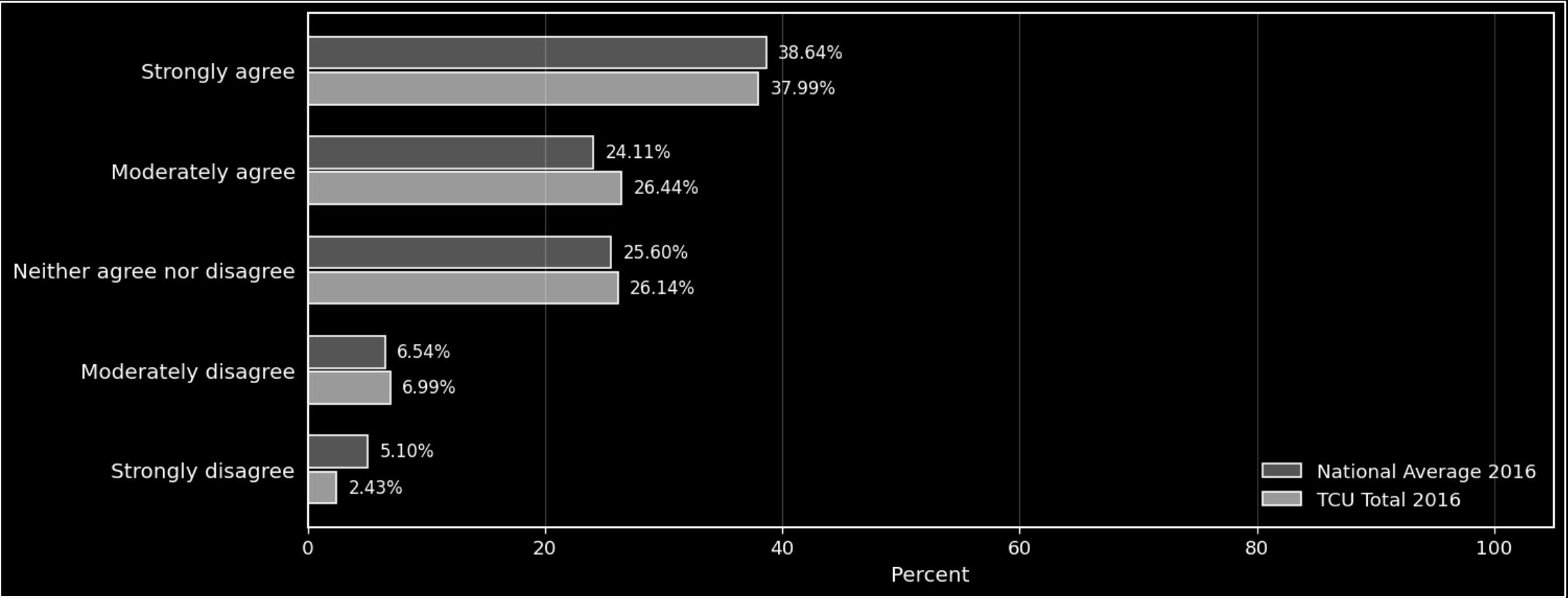

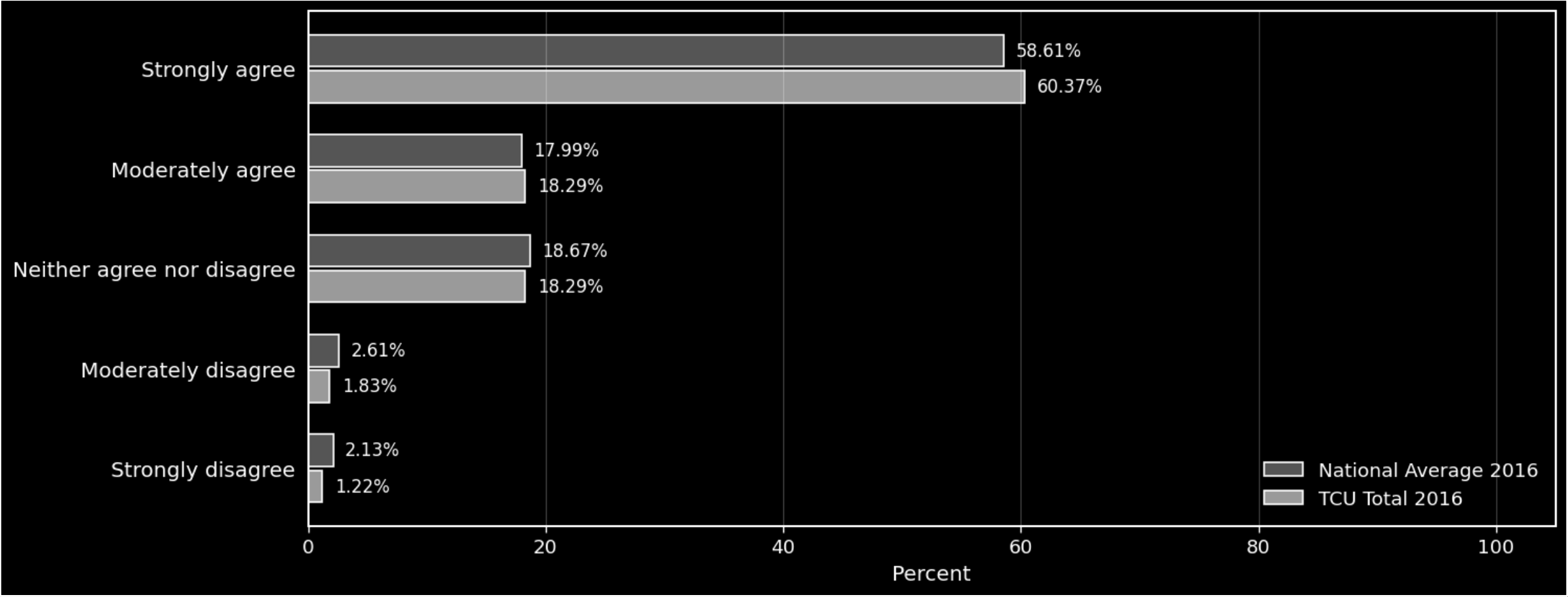

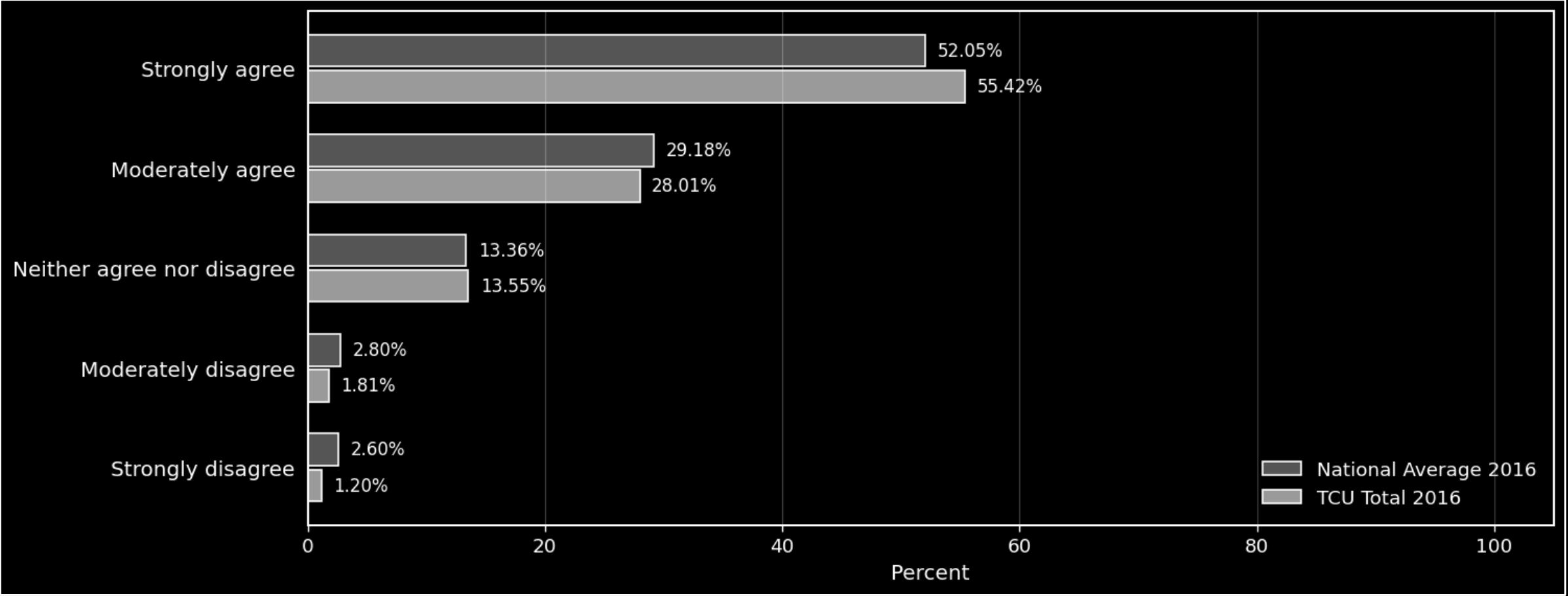

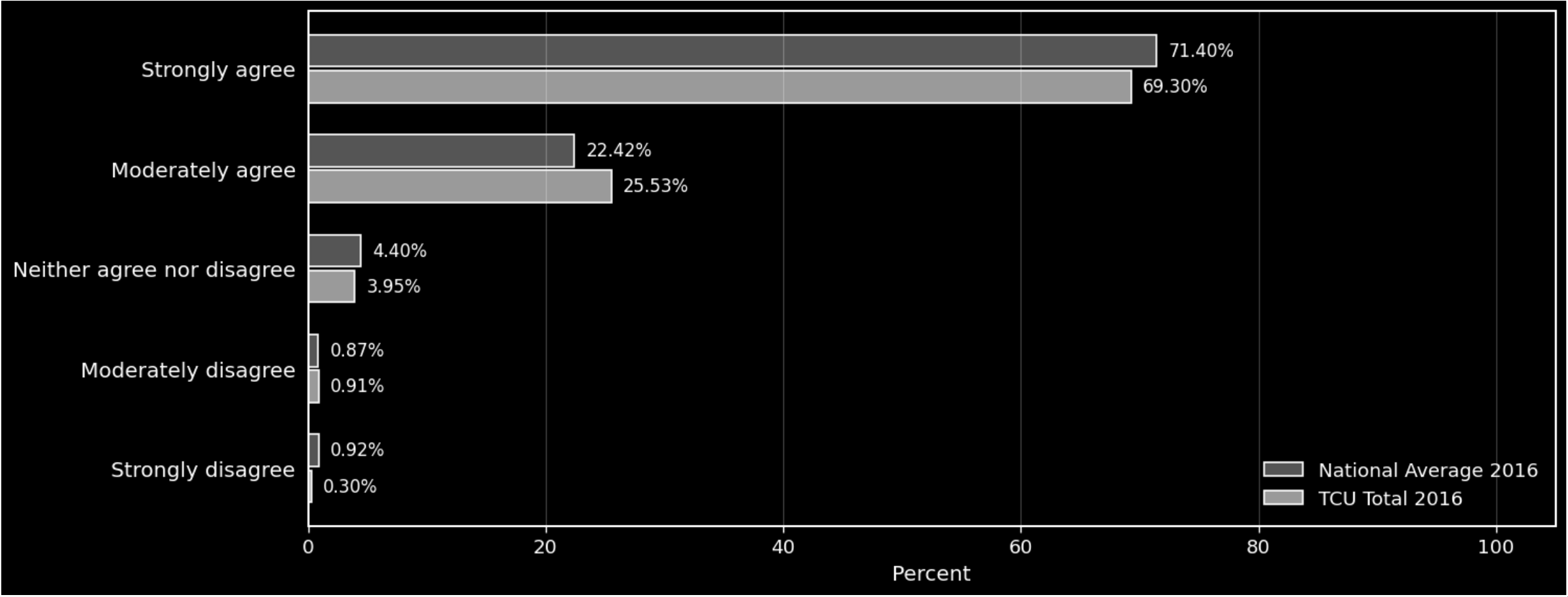


Chart 64. Please complete this statement: As a result of being a member of a fraternity/sorority, my overall health (e.g., fitness, eating habits) has . . . 0.93

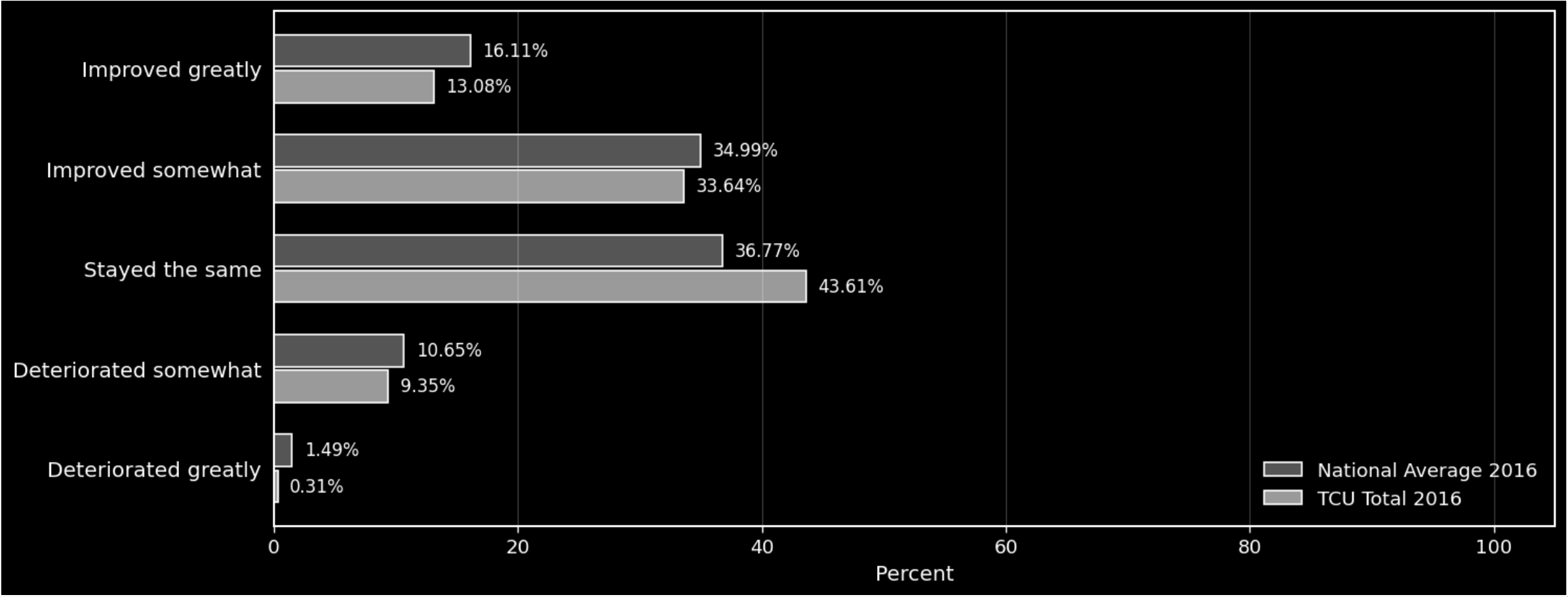


Chart 65. Please complete this statement: As a result of being a member of a fraternity/sorority, my academic achievement and grades have . . . 0.14* 0.87

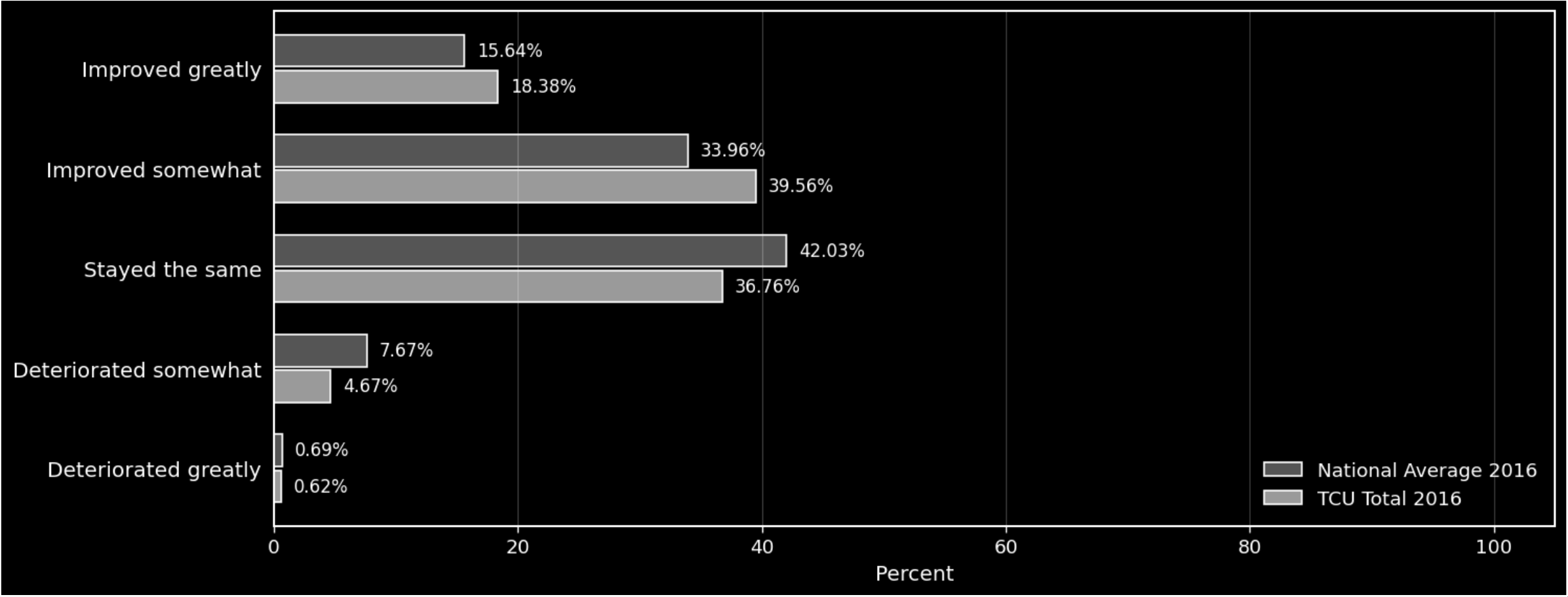


Chart 66. How do you think fraternities and sororities are perceived by each of the following groups of people? - Students in fraternities/sororities 0.69 2004

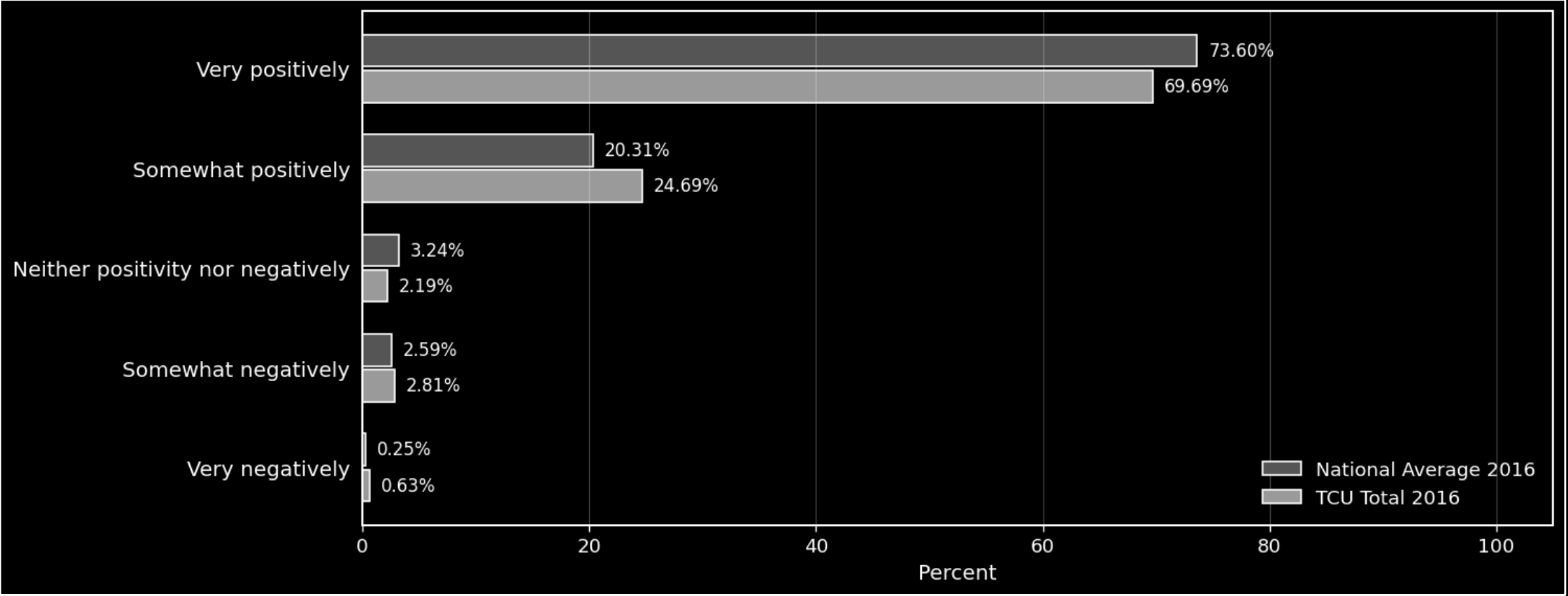

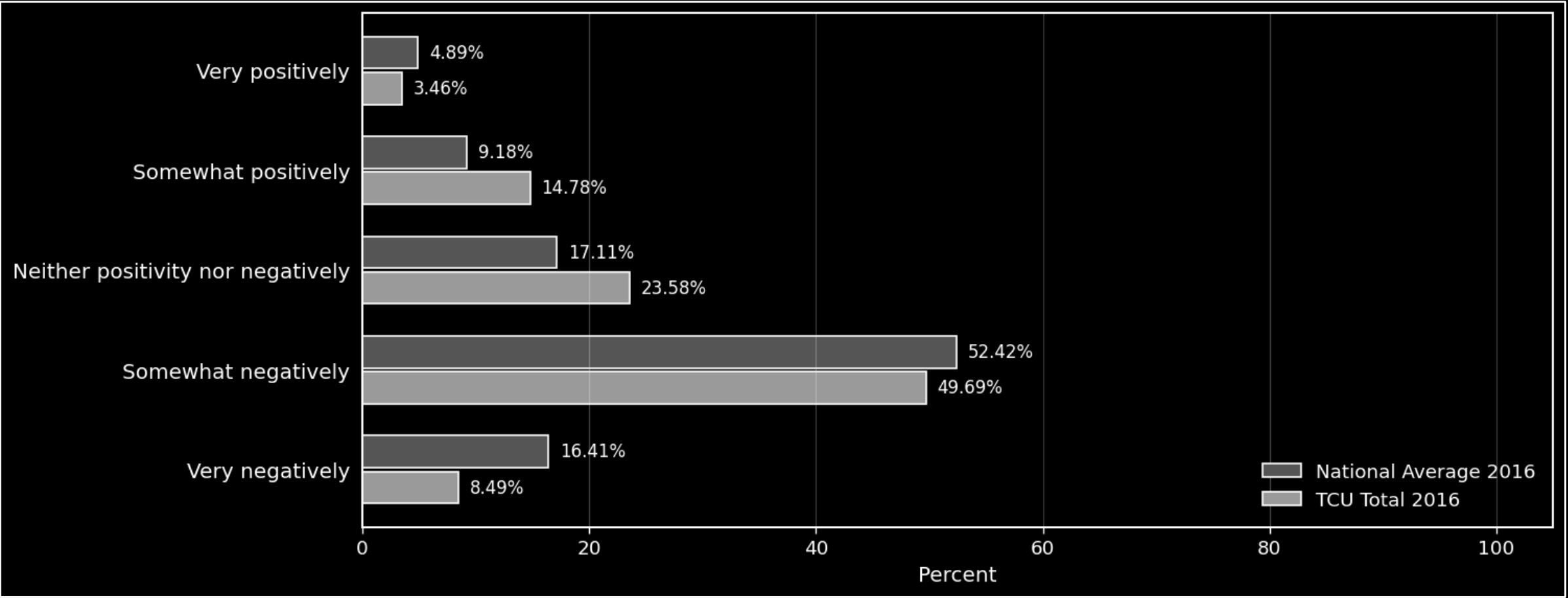

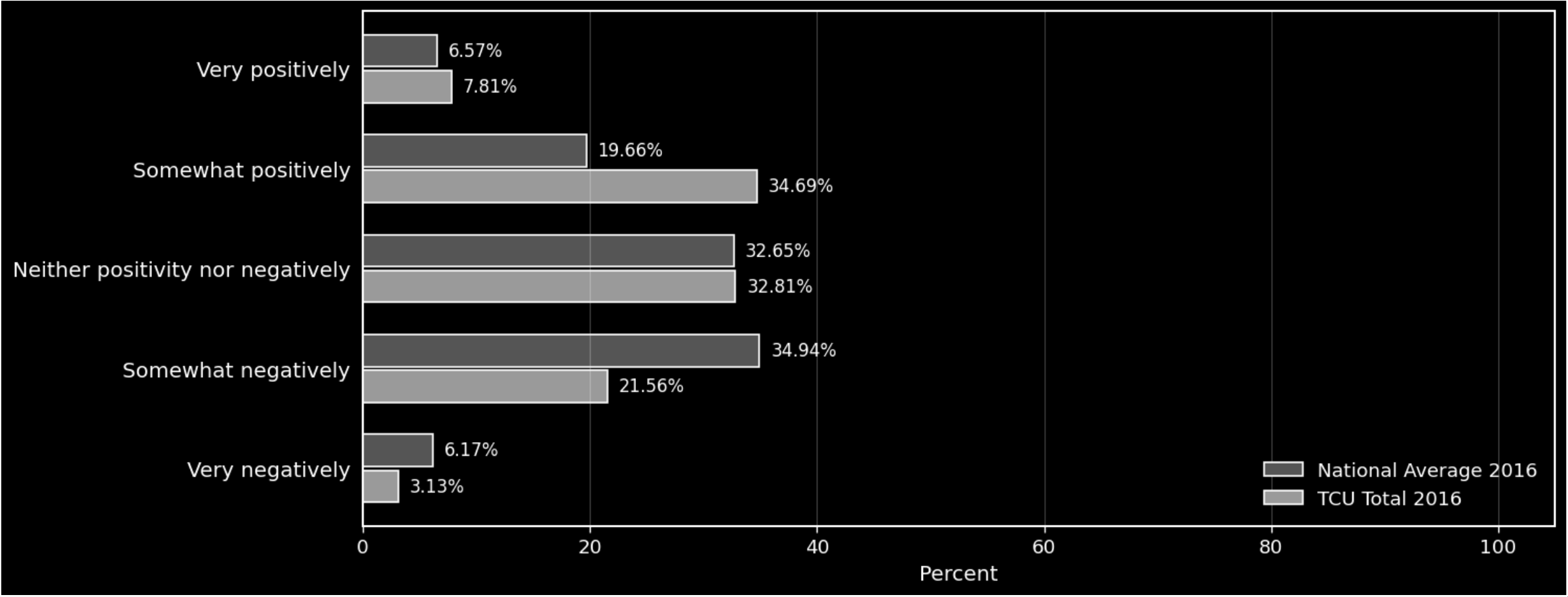

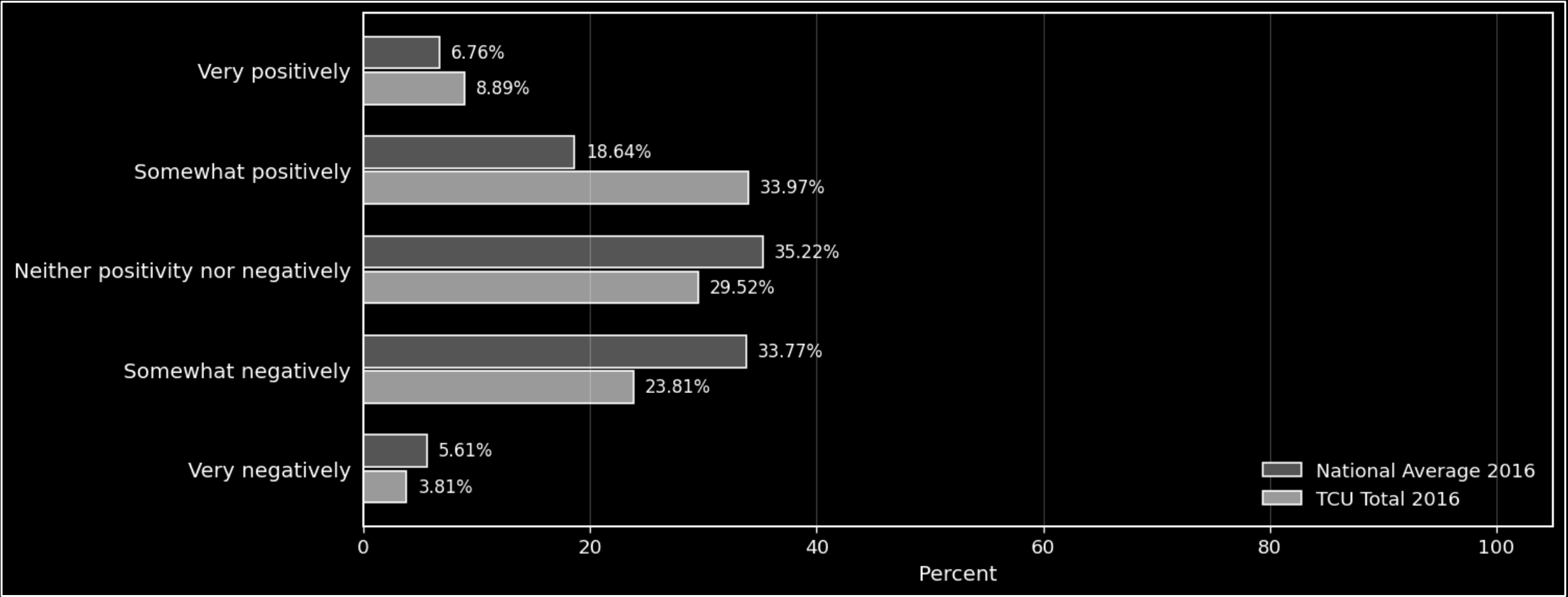

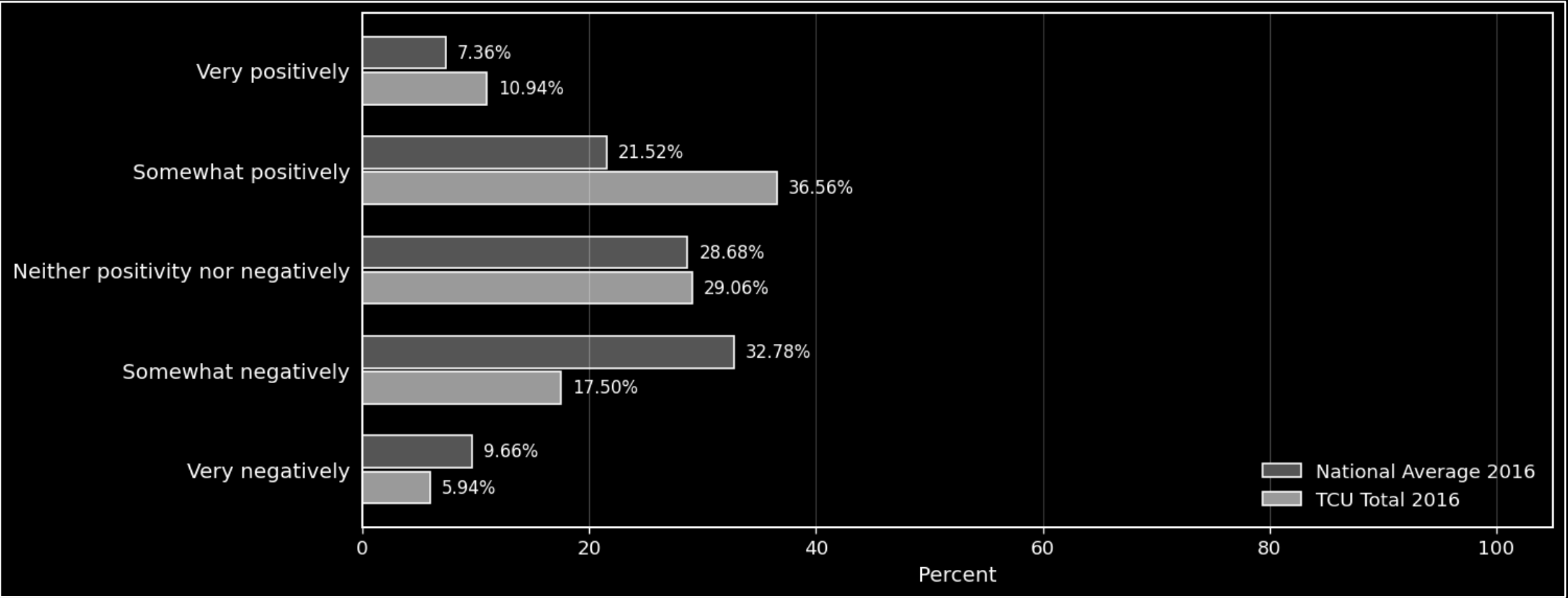

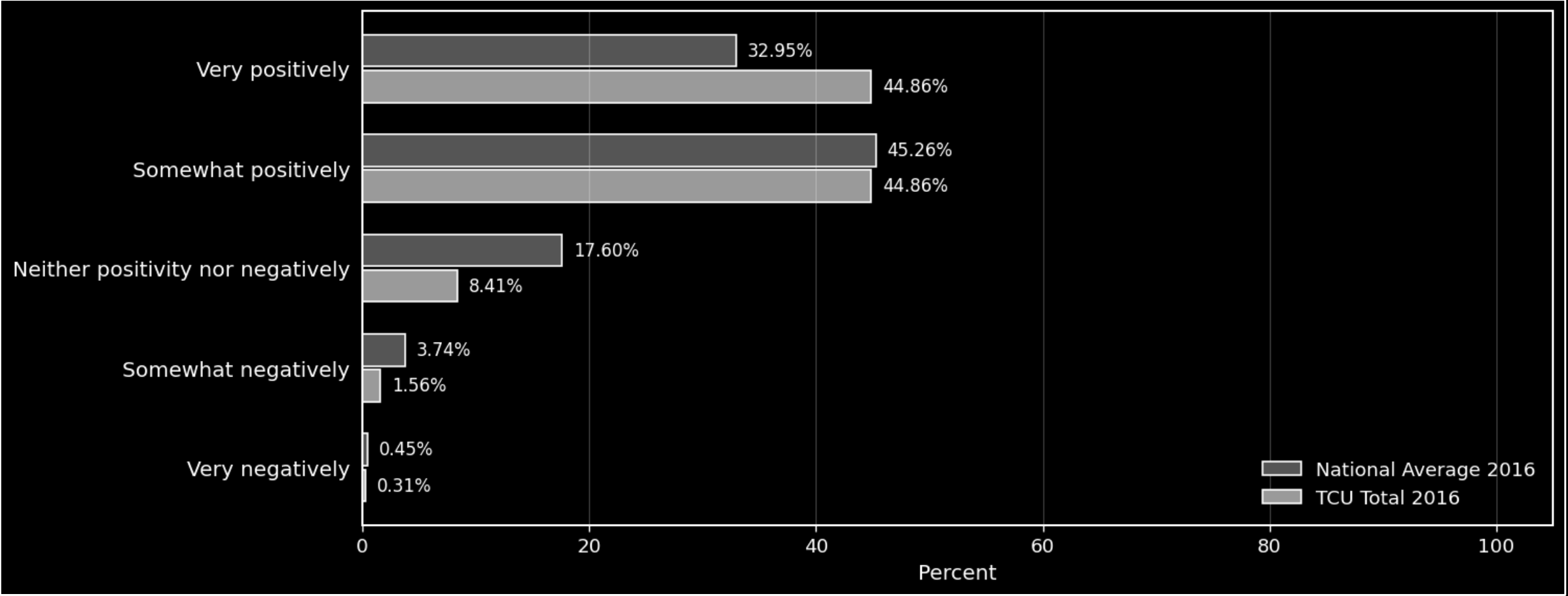

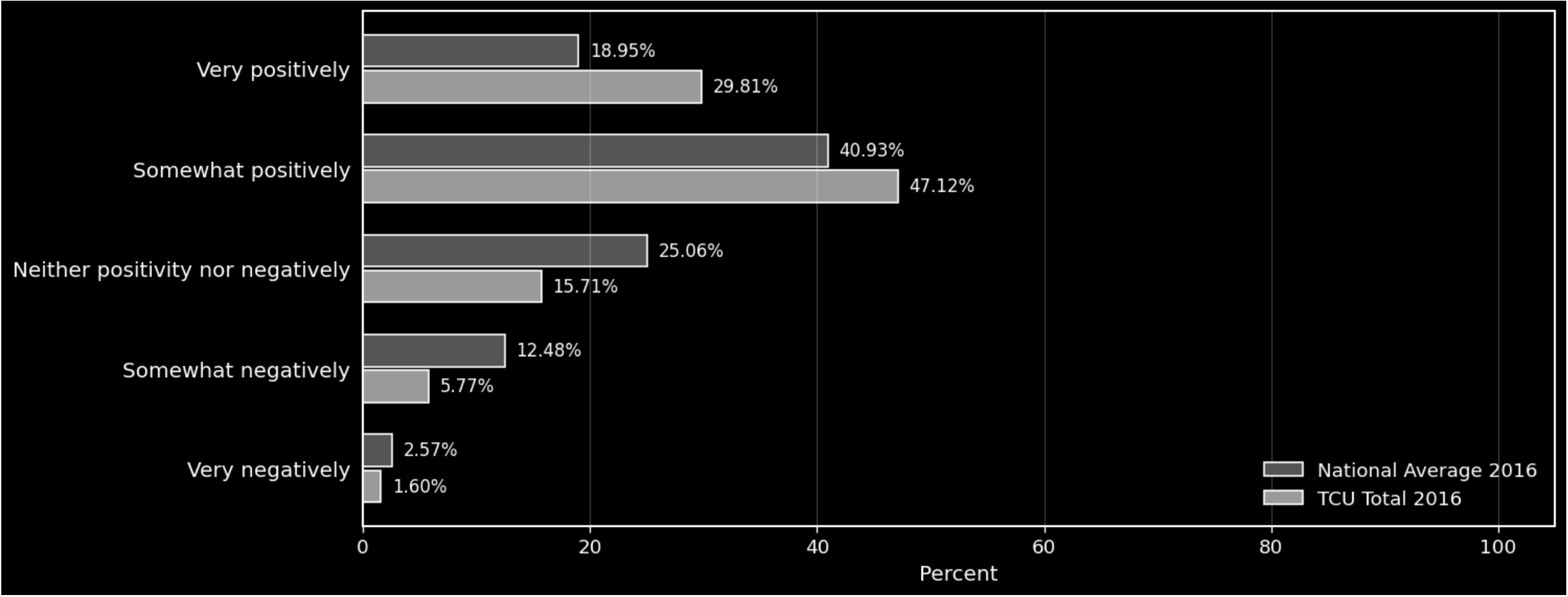

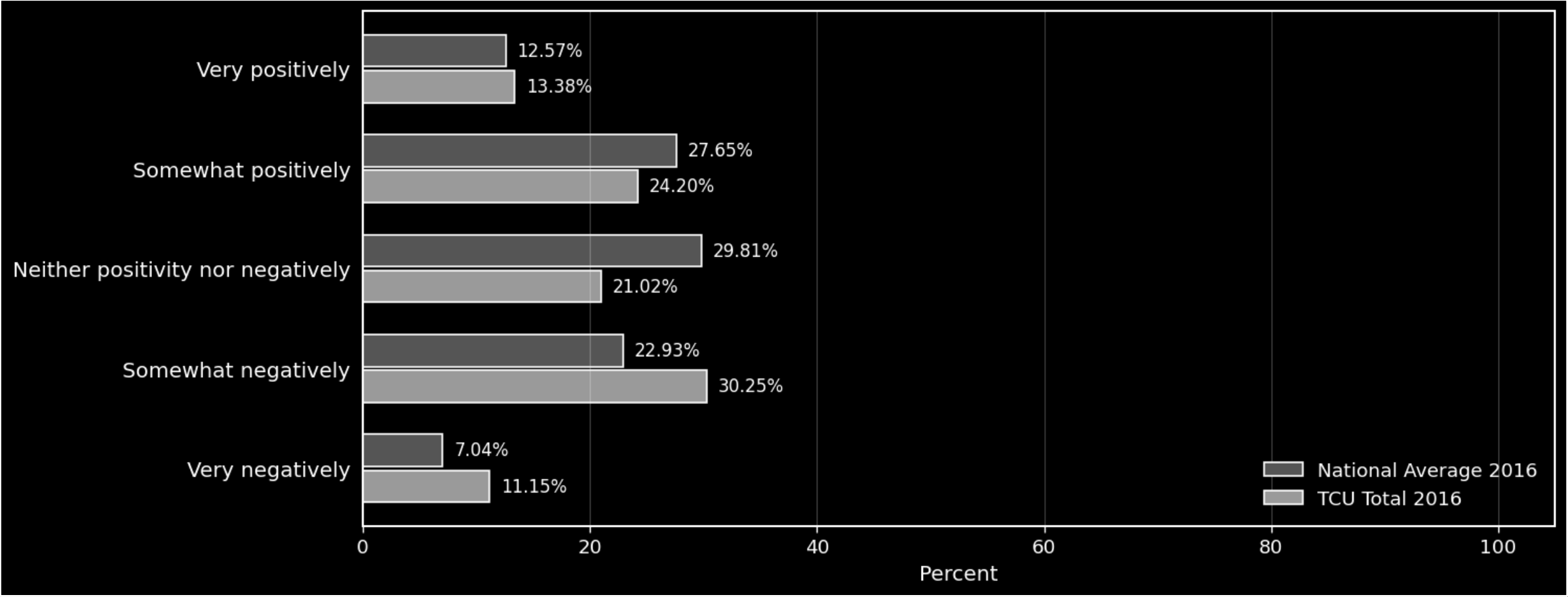


Chart 74. Approximately what percentage of members in your chapter drink alcohol? (Part 1 of 2)

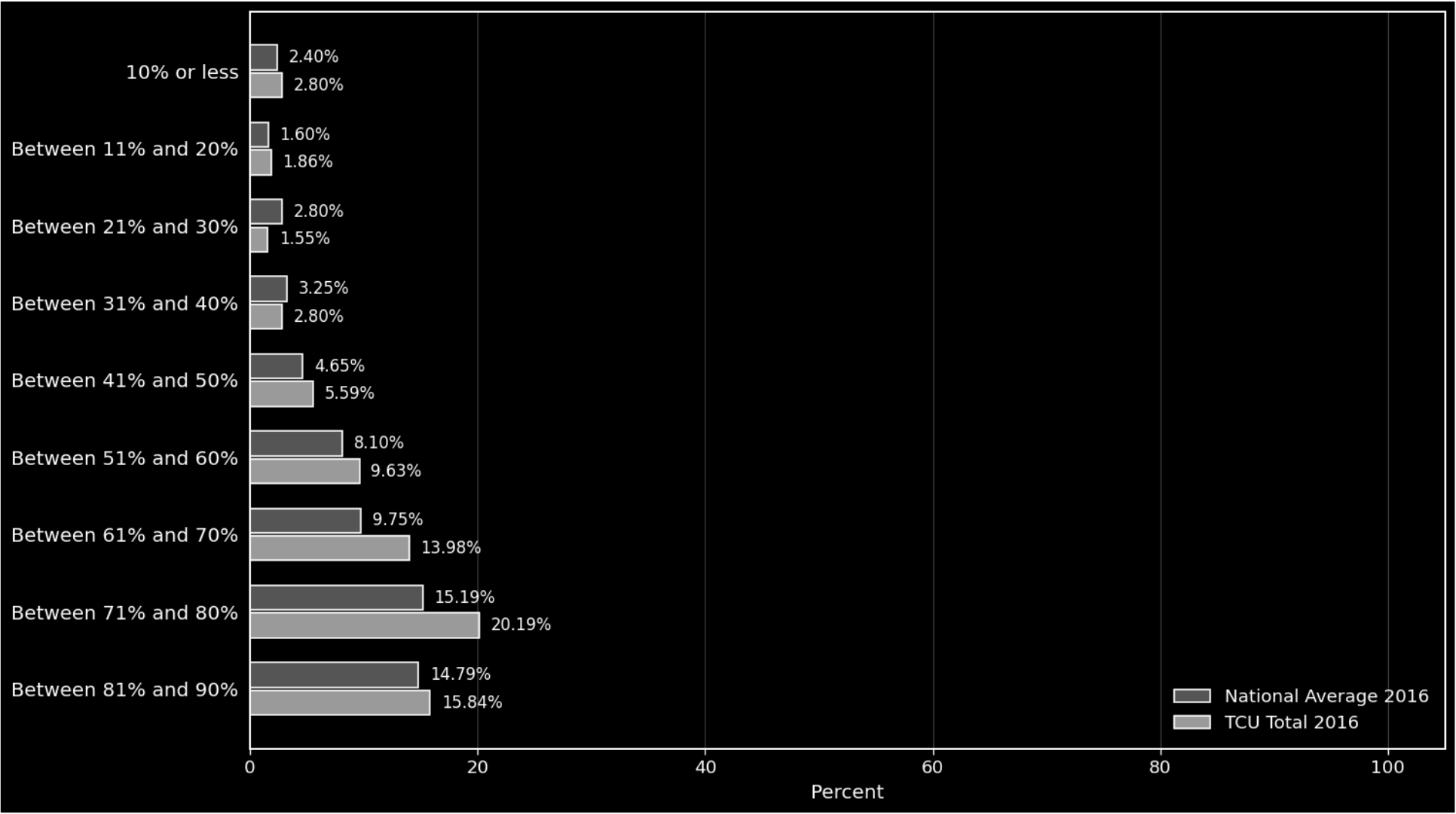


Chart 74. Approximately what percentage of members in your chapter drink alcohol? (Part 2 of 2)

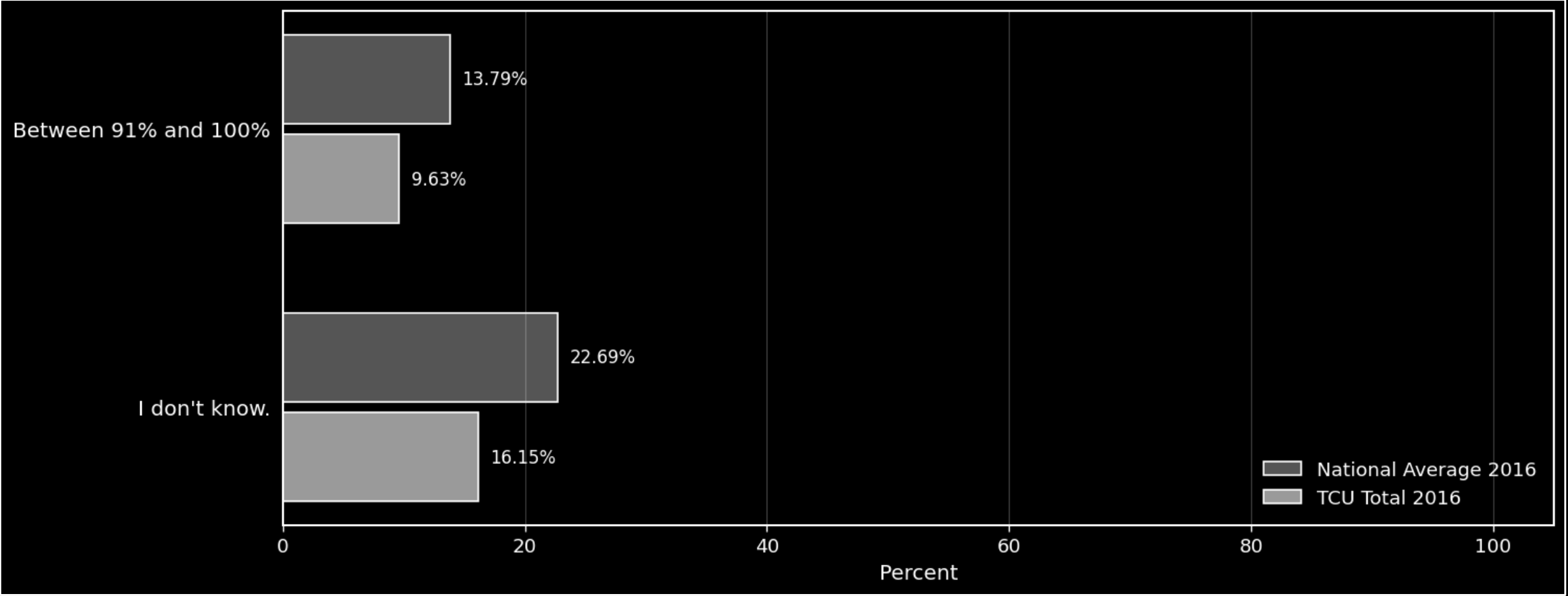


Chart 75. Of those in your chapter who drink alcohol, how often would you say that most drink? 0.67 1664 83.89% 0.59 287 86.76%

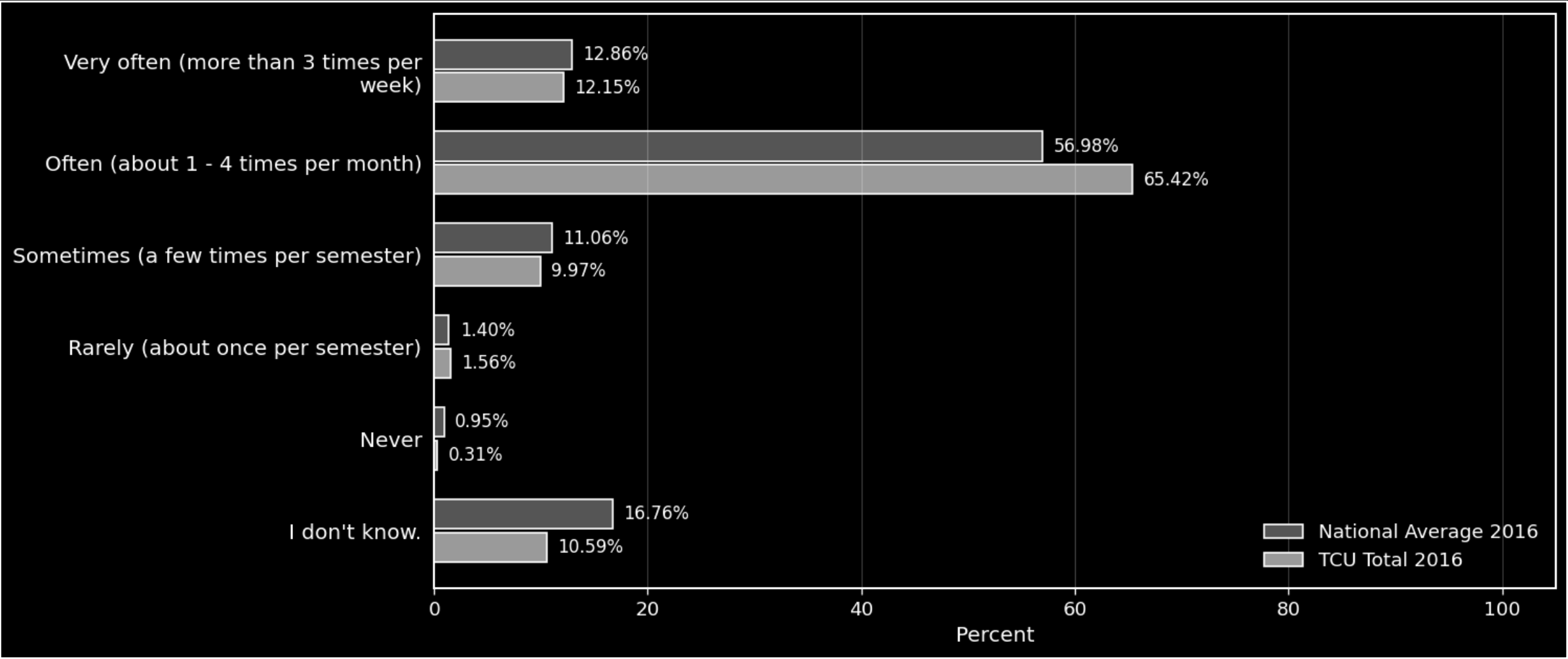

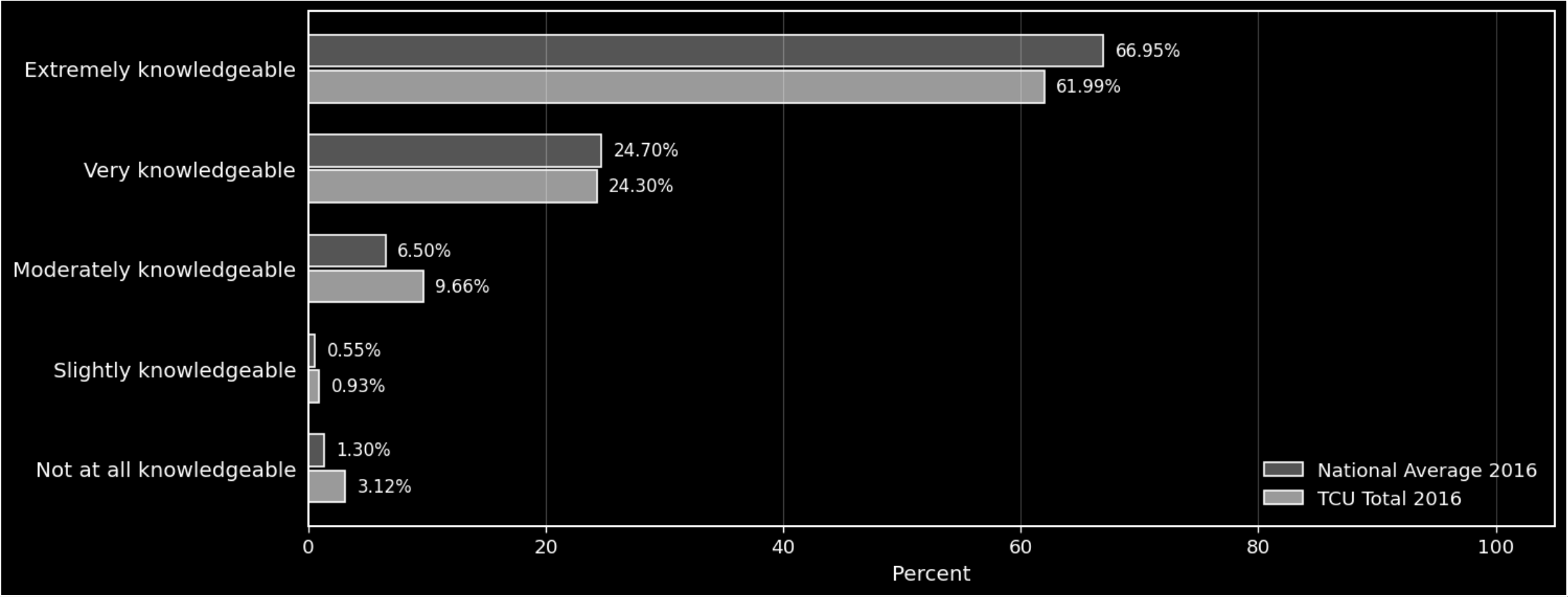


Chart 77. How often do hazing activities take place as part of your chapter's activities? 0.48 1935 1.45% 0.50 312 1.60%

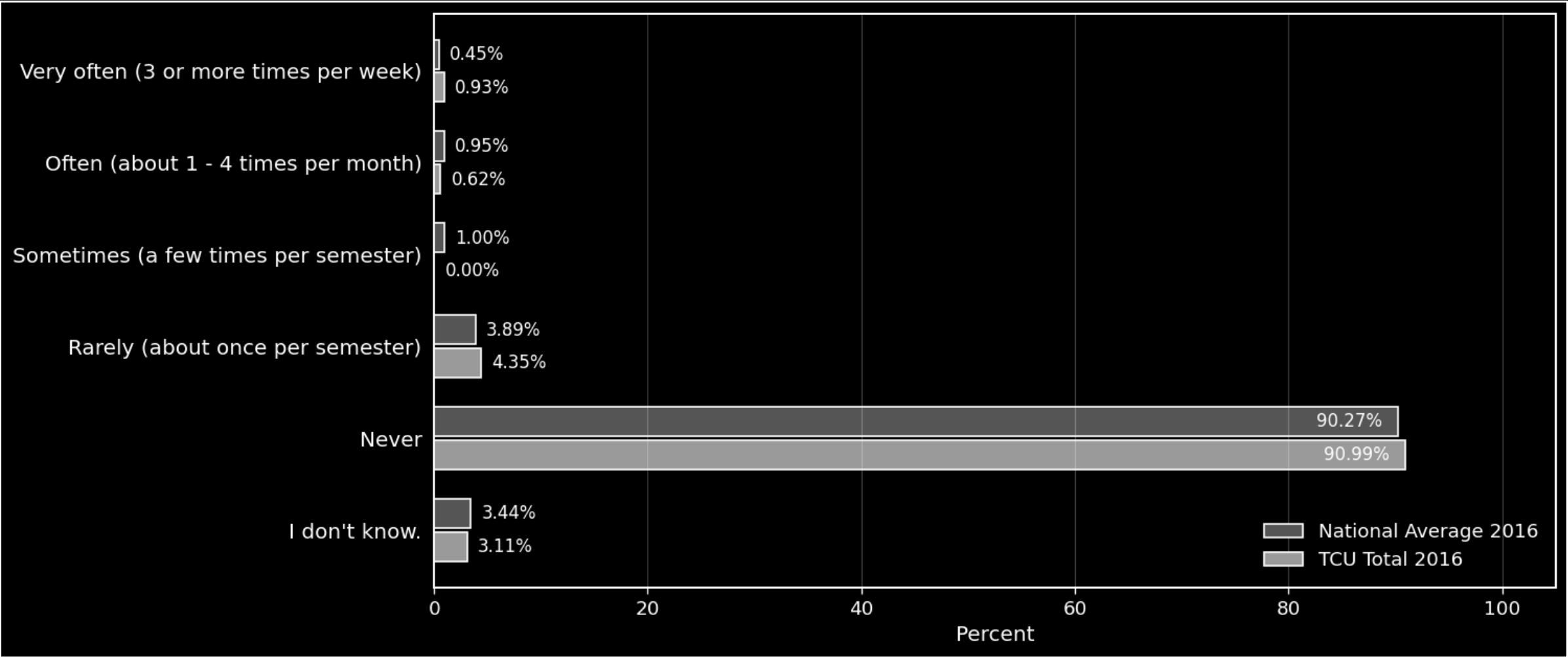


Chart 78. How often is hazing prevention discussed in your organization? 0.86 1951 56.18% 0.87 315 53.65%

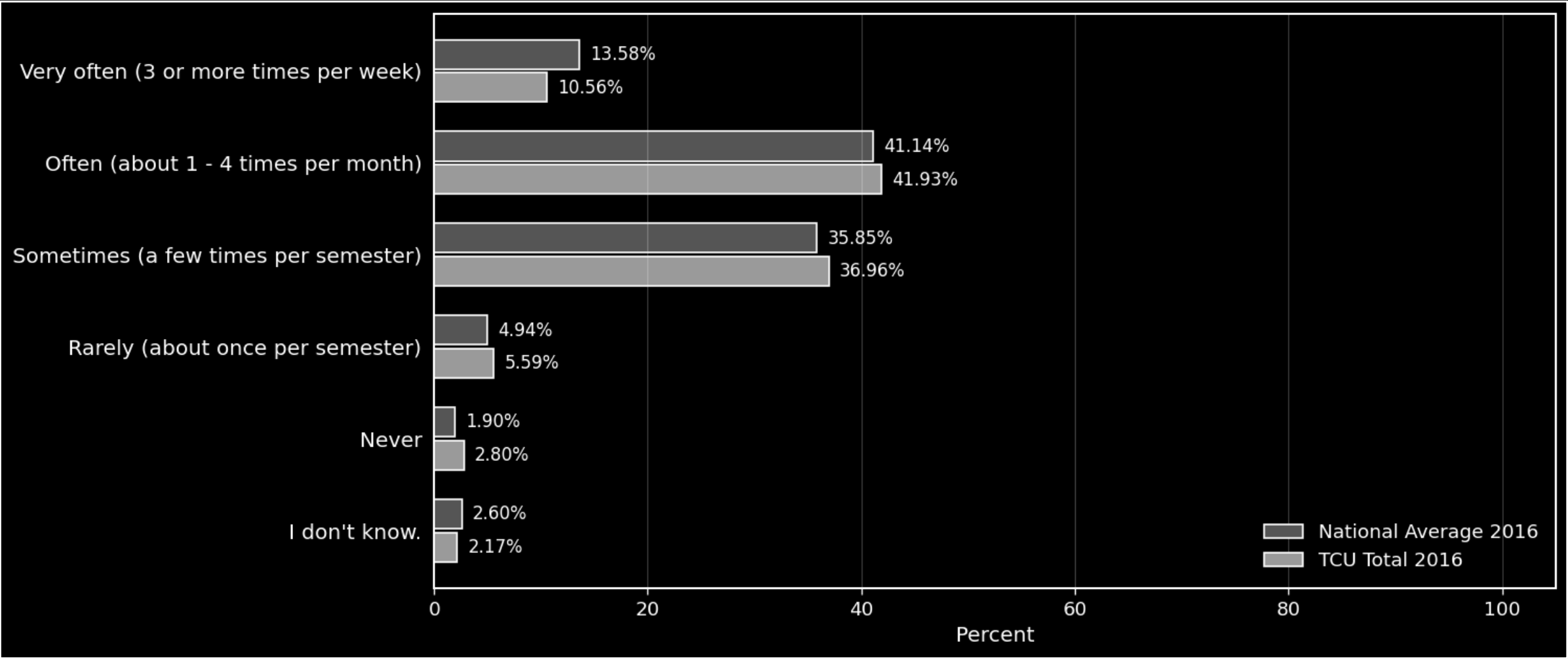


Chart 79. Generally, how do you perceive fraternities and sororities at this campus? 1.08 1450 24.07% 1.06 247 23.08%

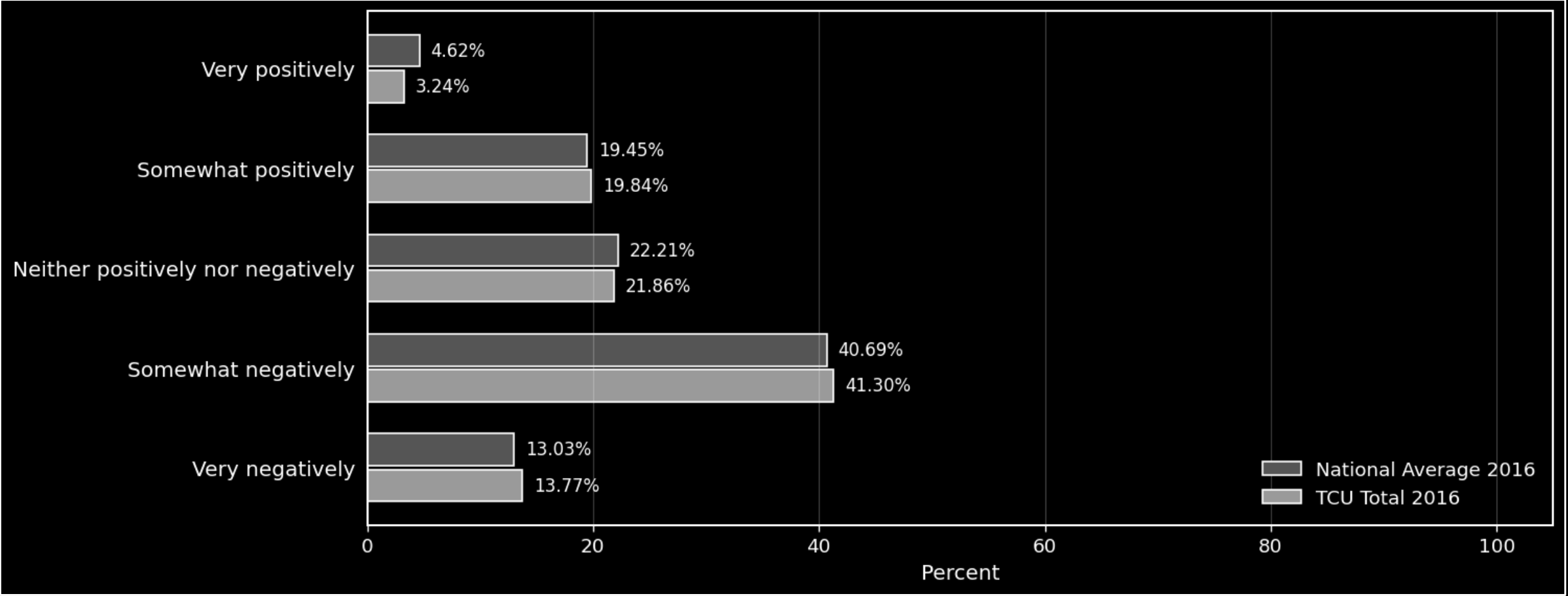


Chart 80. Upon which of the following do you base your perception of fraternities and sororities at this campus? (Check all that apply) (Part 1 of 3)

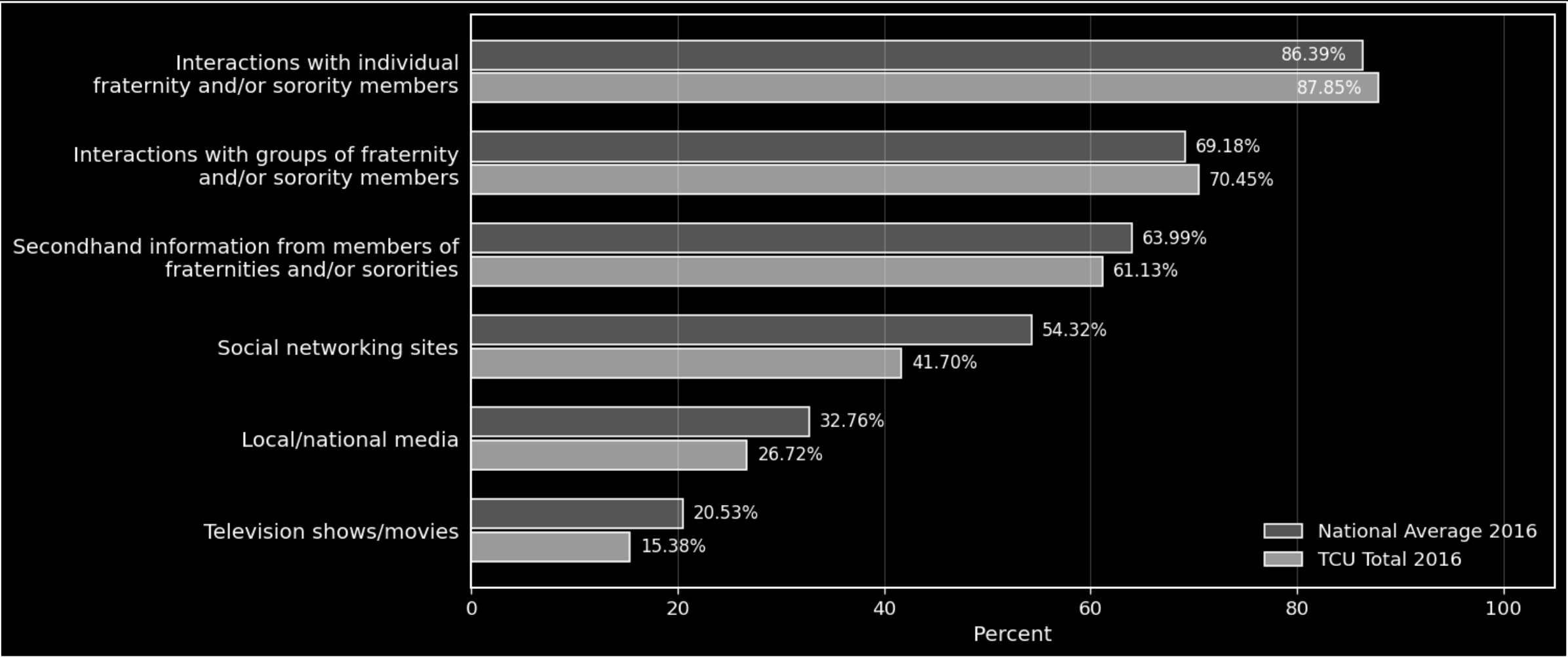


Chart 80. Upon which of the following do you base your perception of fraternities and sororities at this campus? (Check all that apply) (Part 2 of 3)

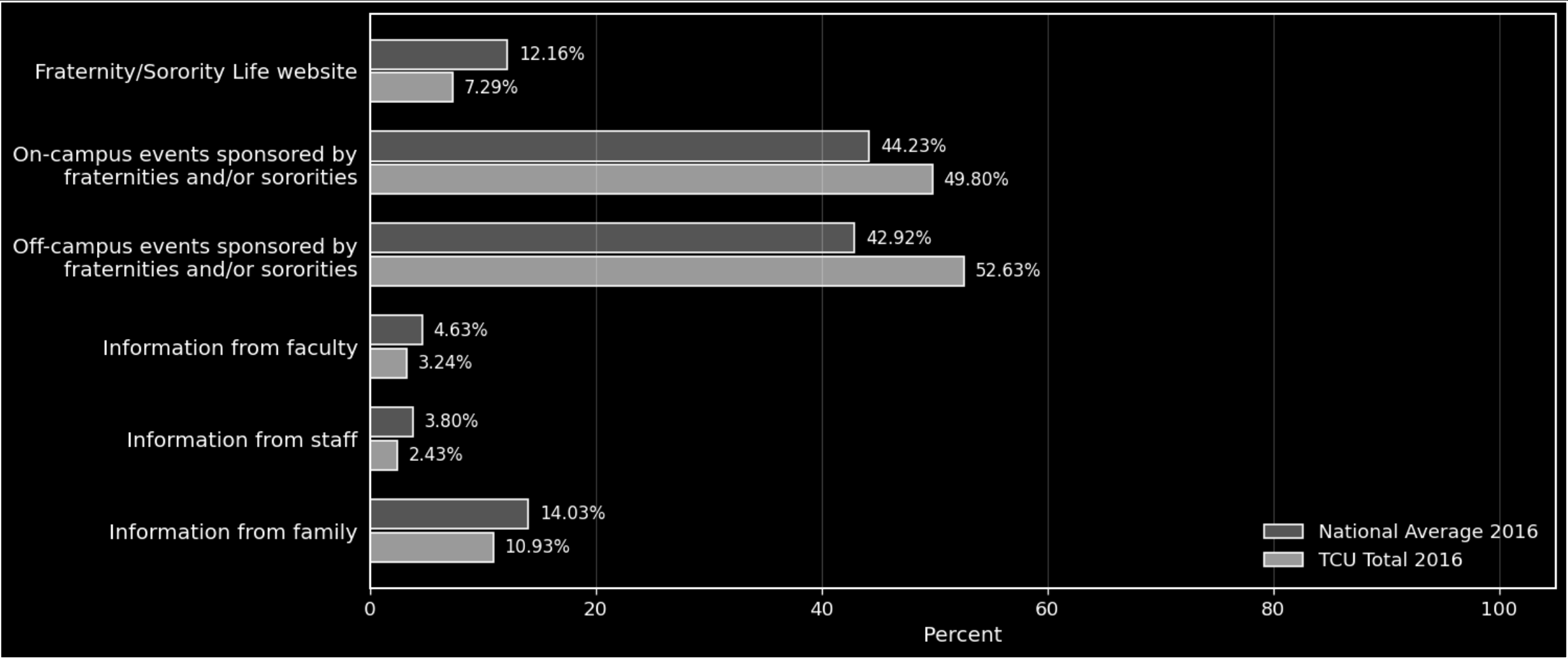


Chart 80. Upon which of the following do you base your perception of fraternities and sororities at this campus? (Check all that apply) (Part 3 of 3)

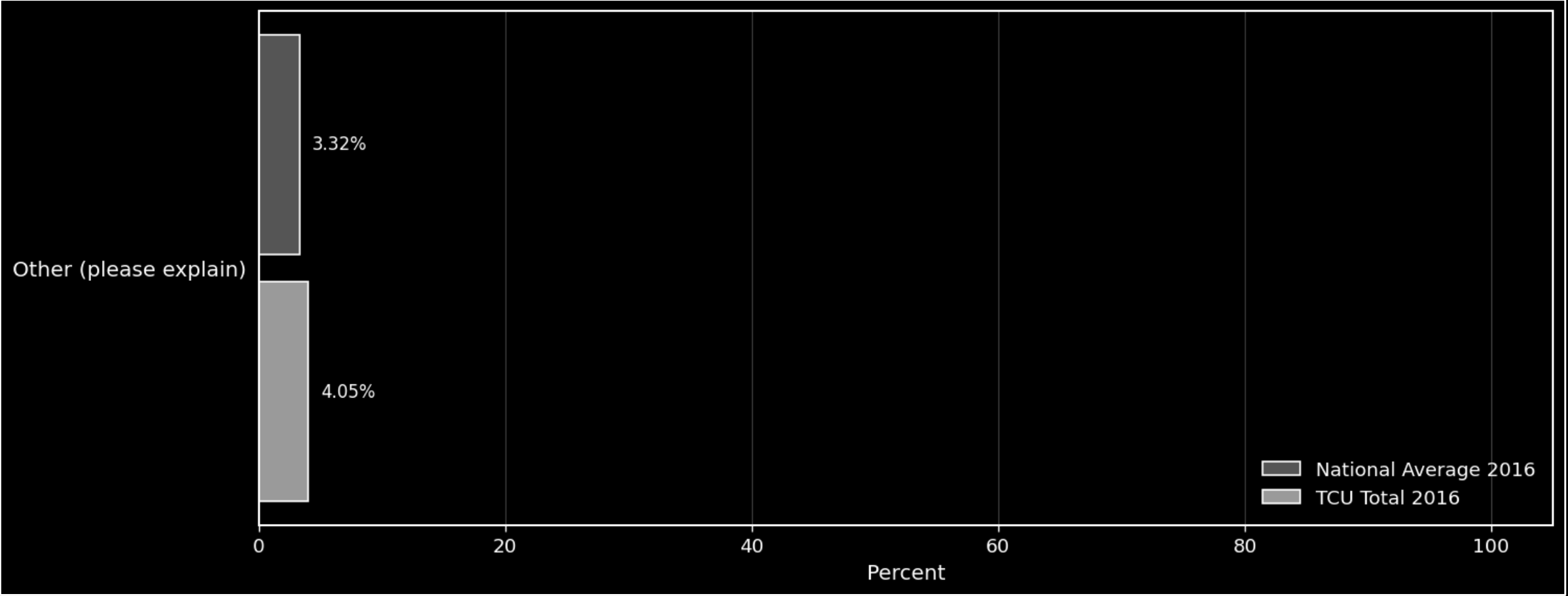


Chart 81. How many structured programs/events (e.g., speakers, philanthropy-related) hosted by fraternities and sororities do you attend per semester?

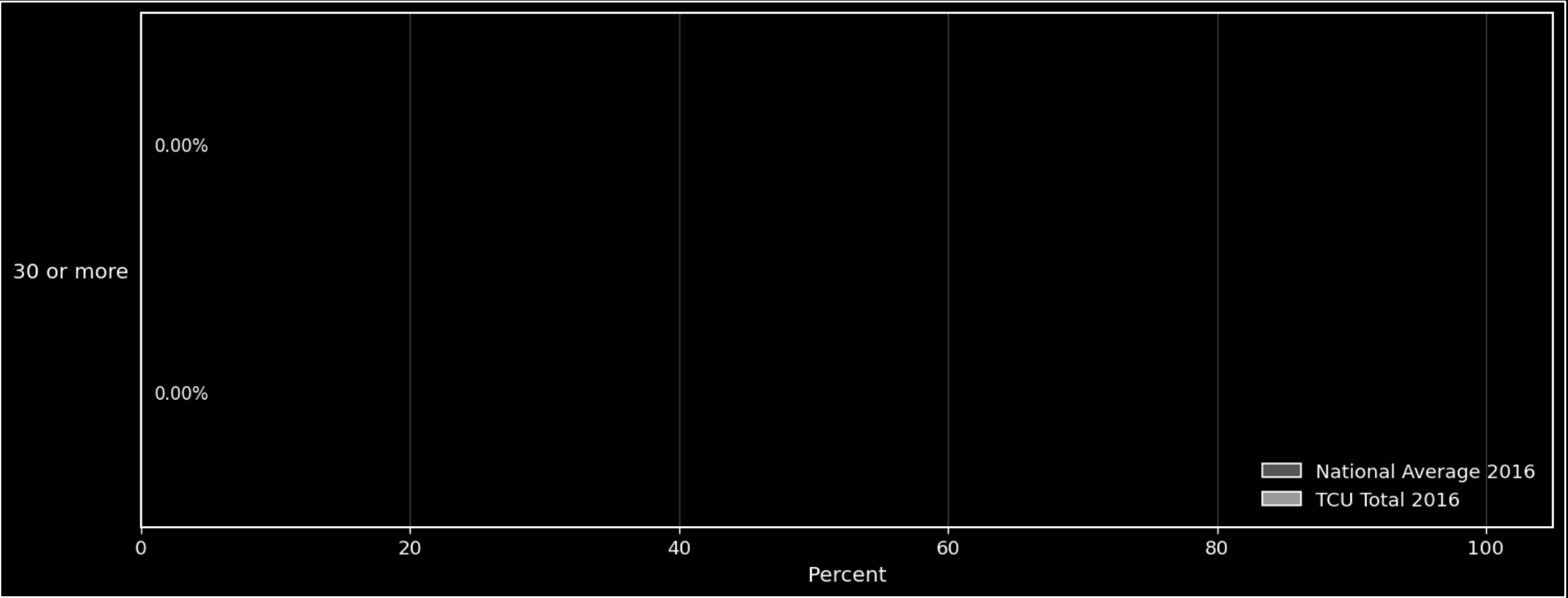


Chart 82. How many social events/parties hosted by fraternities and sororities do you attend per semester?

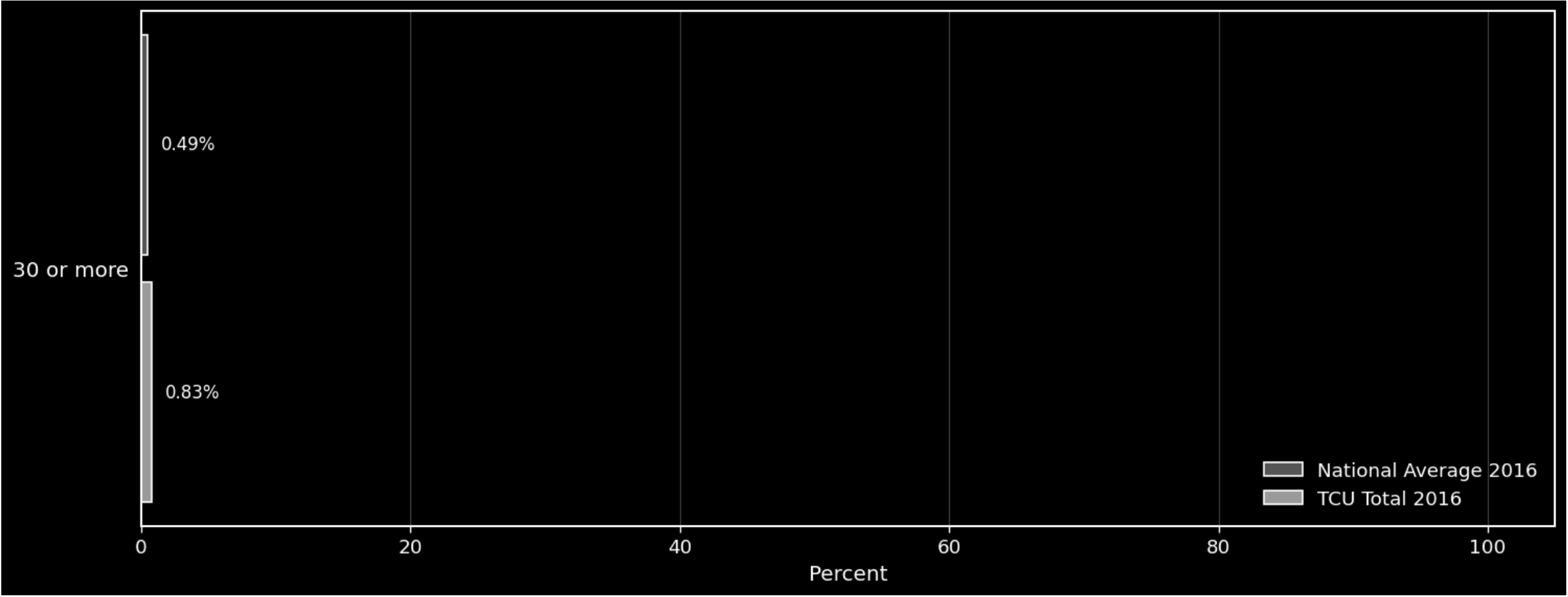


Chart 83. How many times per week do you interact with members of fraternities and sororities at this institution? N Top 1 Bottom 1 Rank 1.08 396 25.25%

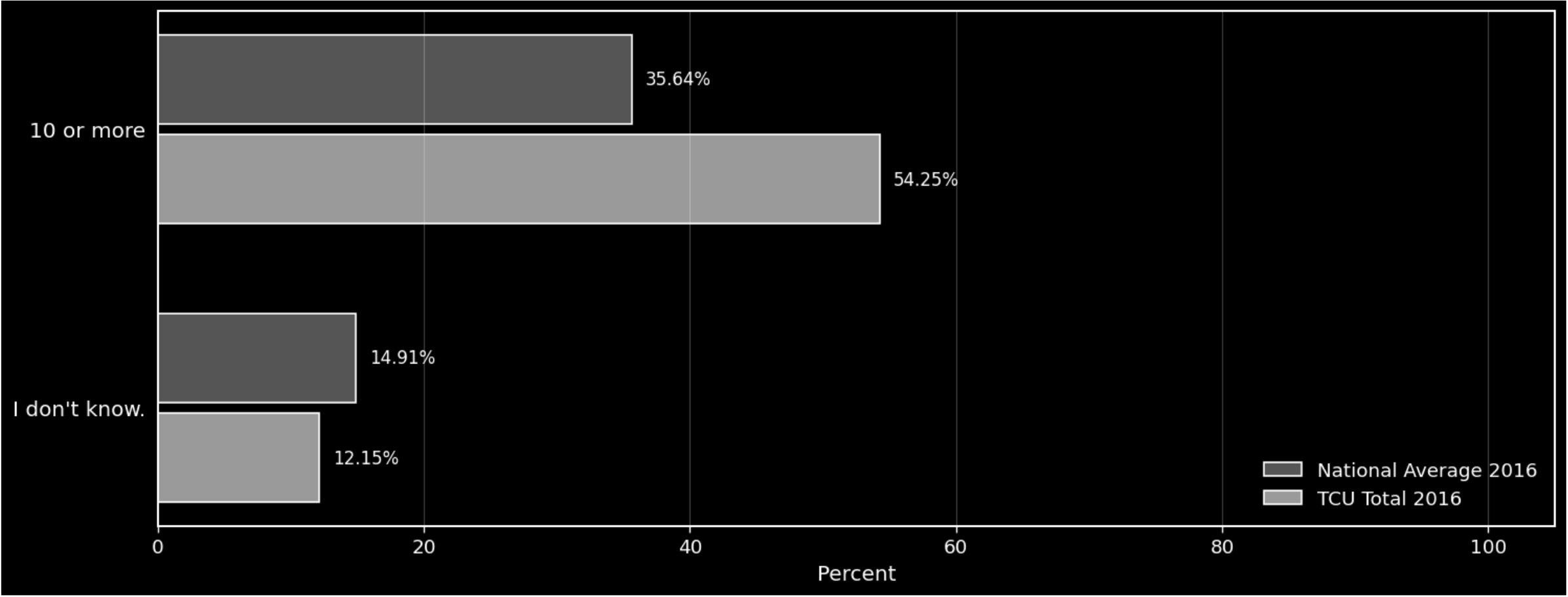


Chart 84. How involved do you feel fraternities and sororities are on your campus? 1.15 1440 62.29% 1.23 246 60.16%

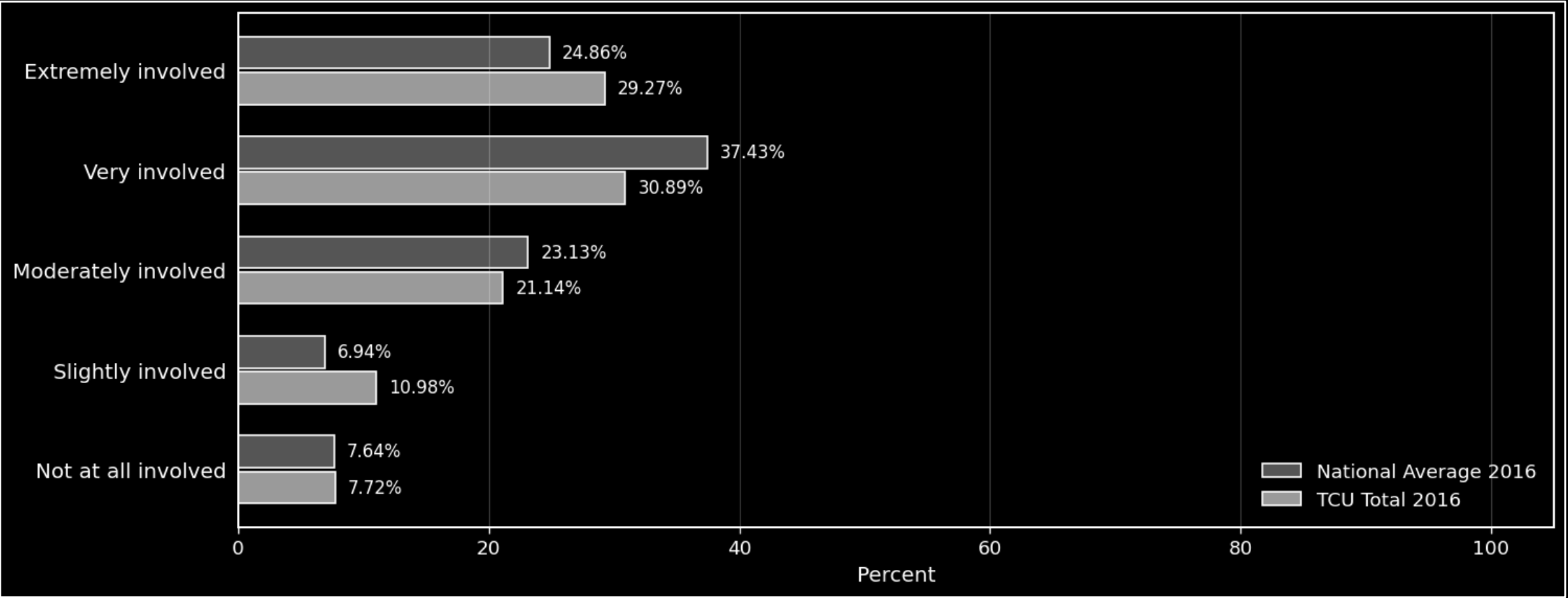

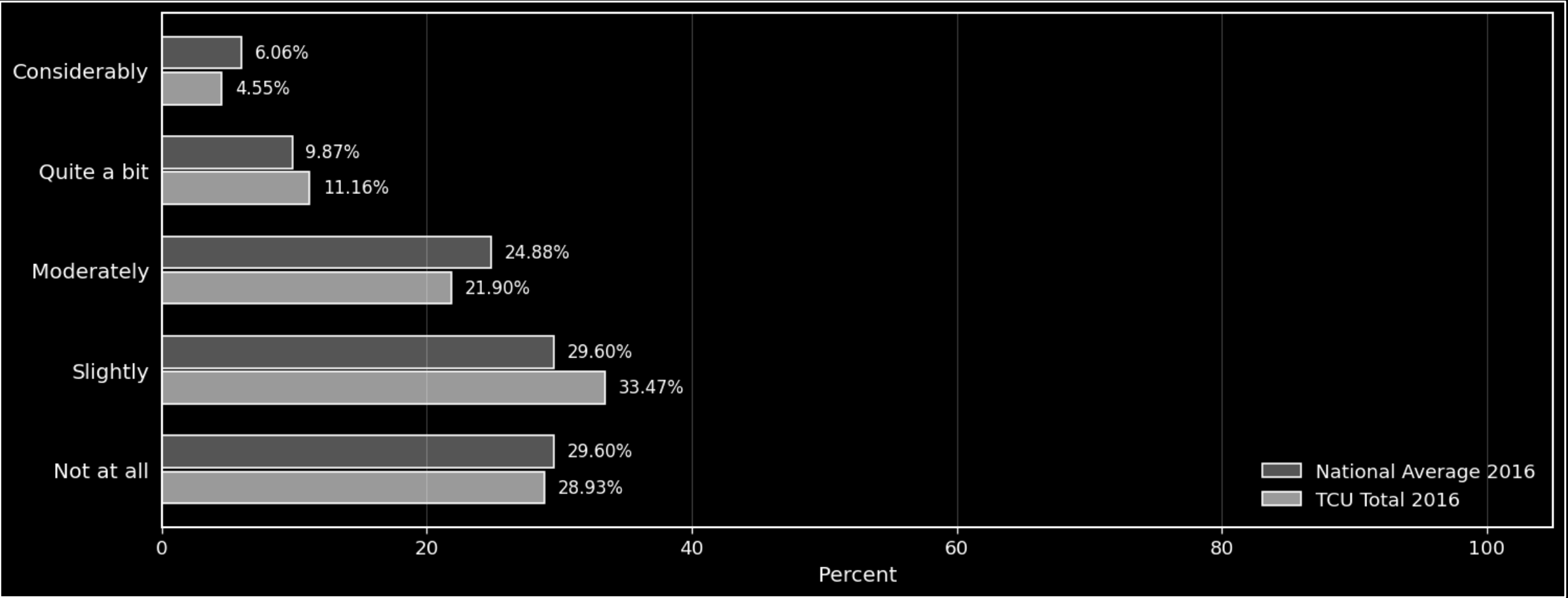

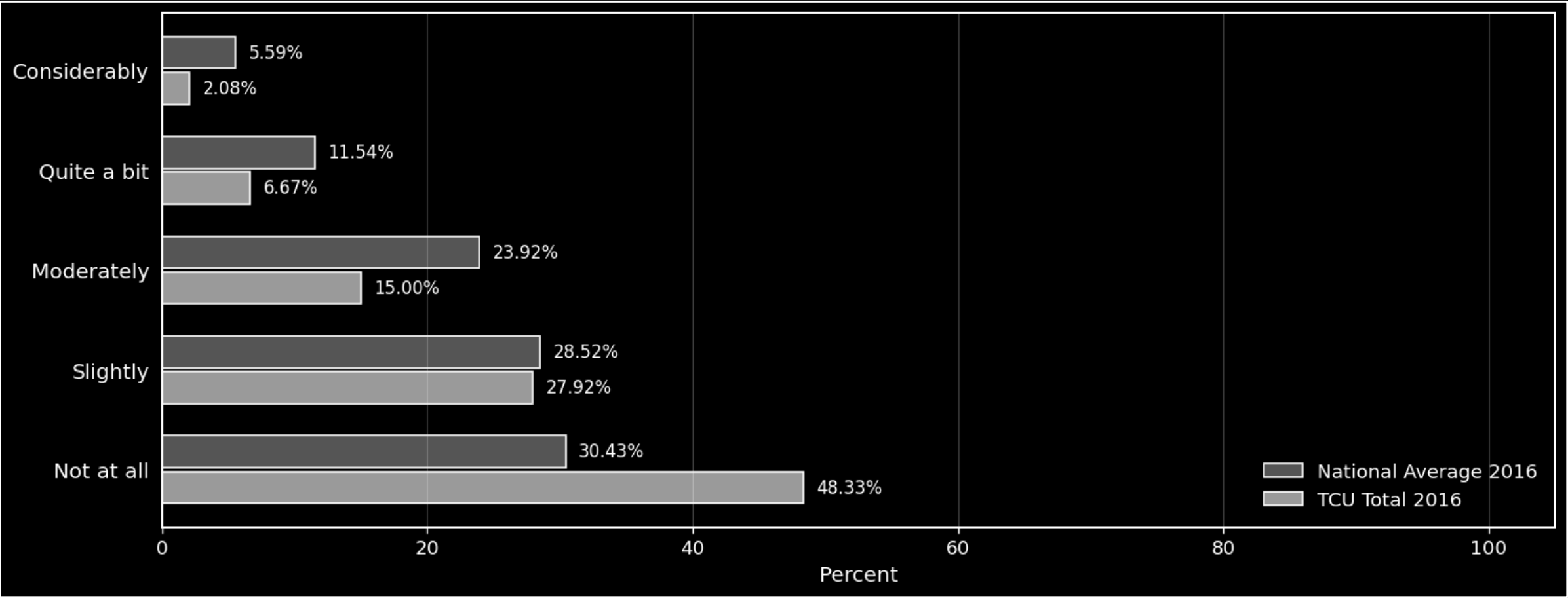

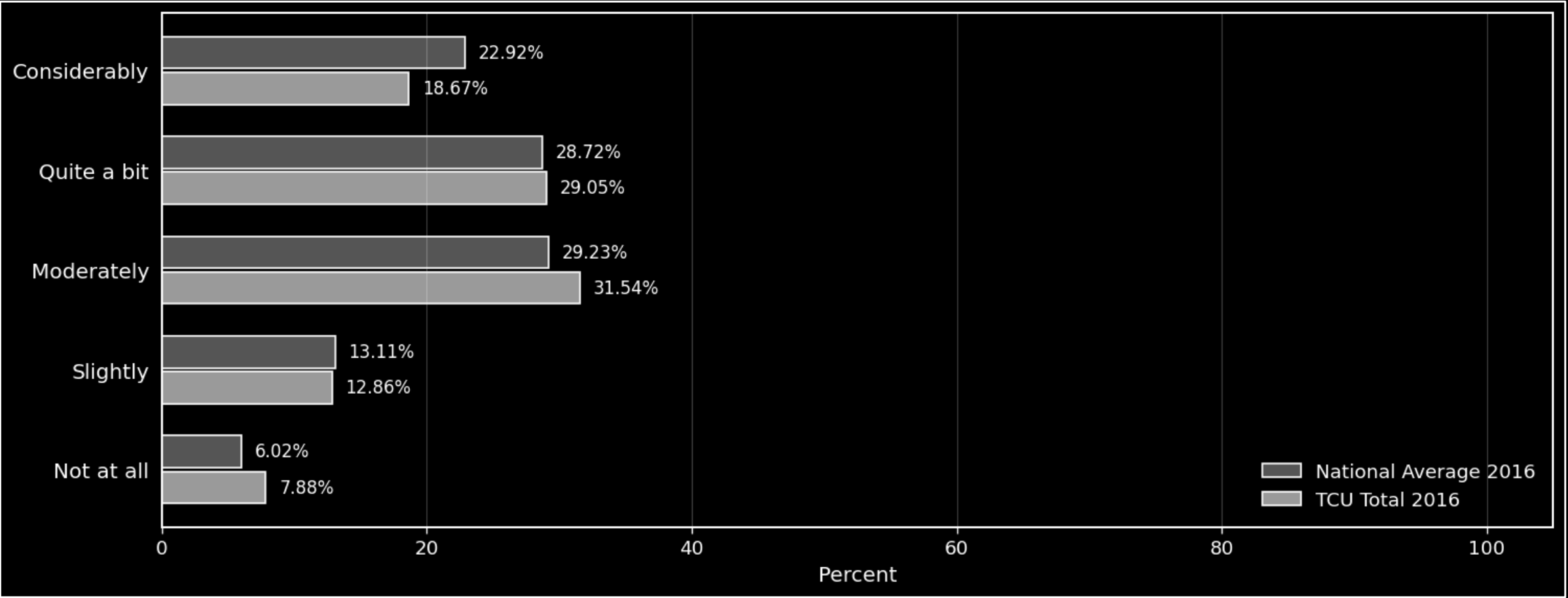

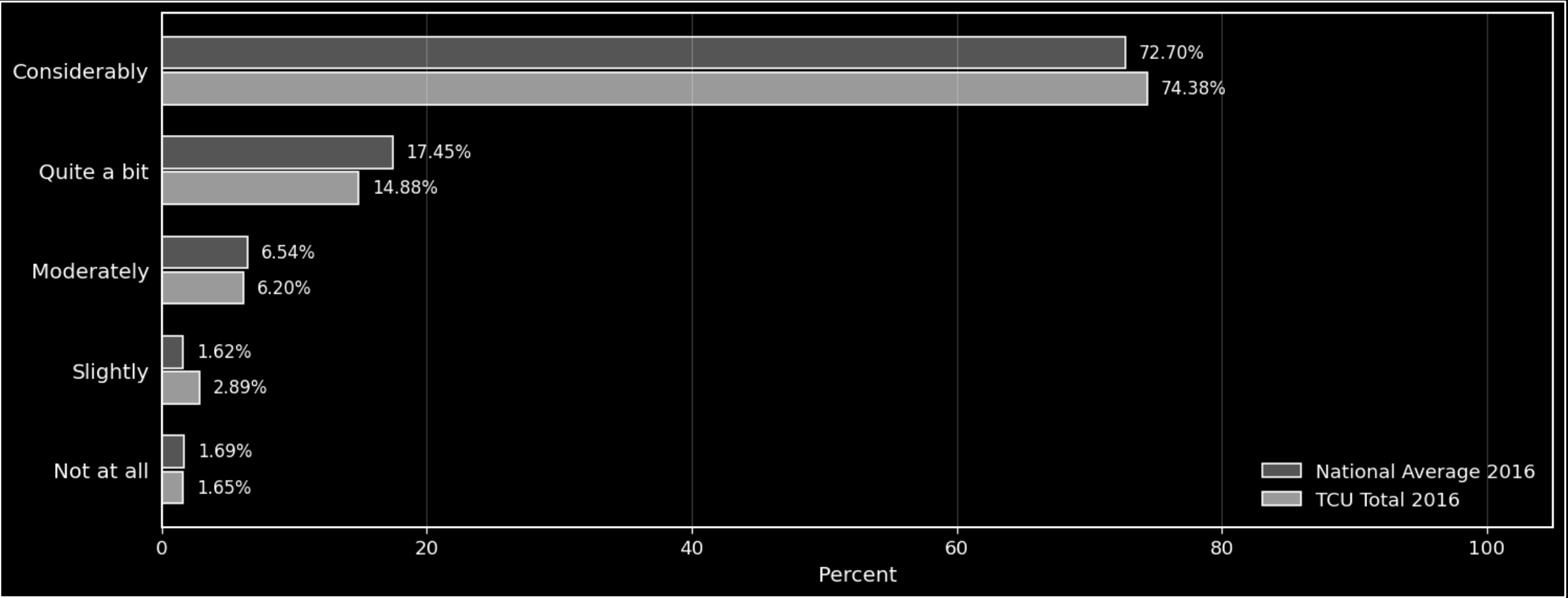

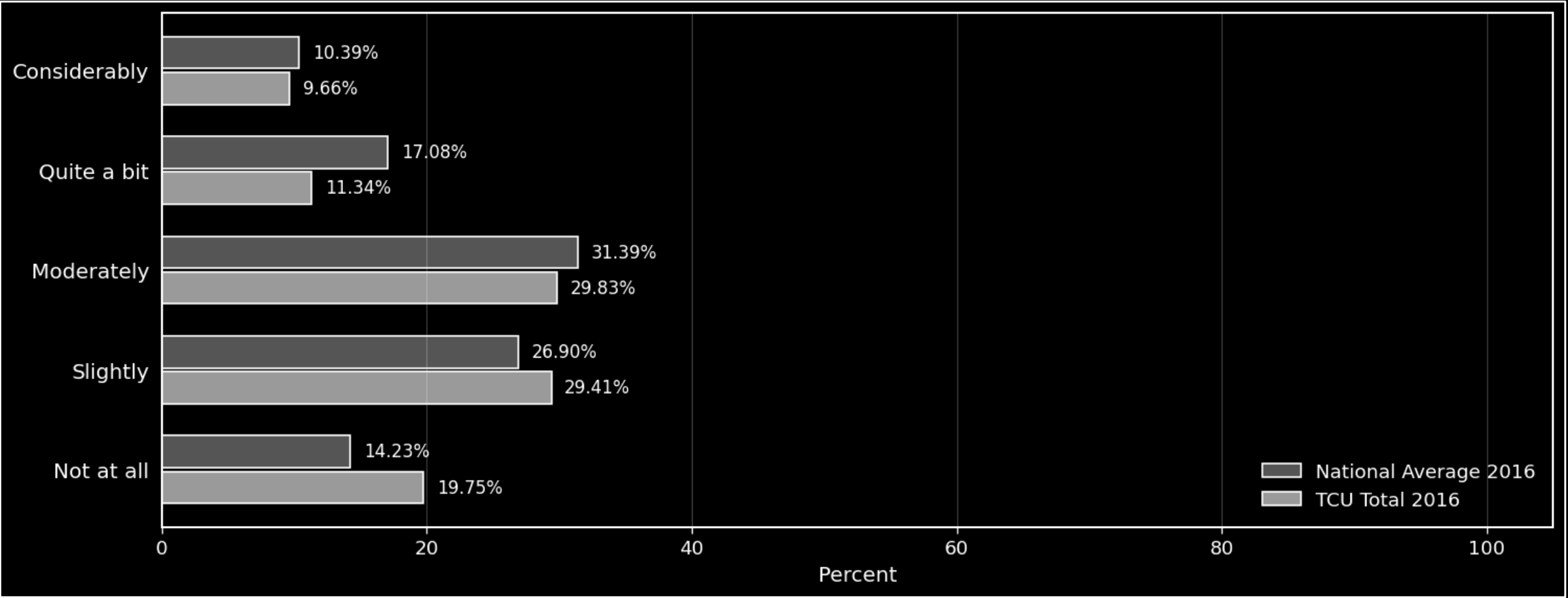

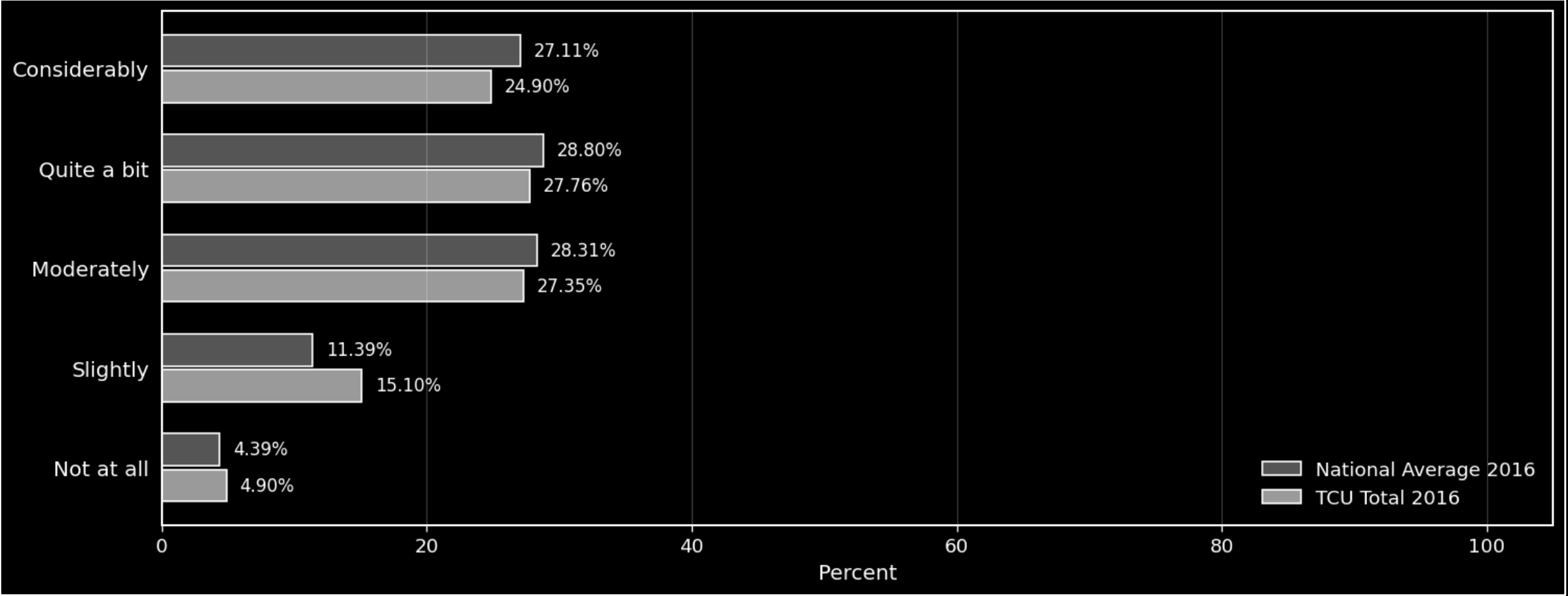

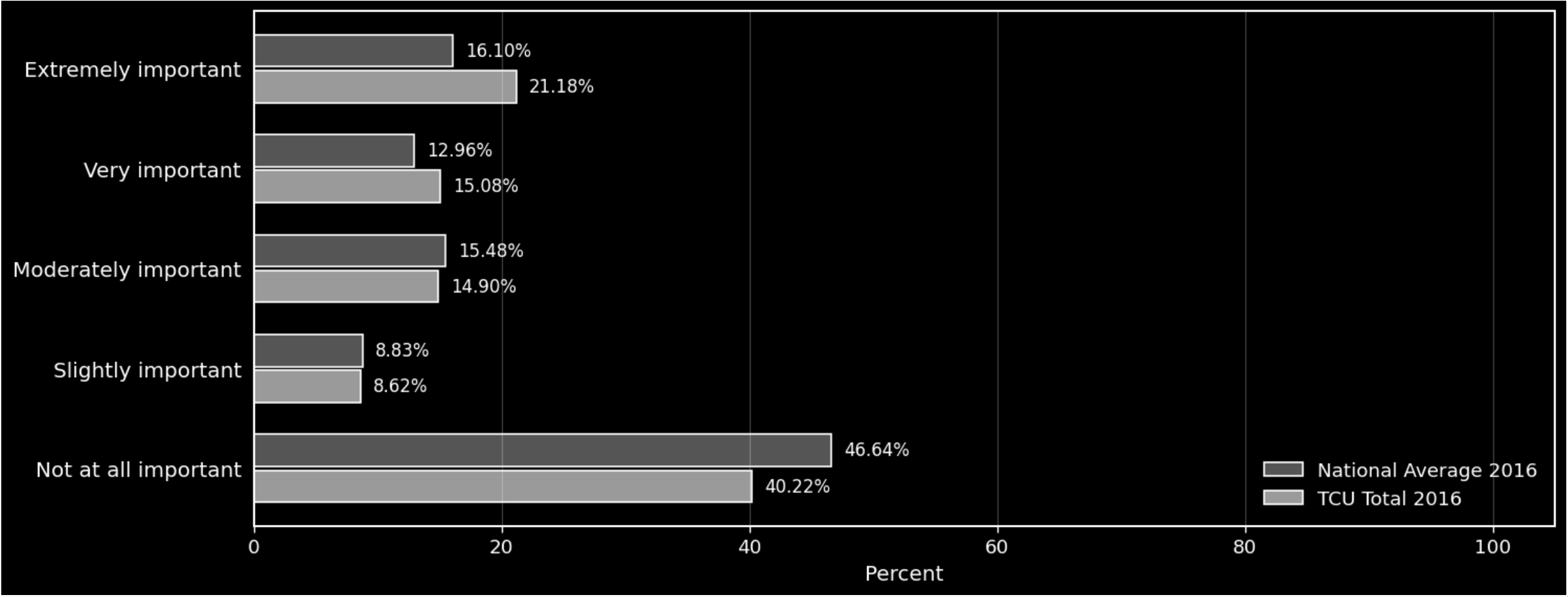


Chart 92. Please indicate your level of satisfaction with your social life on campus: 0.98 3371 82.17% 1.07 560 79.64%

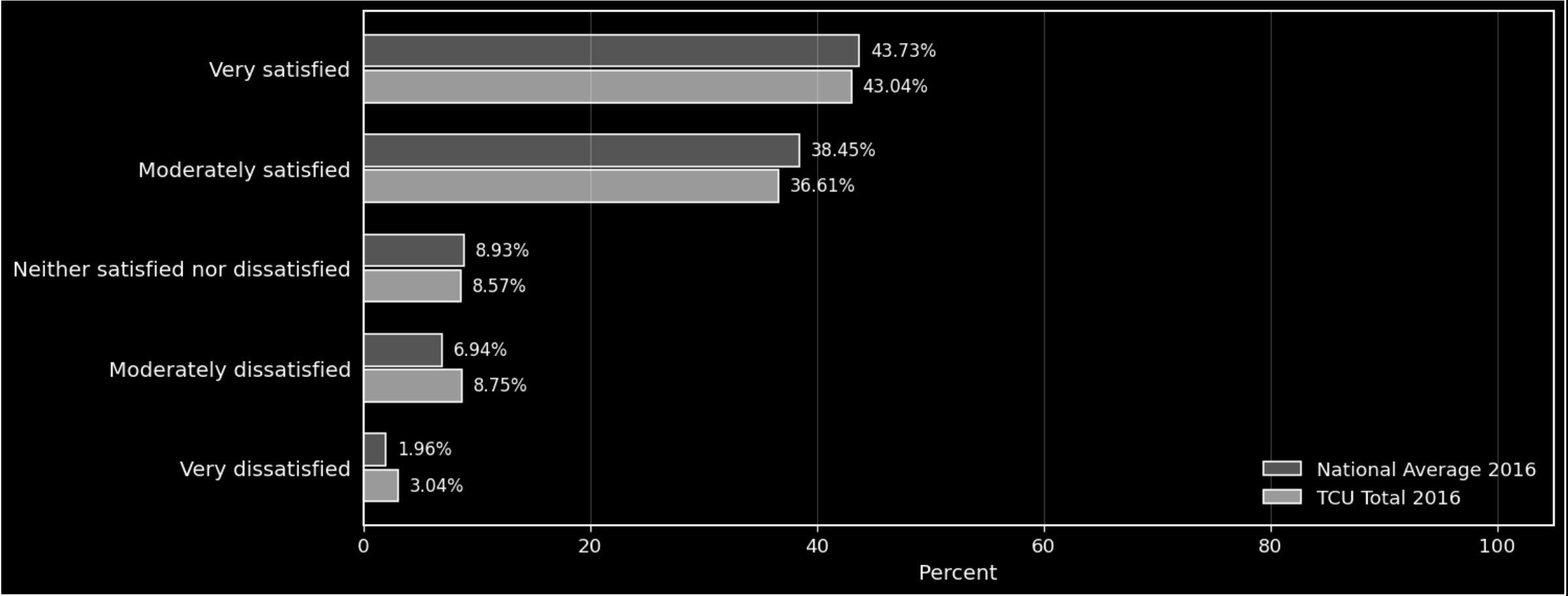

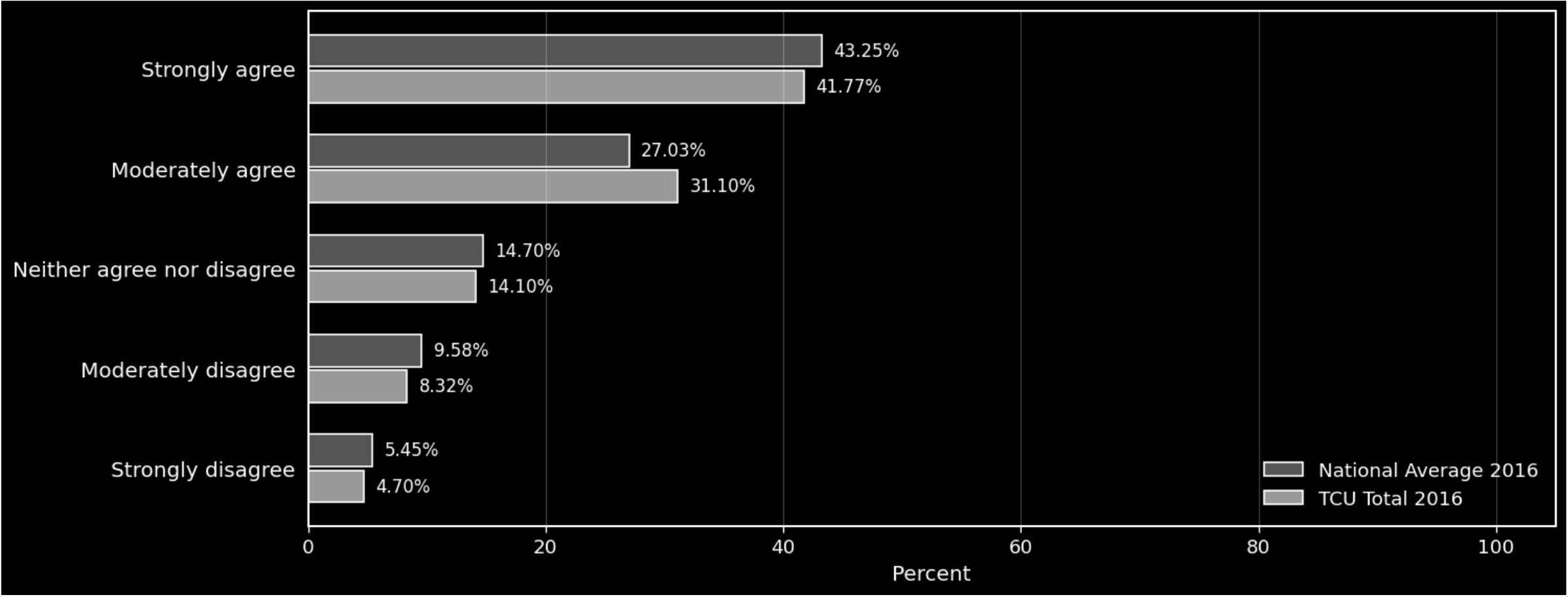

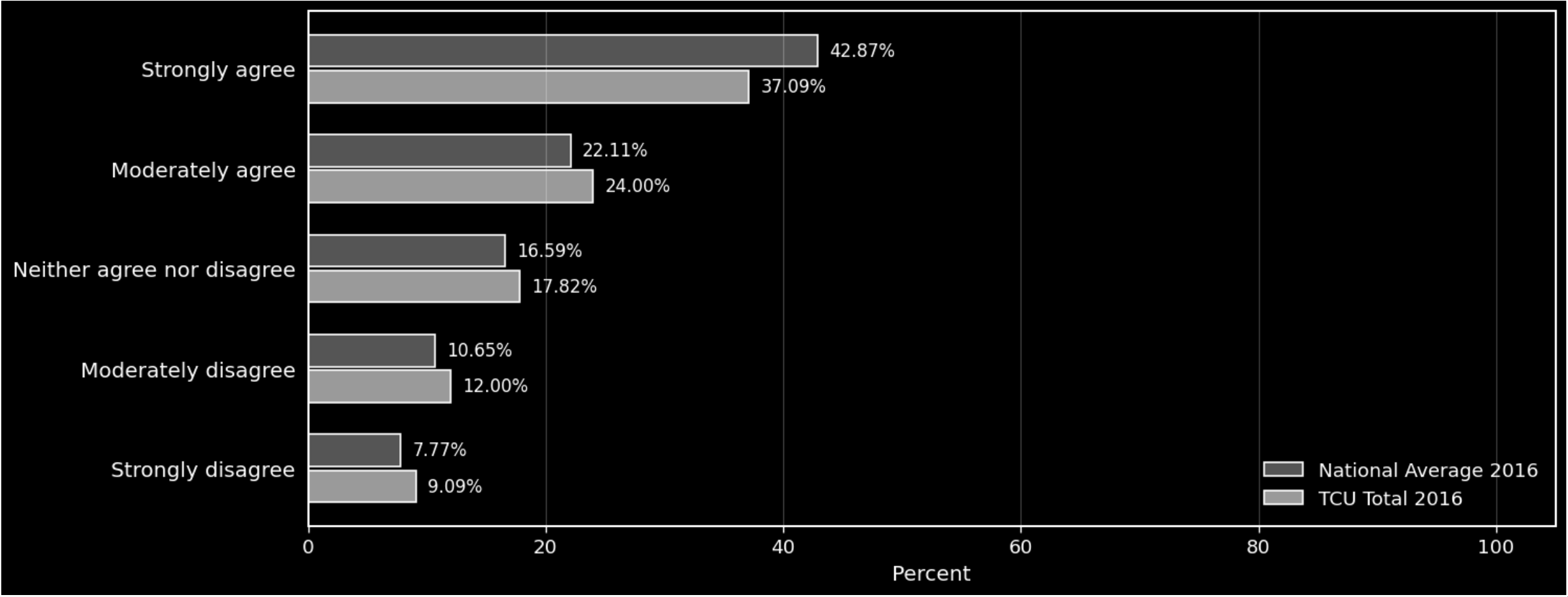

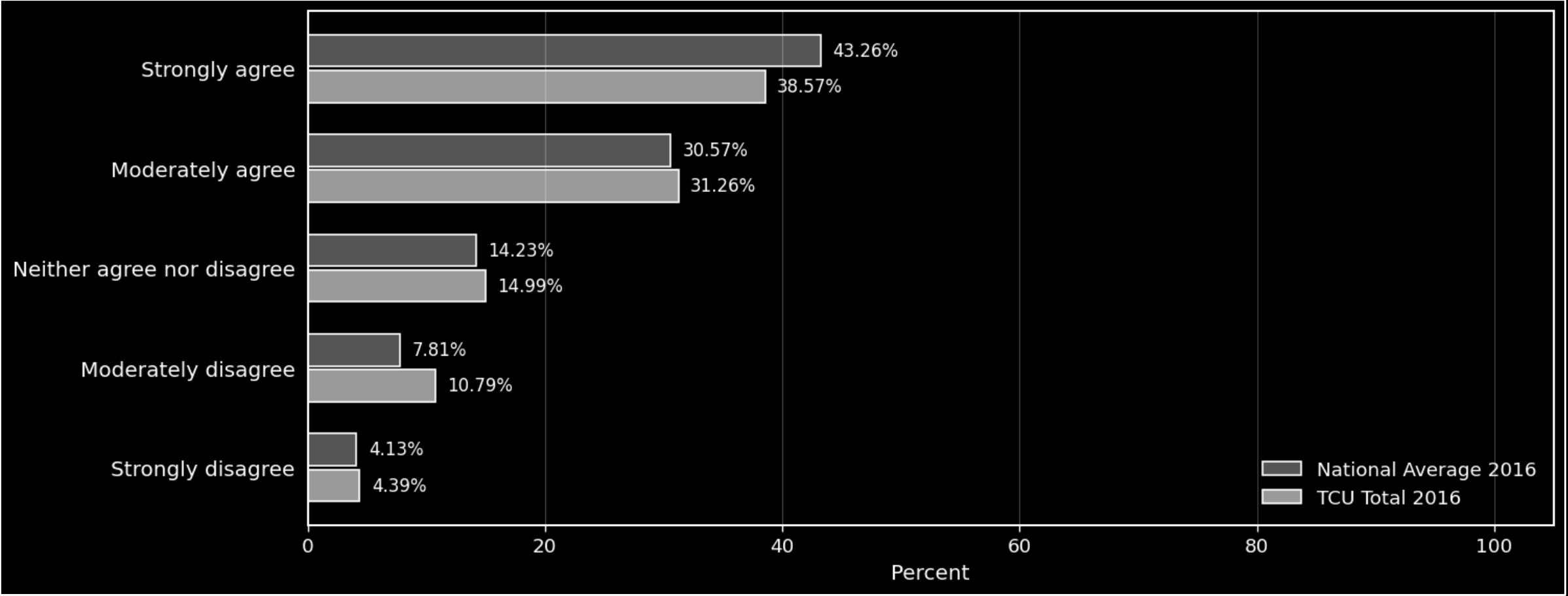

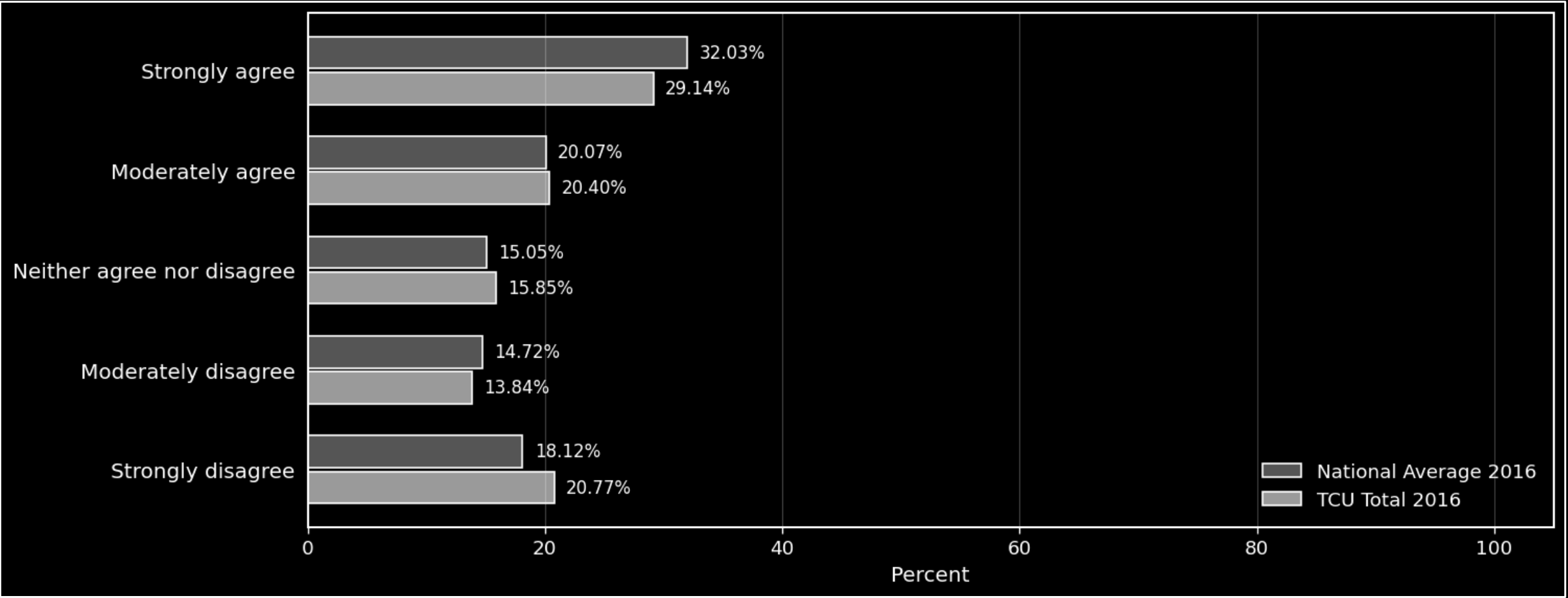
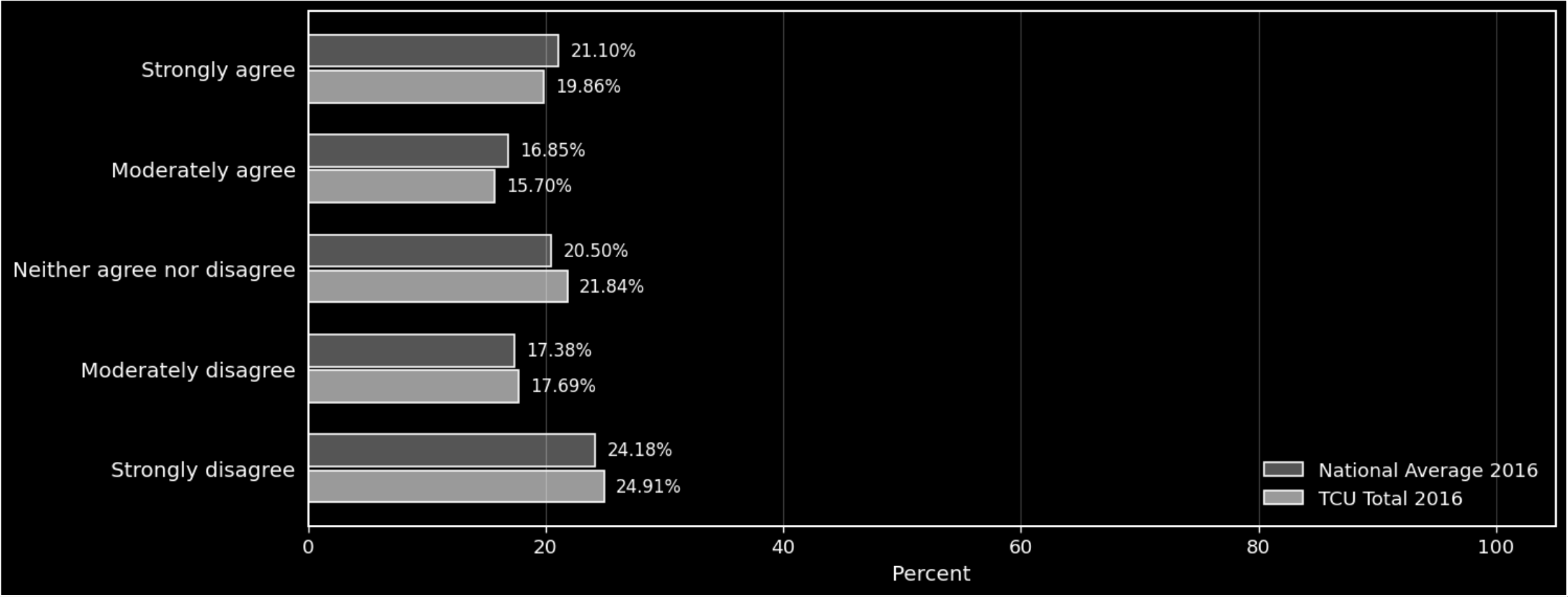

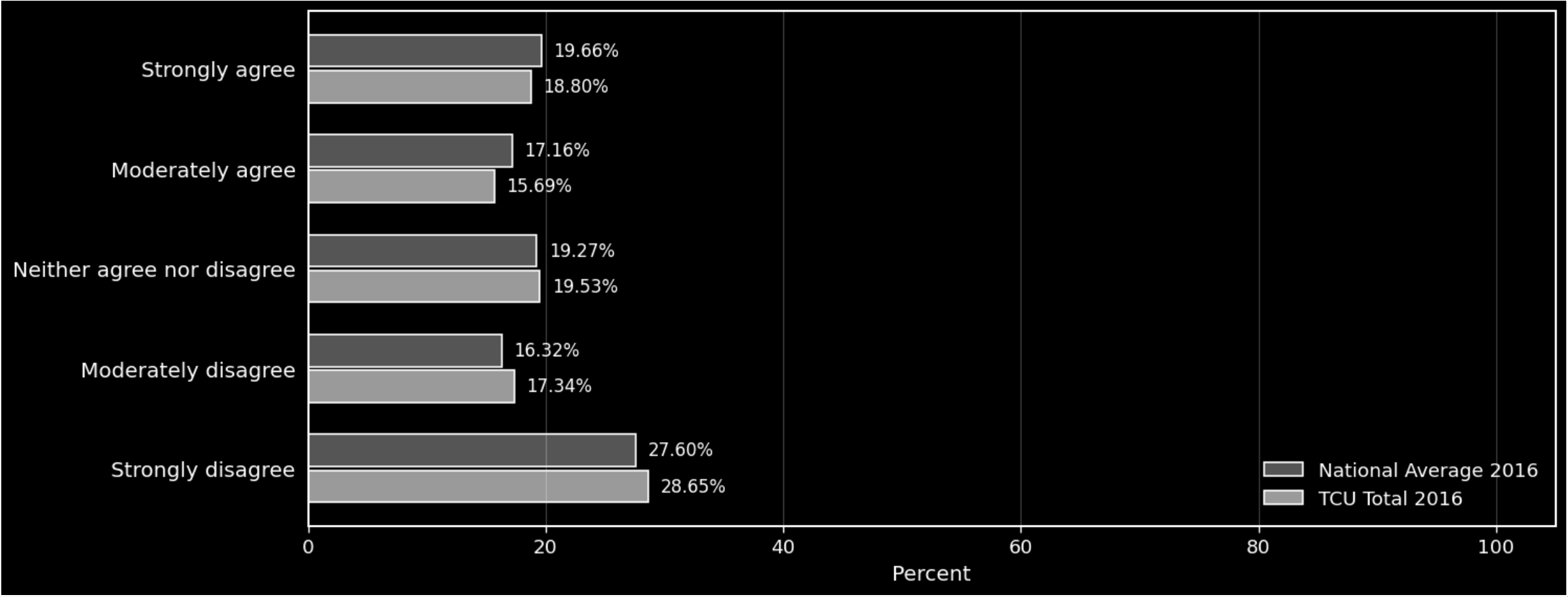

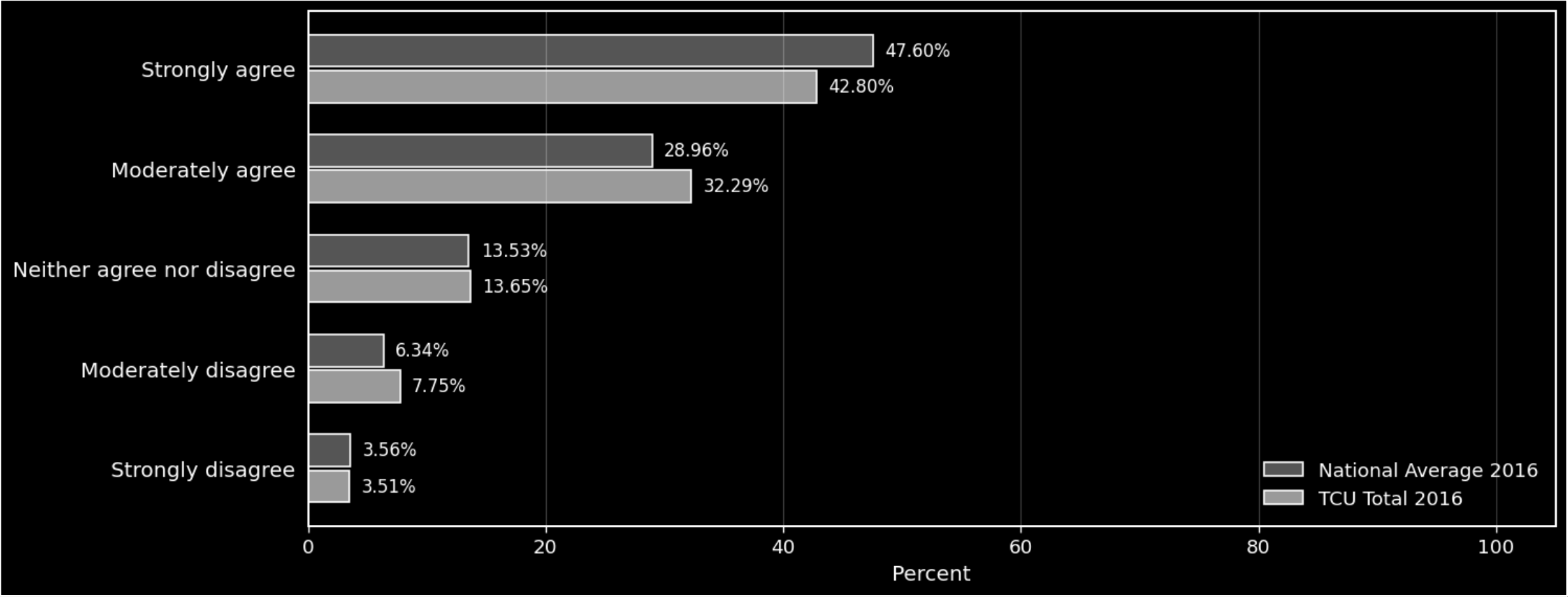

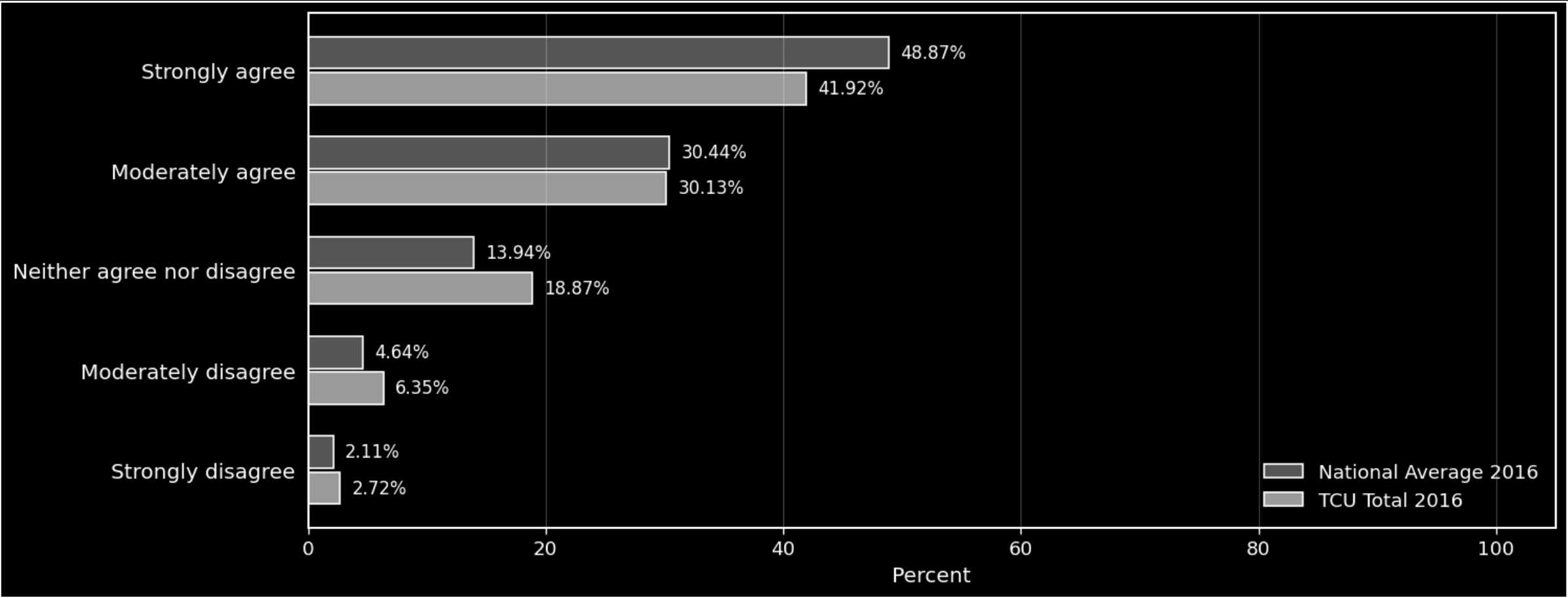


Chart 101. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following: Fraternities and sororities . . . - Provide positive social opportunities for students 1.04

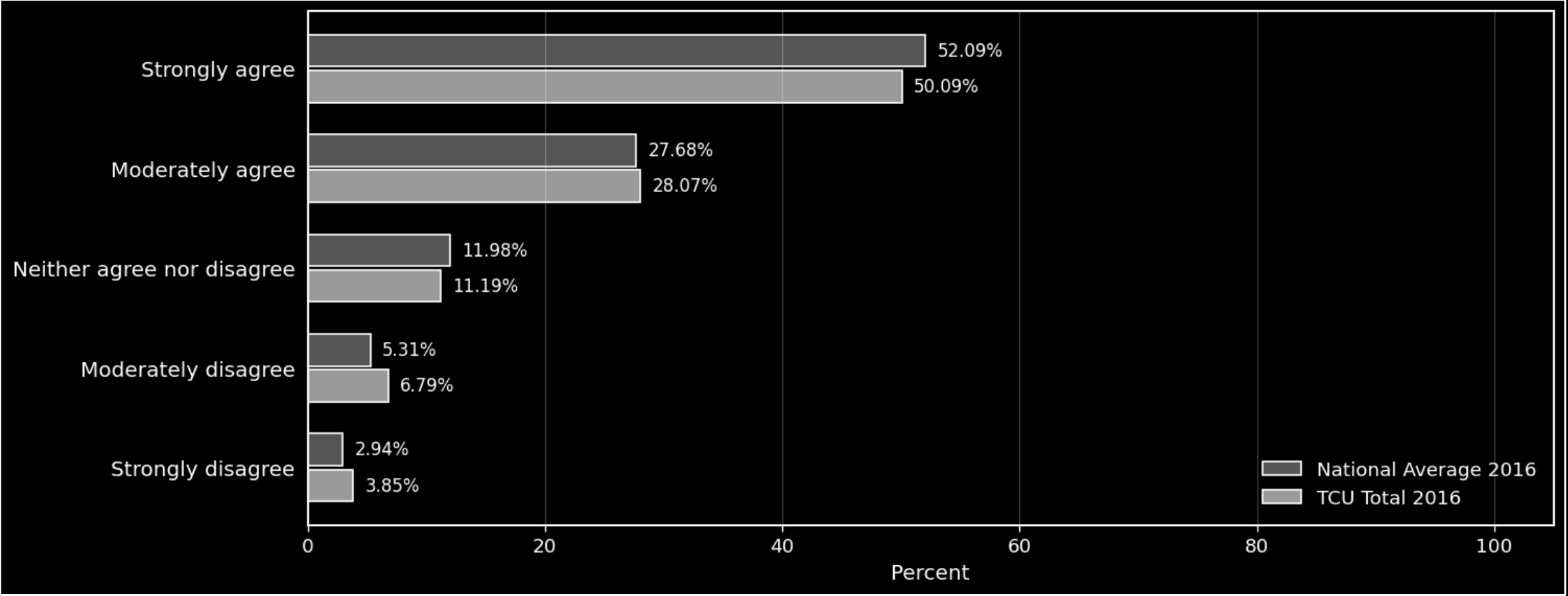

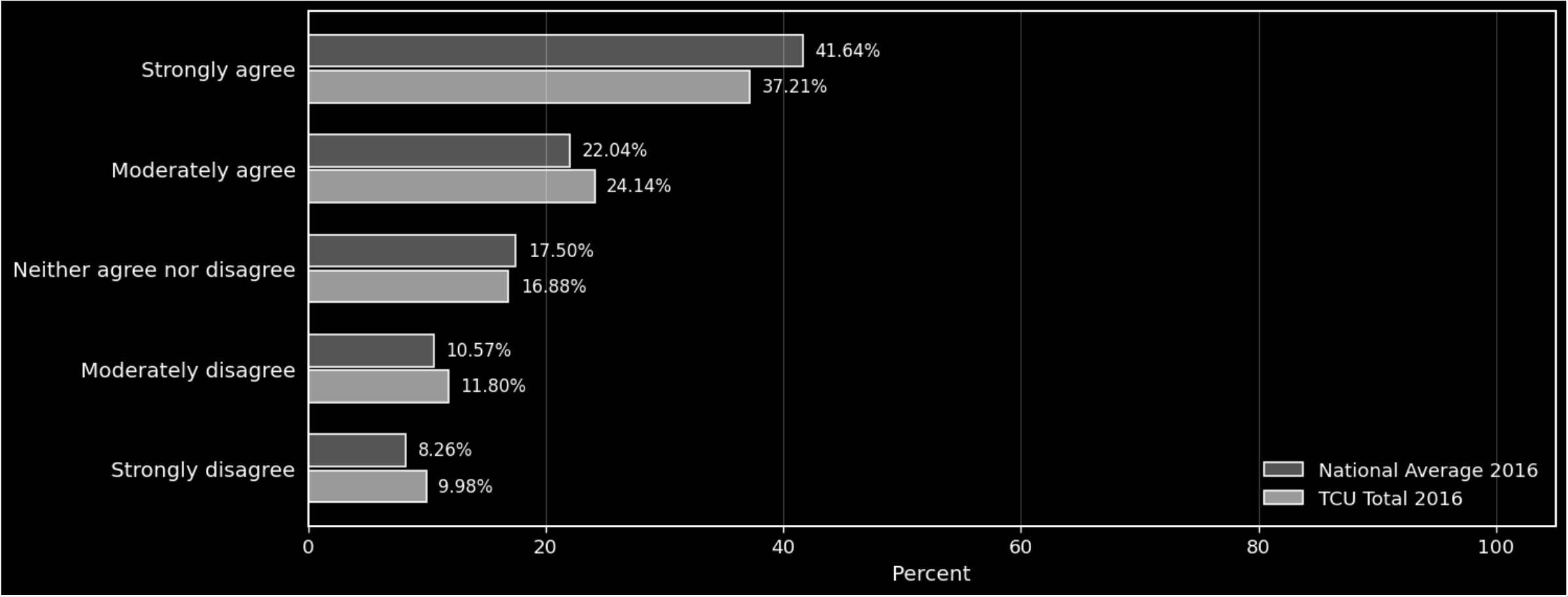

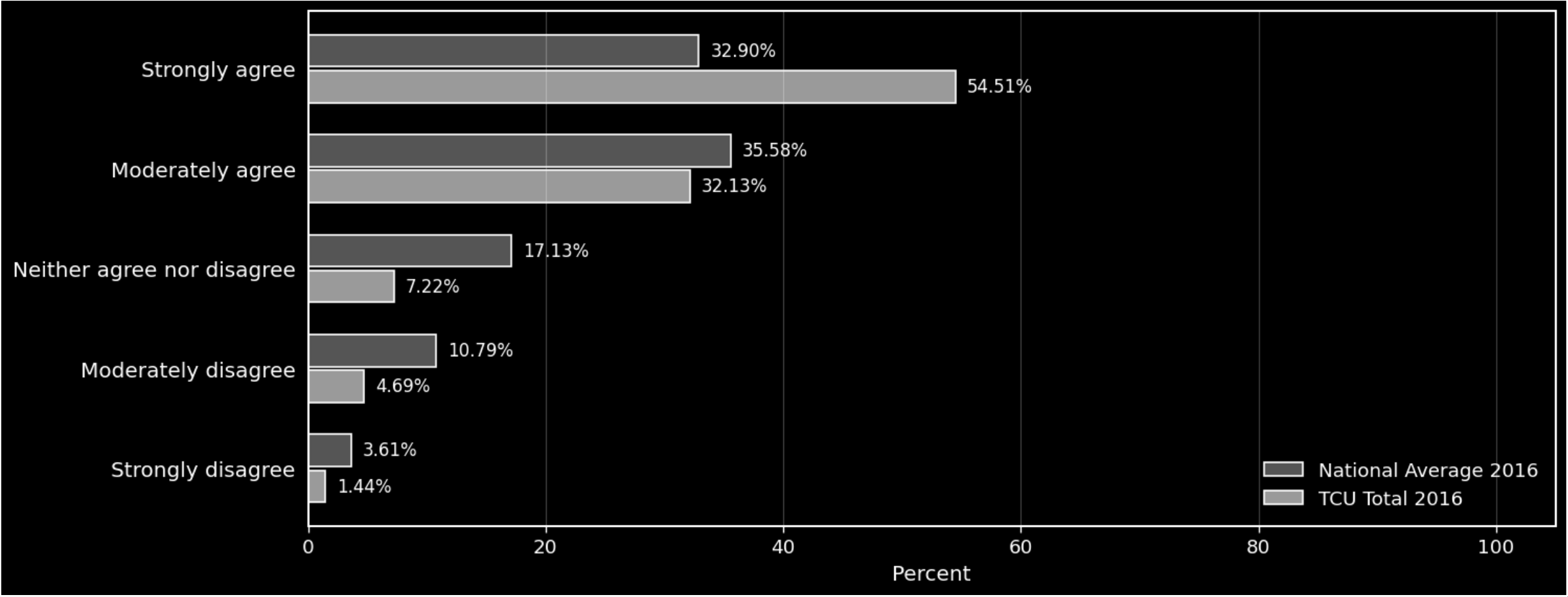

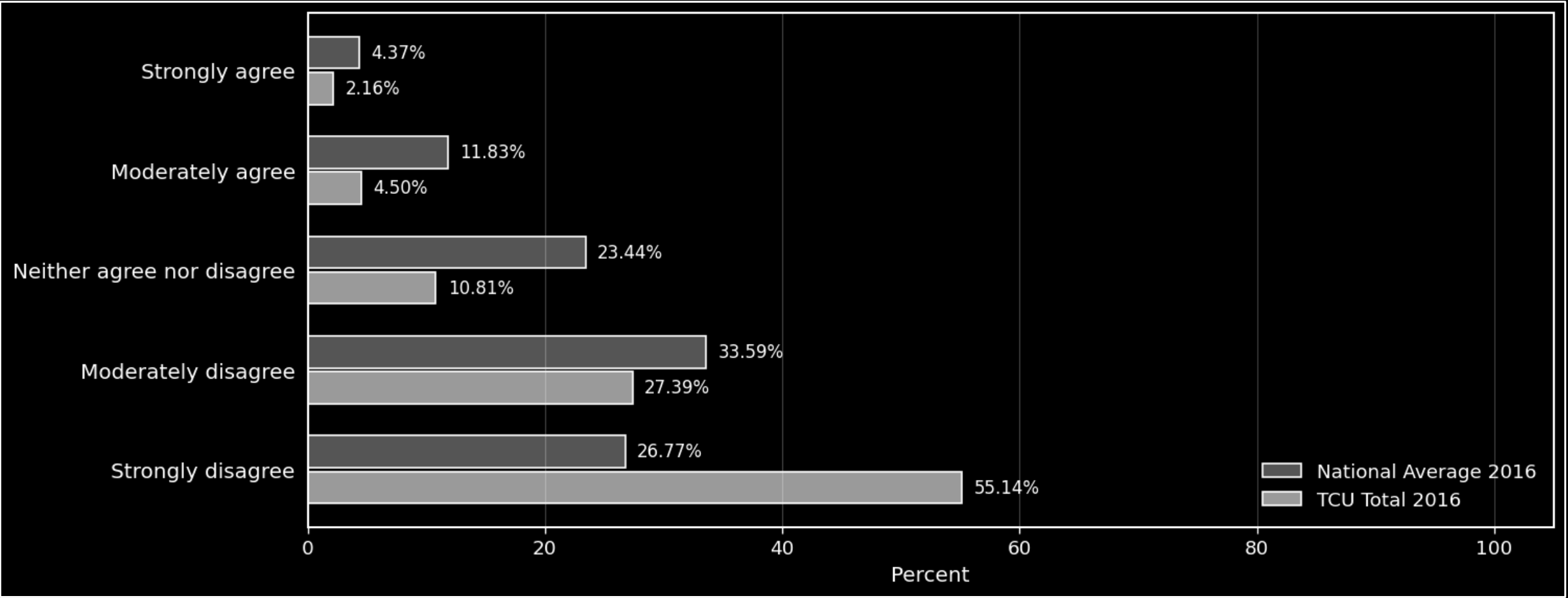

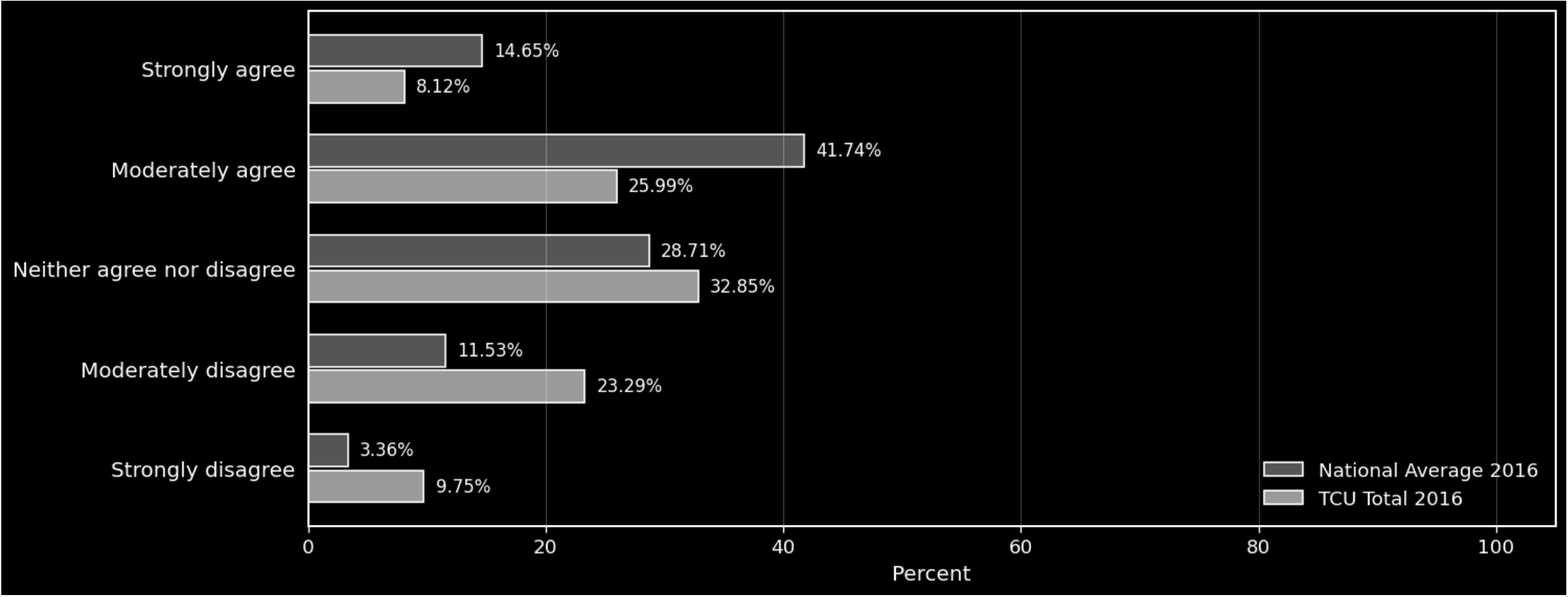

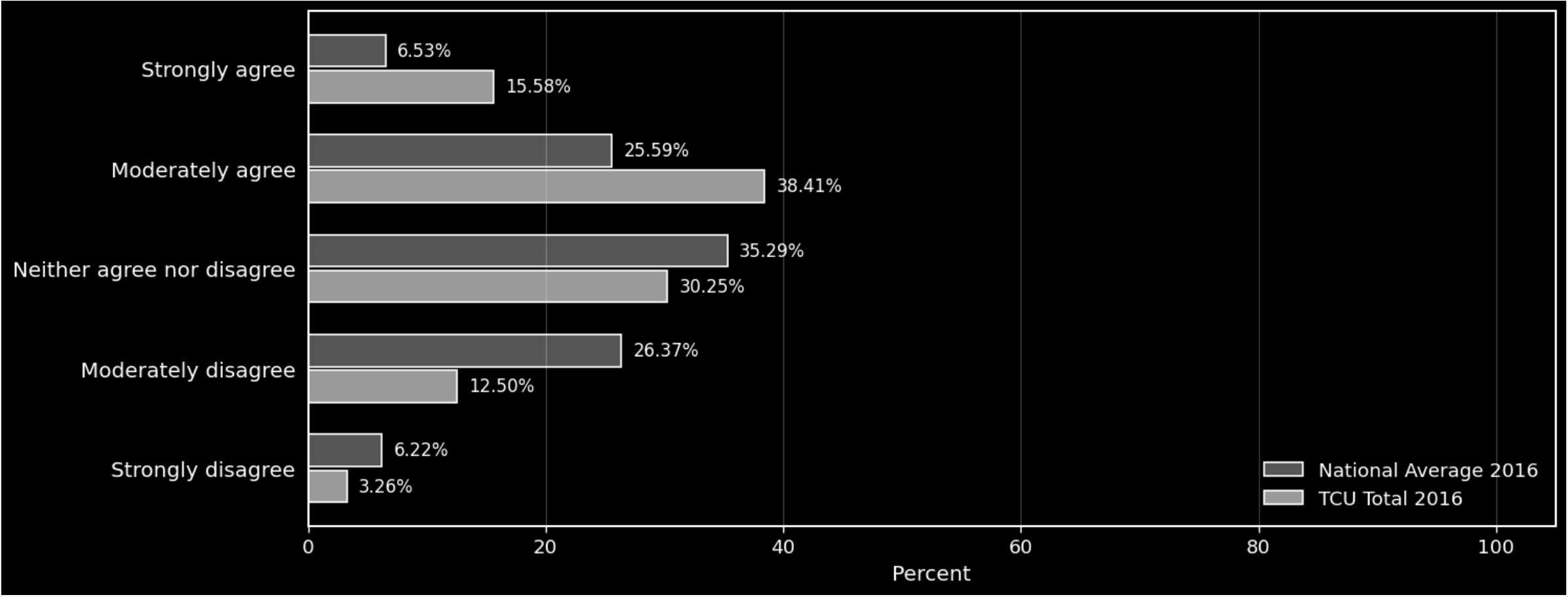

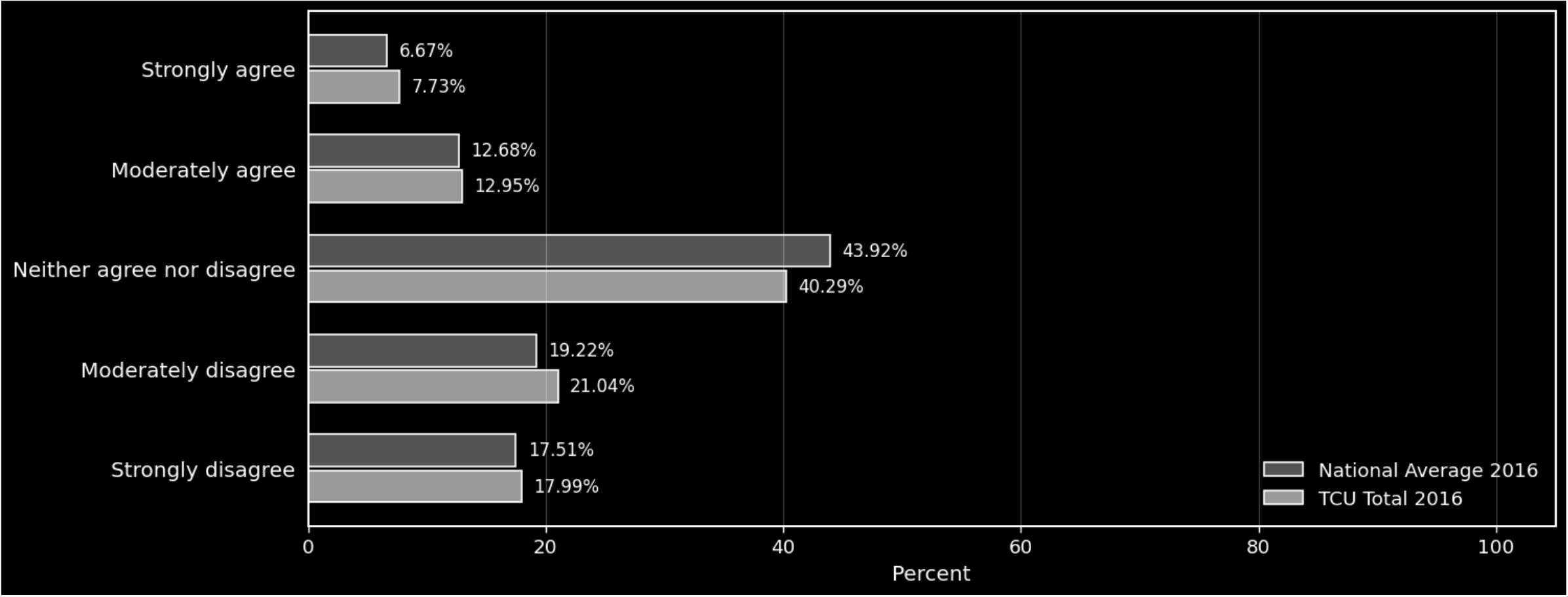


Chart 108. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statements: - Academic achievement is promoted by campus fraternities and sororities.

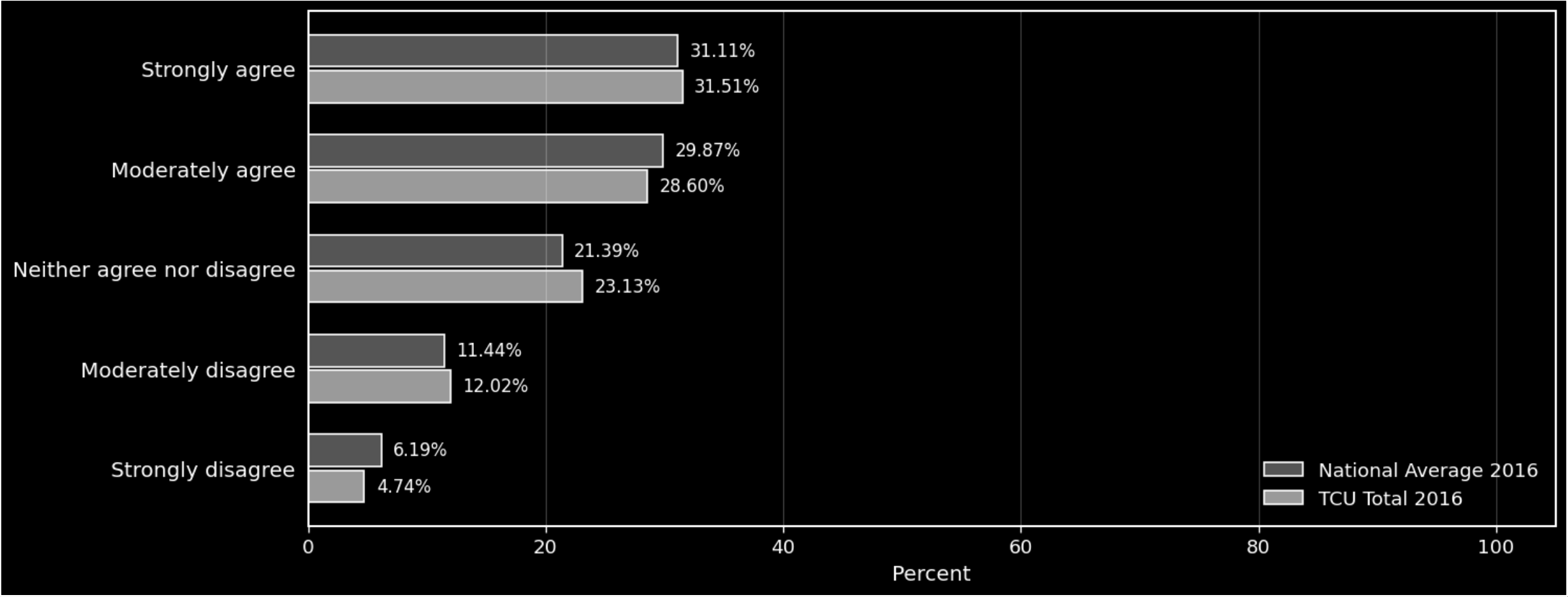


Chart 109. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statements: - Hazing is a problem in the fraternities and sororities on this campus. 1.26

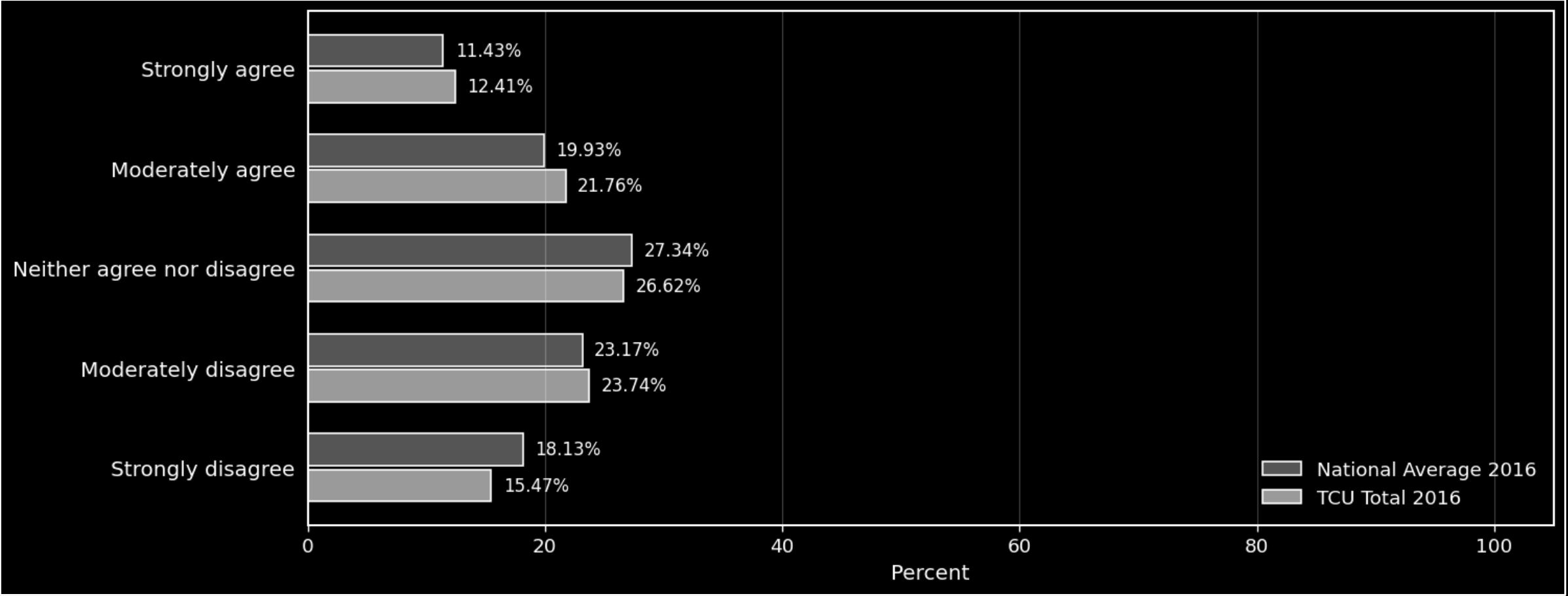


Chart 110. Please complete this statement: A majority of my friends are . . . (Check all that apply)

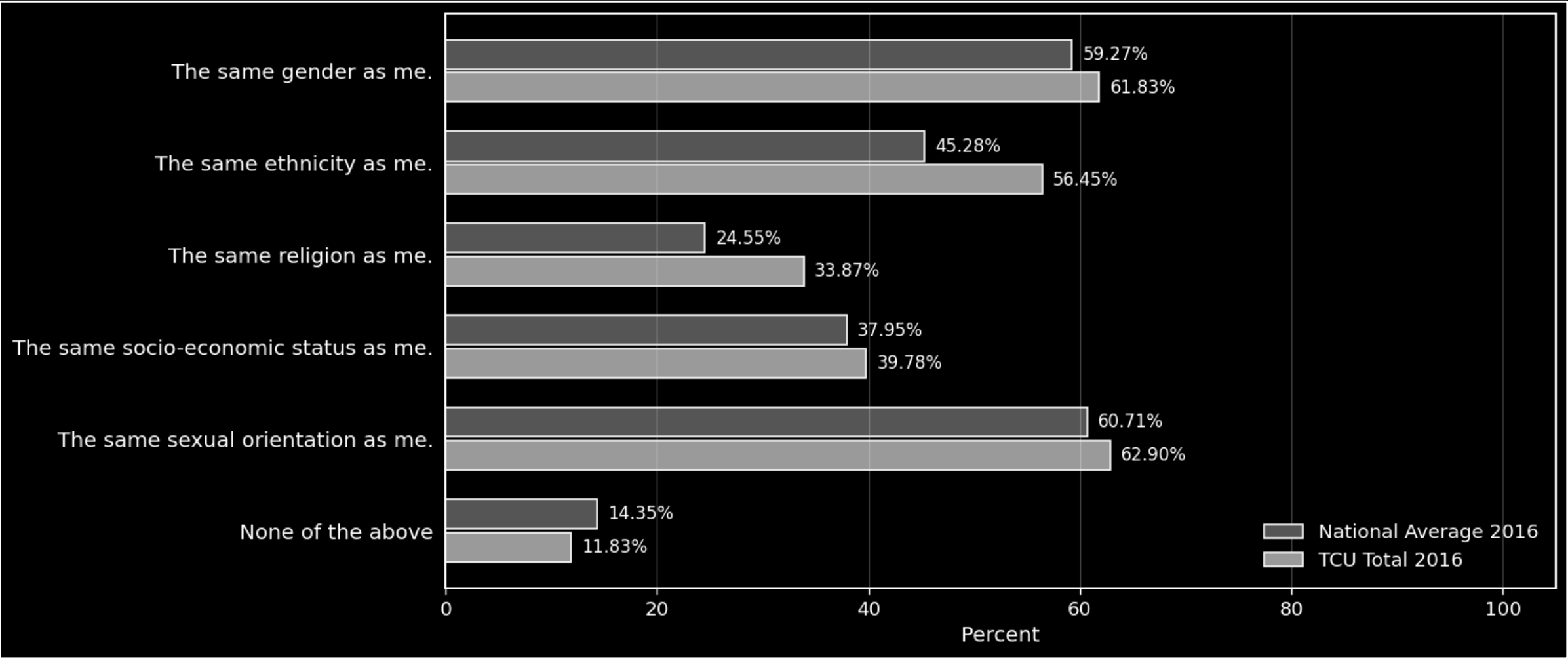

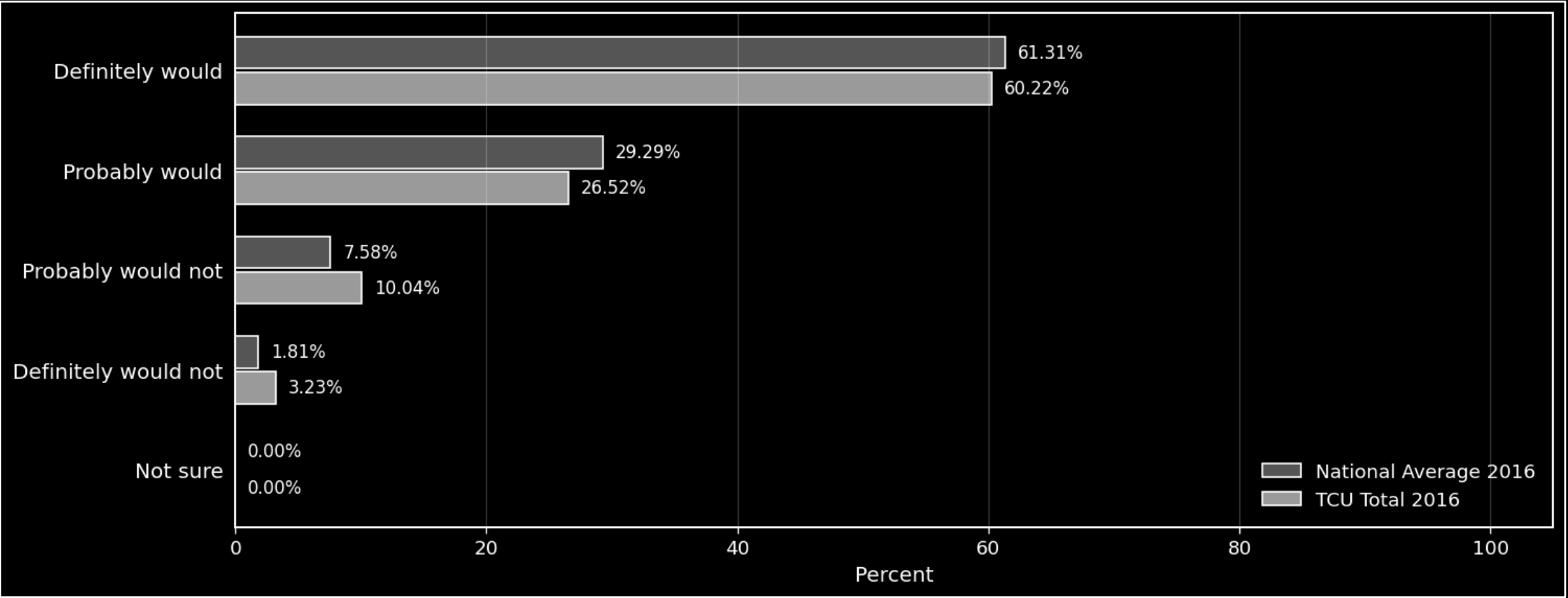

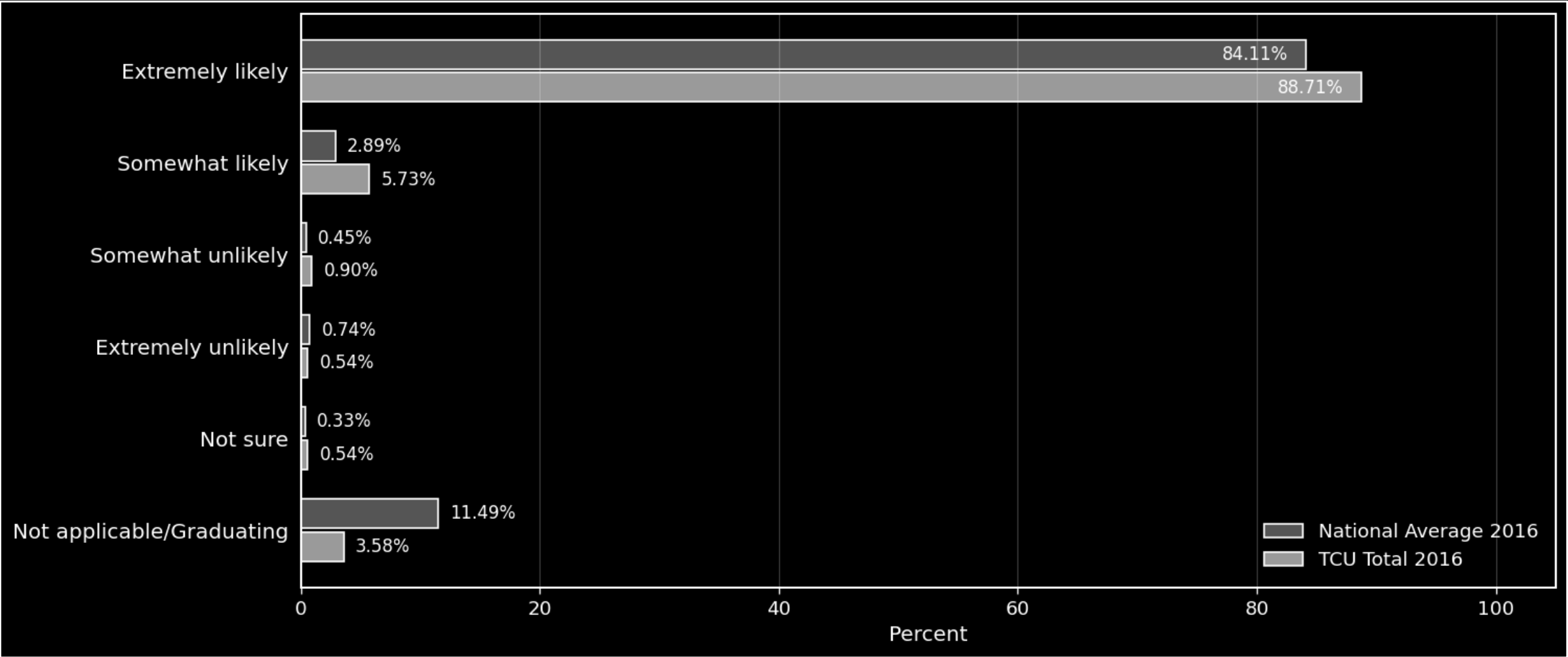


Chart 113. What is your current class standing?

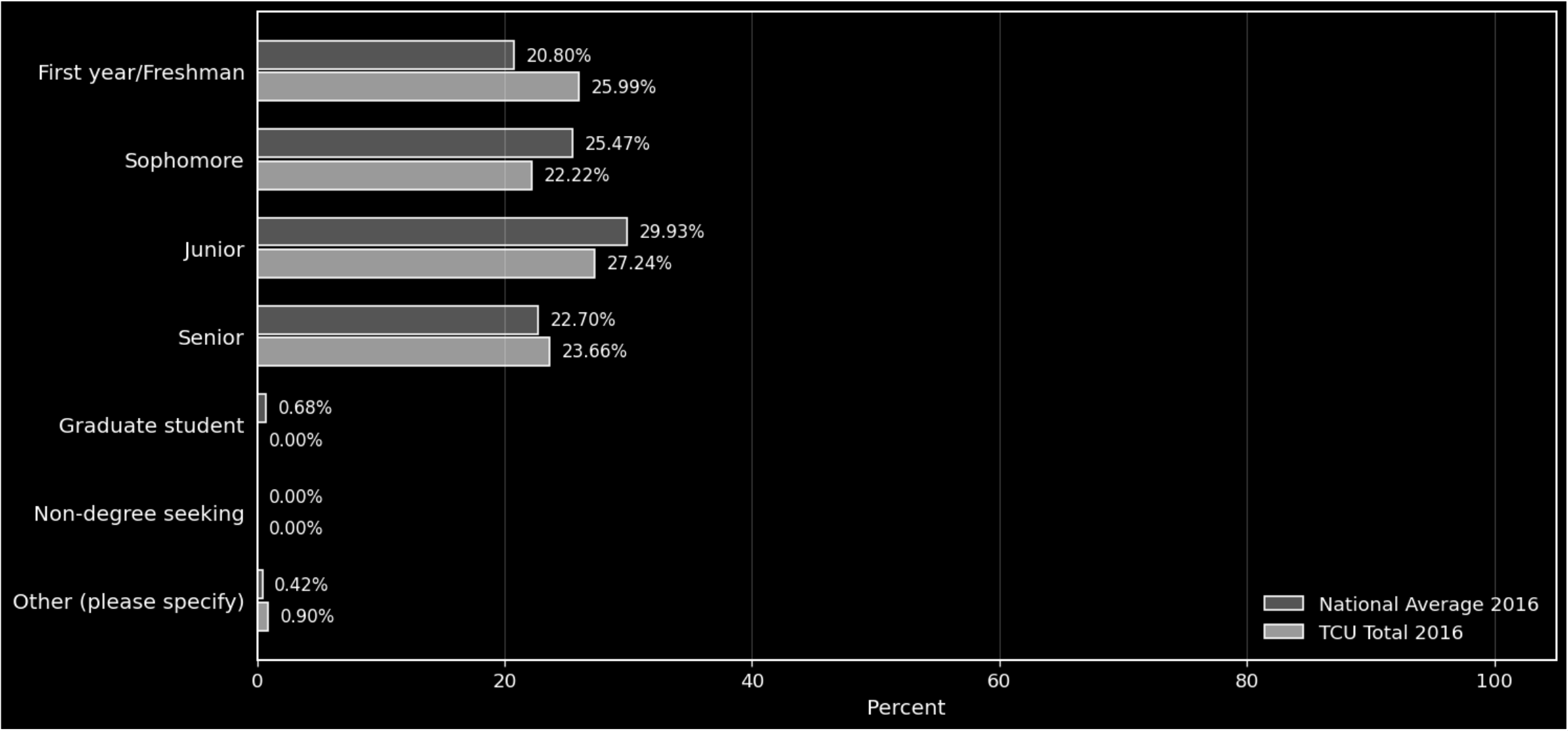


Chart 114. What is your current enrollment status?

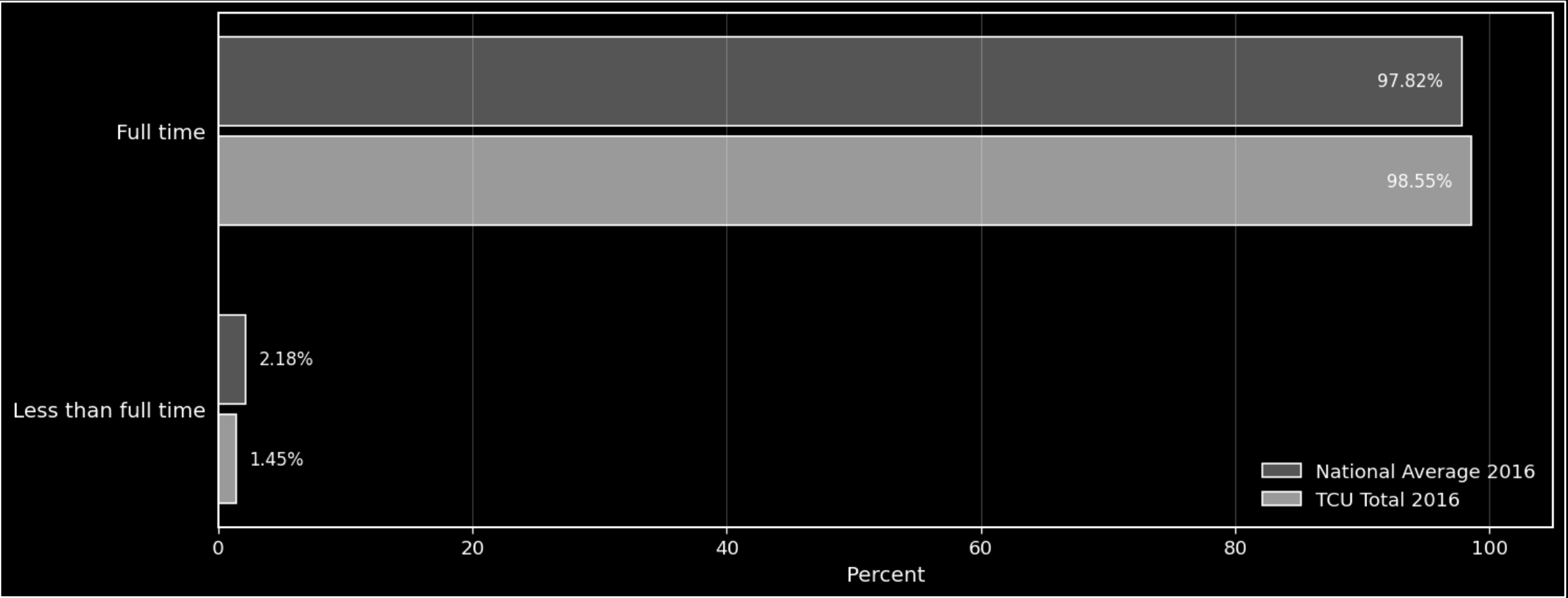


Chart 115. In which subject area is your major? (Part 1 of 2)

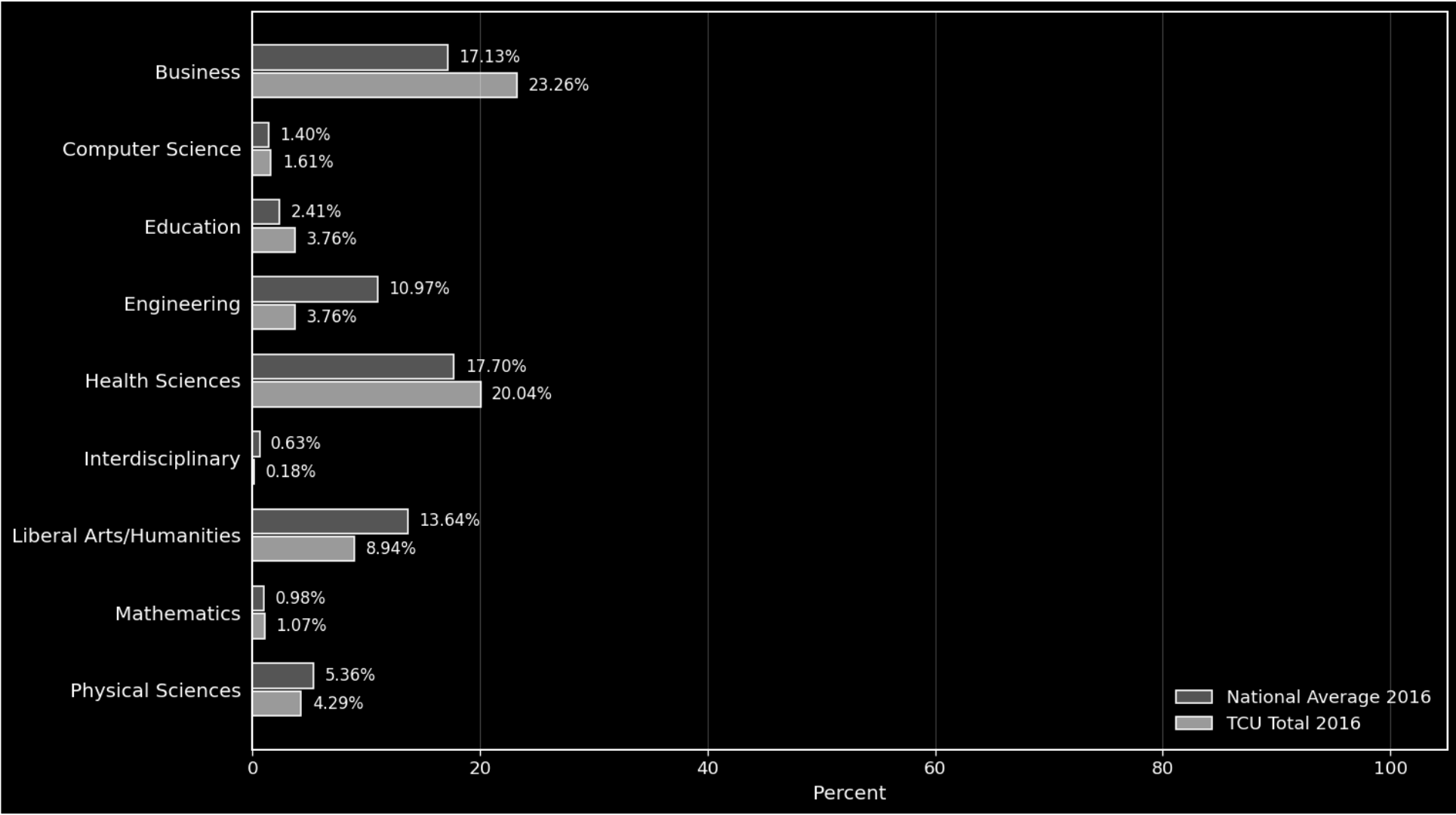


Chart 115. In which subject area is your major? (Part 2 of 2)

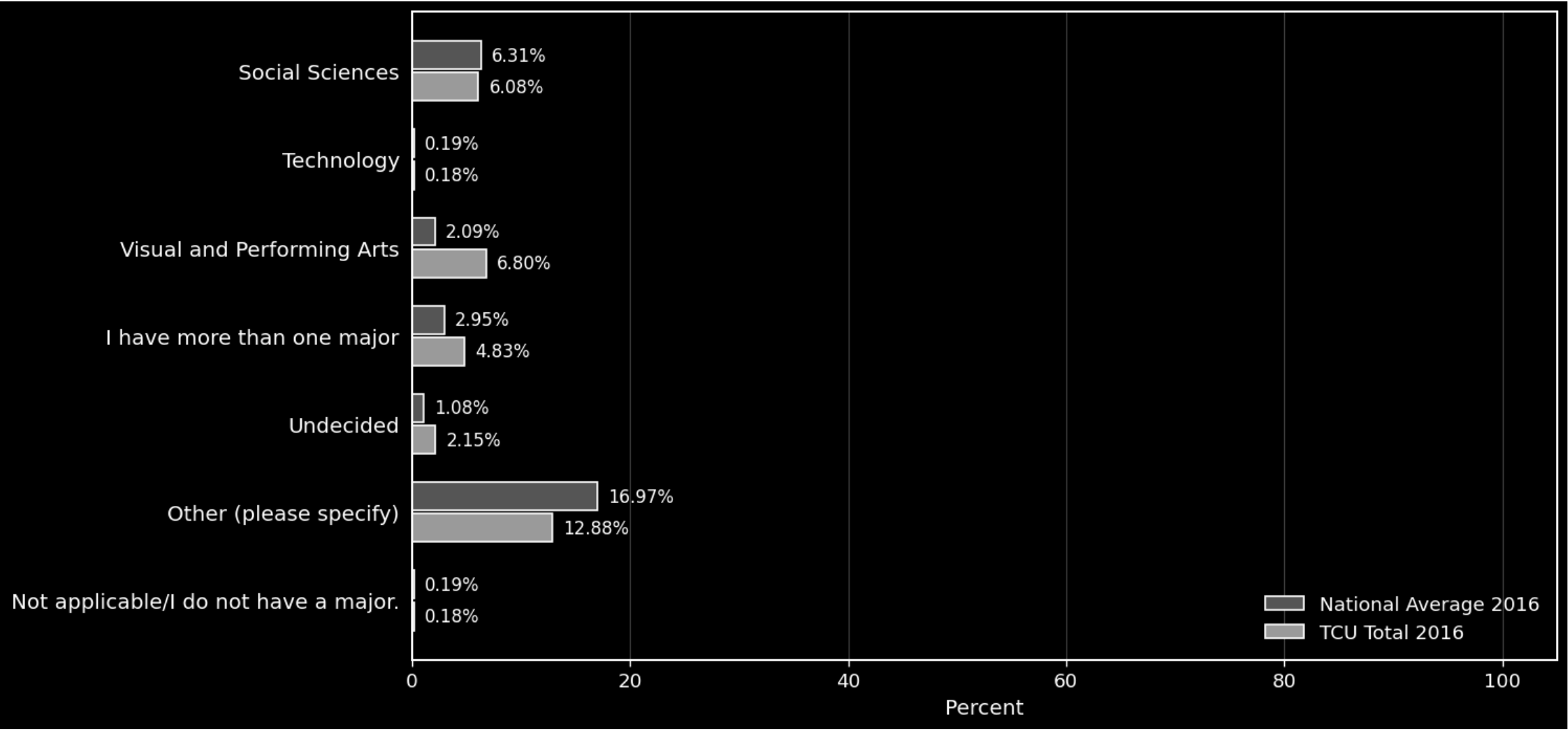


Chart 116. What is your approximate cumulative GPA?

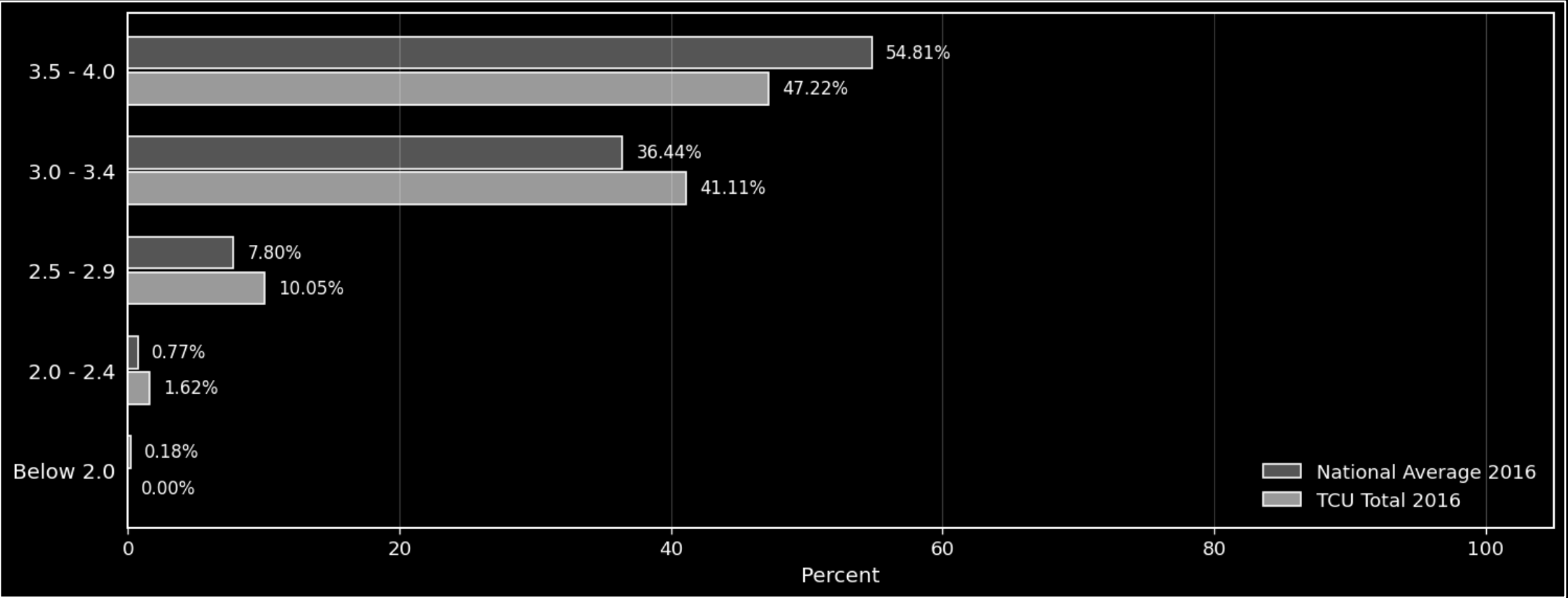


Chart 117. Are you the first in your family to go to college (i.e., neither of your parents/guardians or siblings have attended any college)?

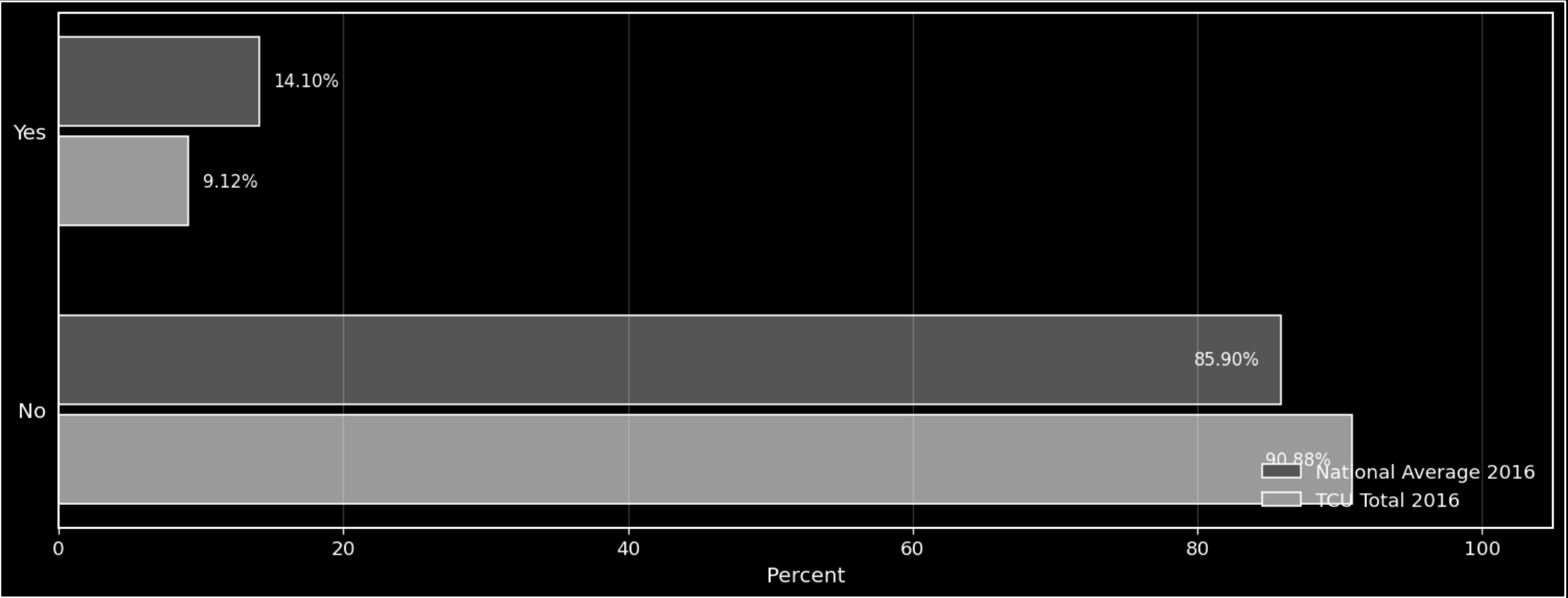


Chart 118. Did you transfer to this institution?

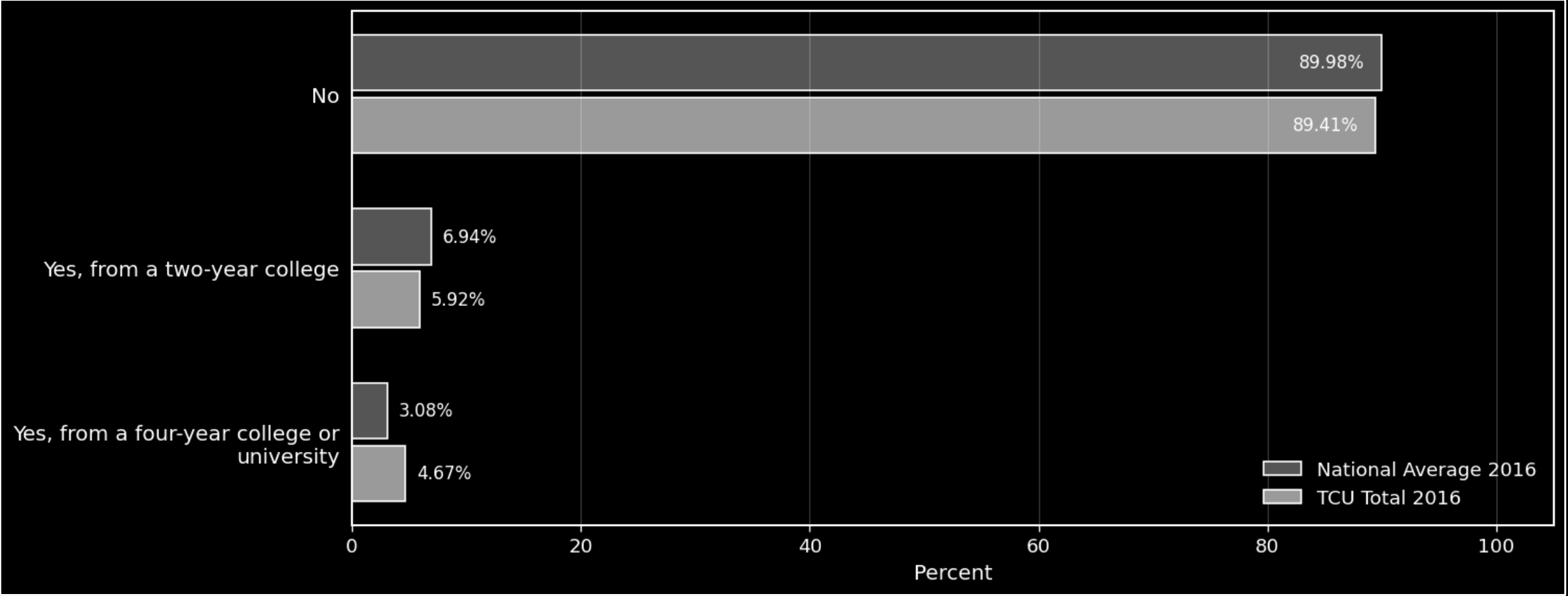


Chart 119. Where do you currently live?

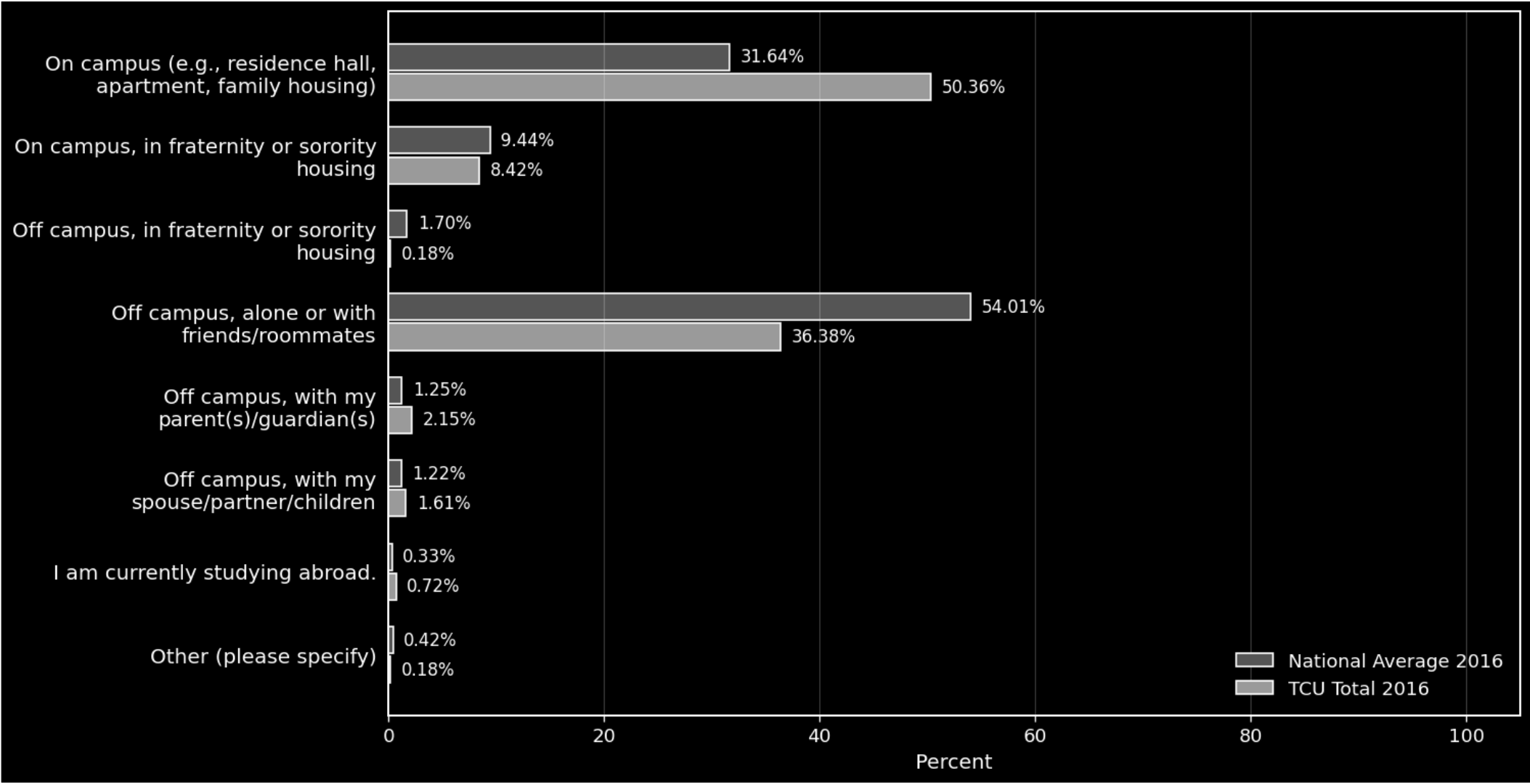


Chart 120. What is your current gender identity?

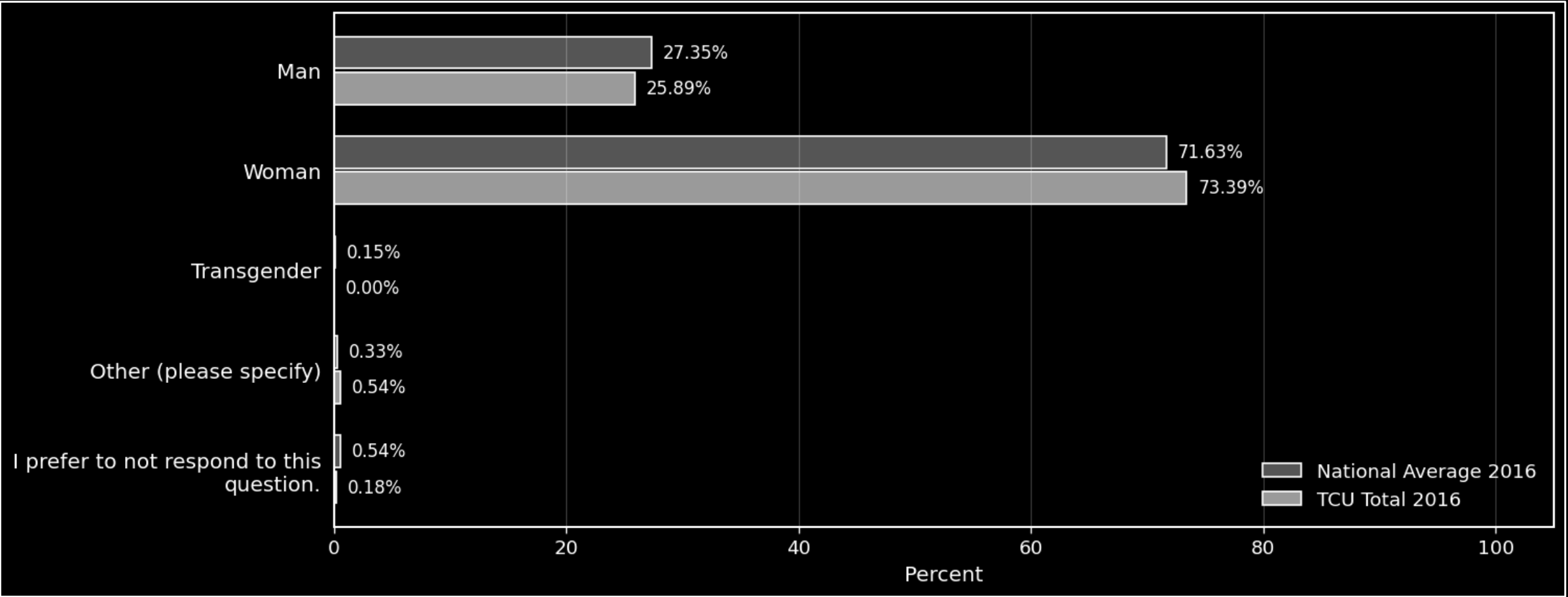


Chart 121. Do you identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or queer?

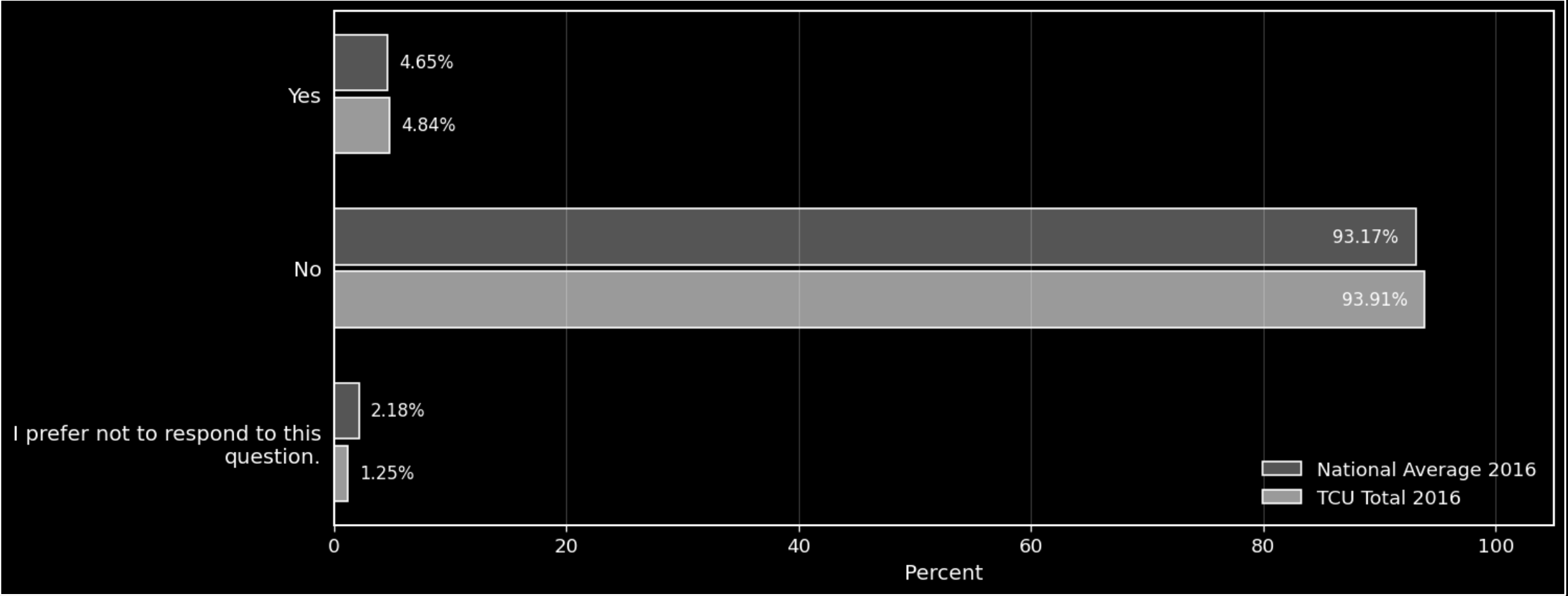


Chart 122. With which category do you most identify?

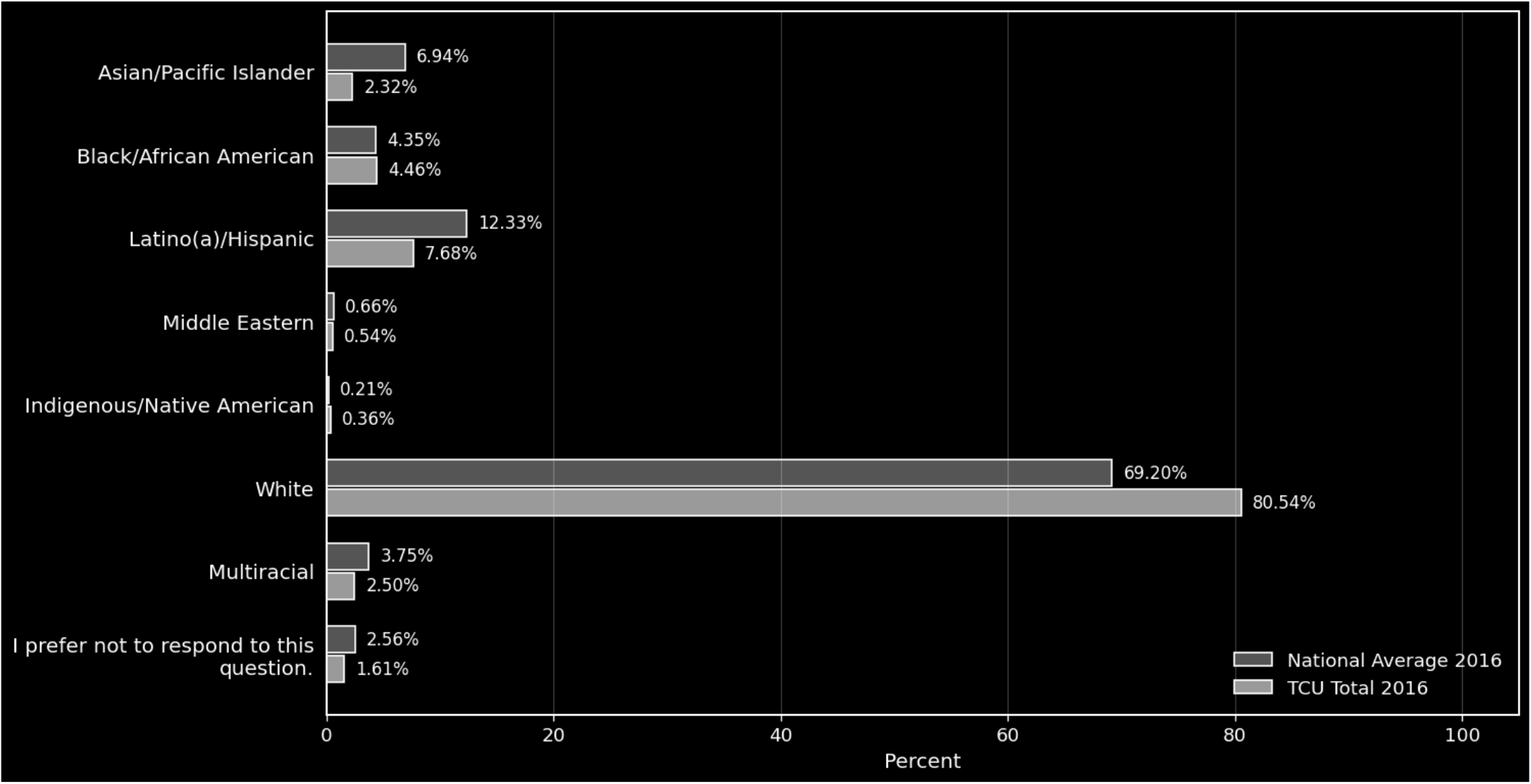


Chart 123. Are you an international student (holding a SEVIS visa group: F1, F2, J1, J2, BE, BP, B1, B2, WB, WP)?

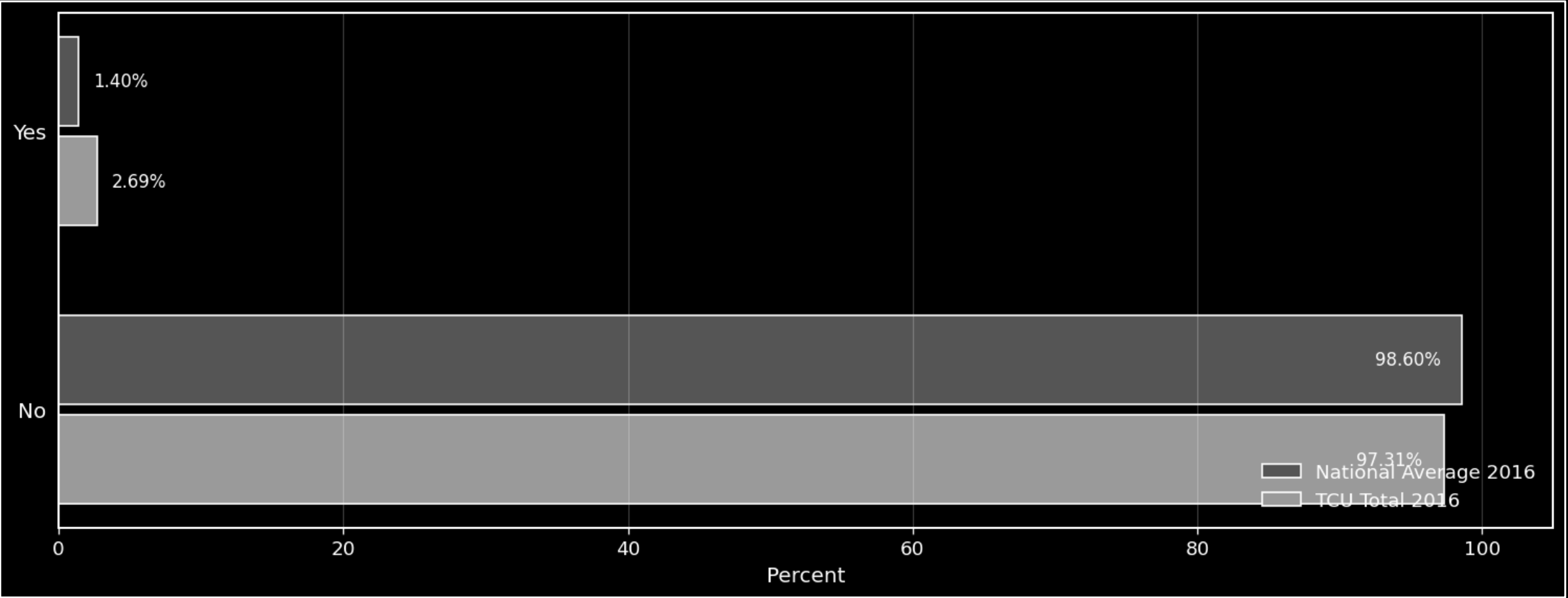


Chart 124. Have you ever been enlisted in any branch of the US military (active duty, veteran, national guard, or reserves)?

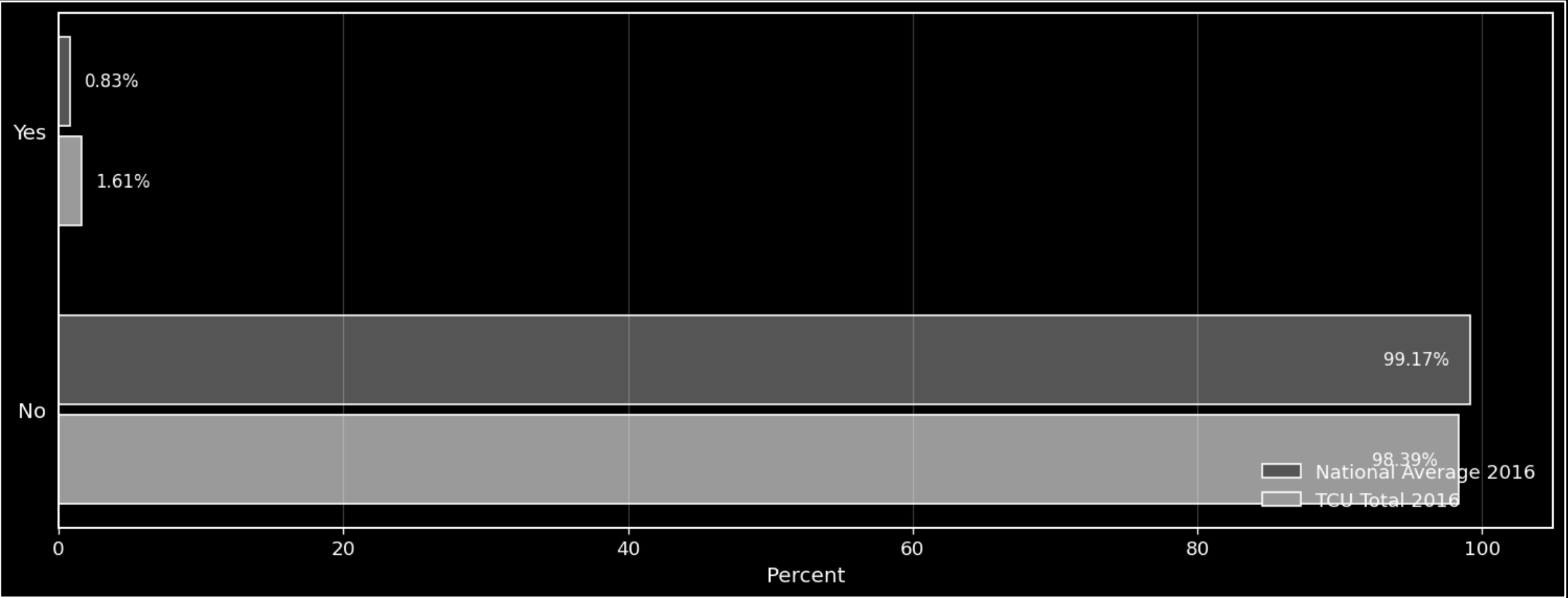


Chart 125. How old are you? N Top 25 Bottom 25 Rank 2.30 3017 0.23% 3.31 510 0.59%

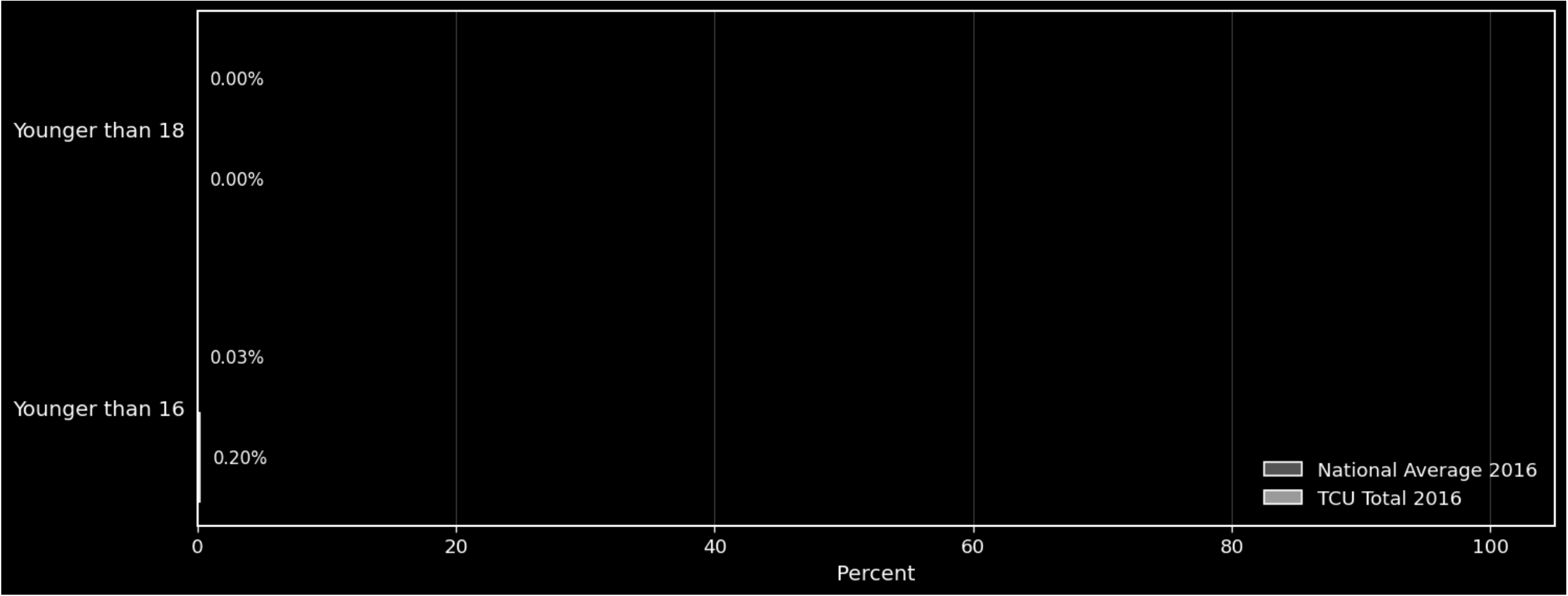


Chart 126. How old are you? N Top 25 Bottom 25 Rank 2.30 3017 0.23% 3.31 510 0.59%

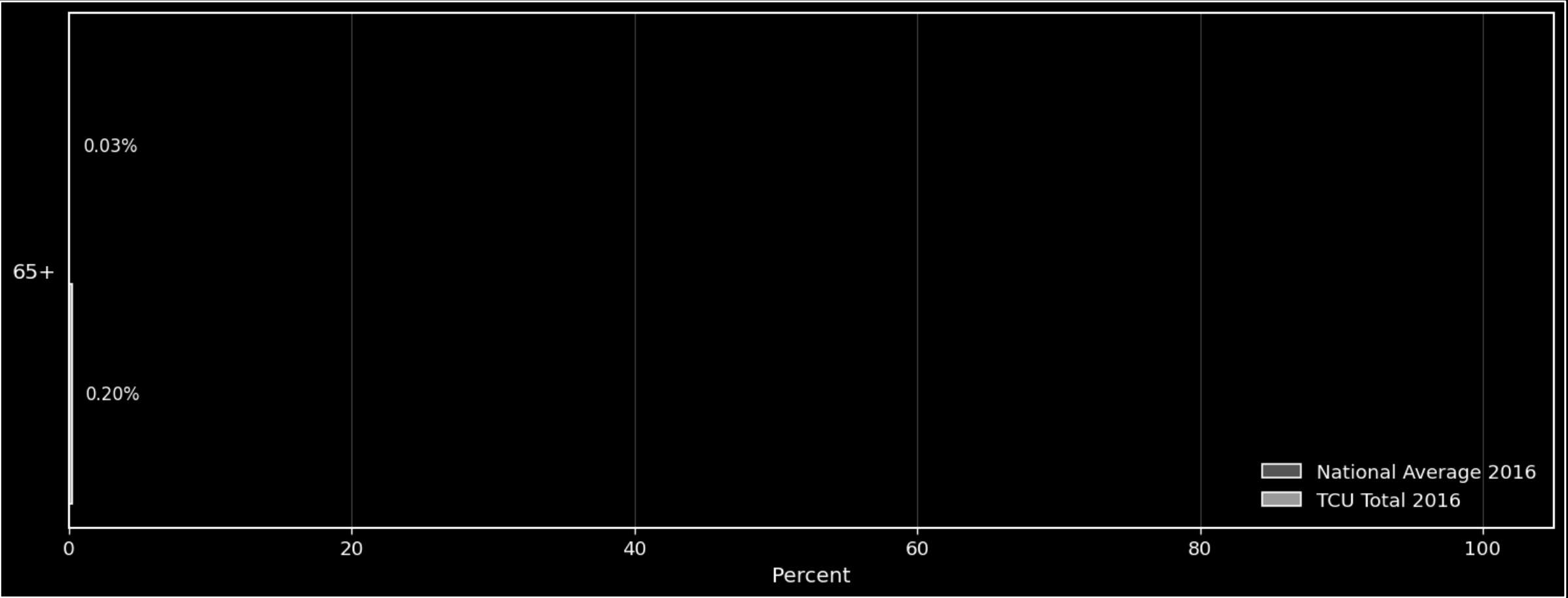


Chart 127. How many hours do you typically spend studying each week?

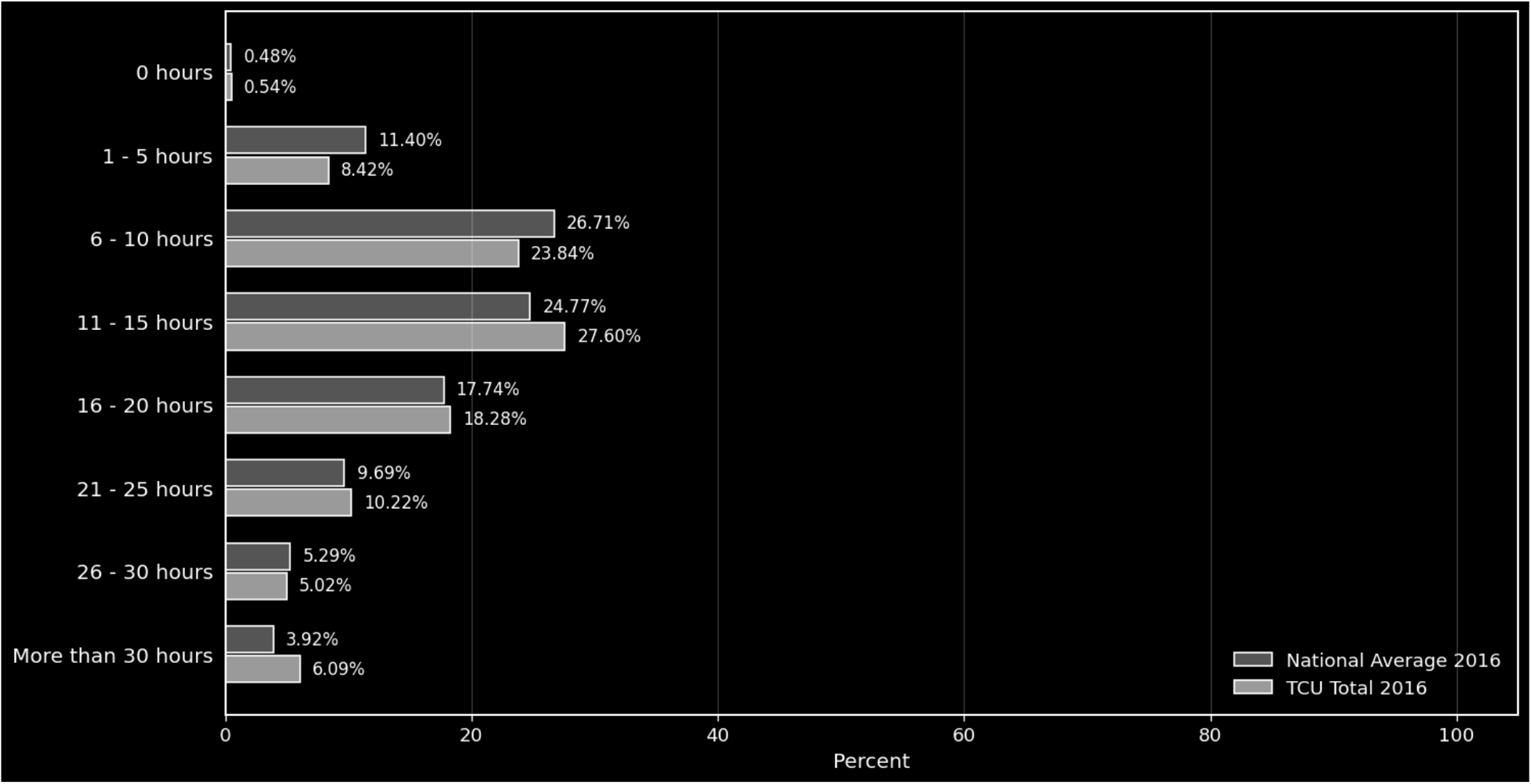


Chart 128. How many hours (during the academic year) do you typically work for pay?

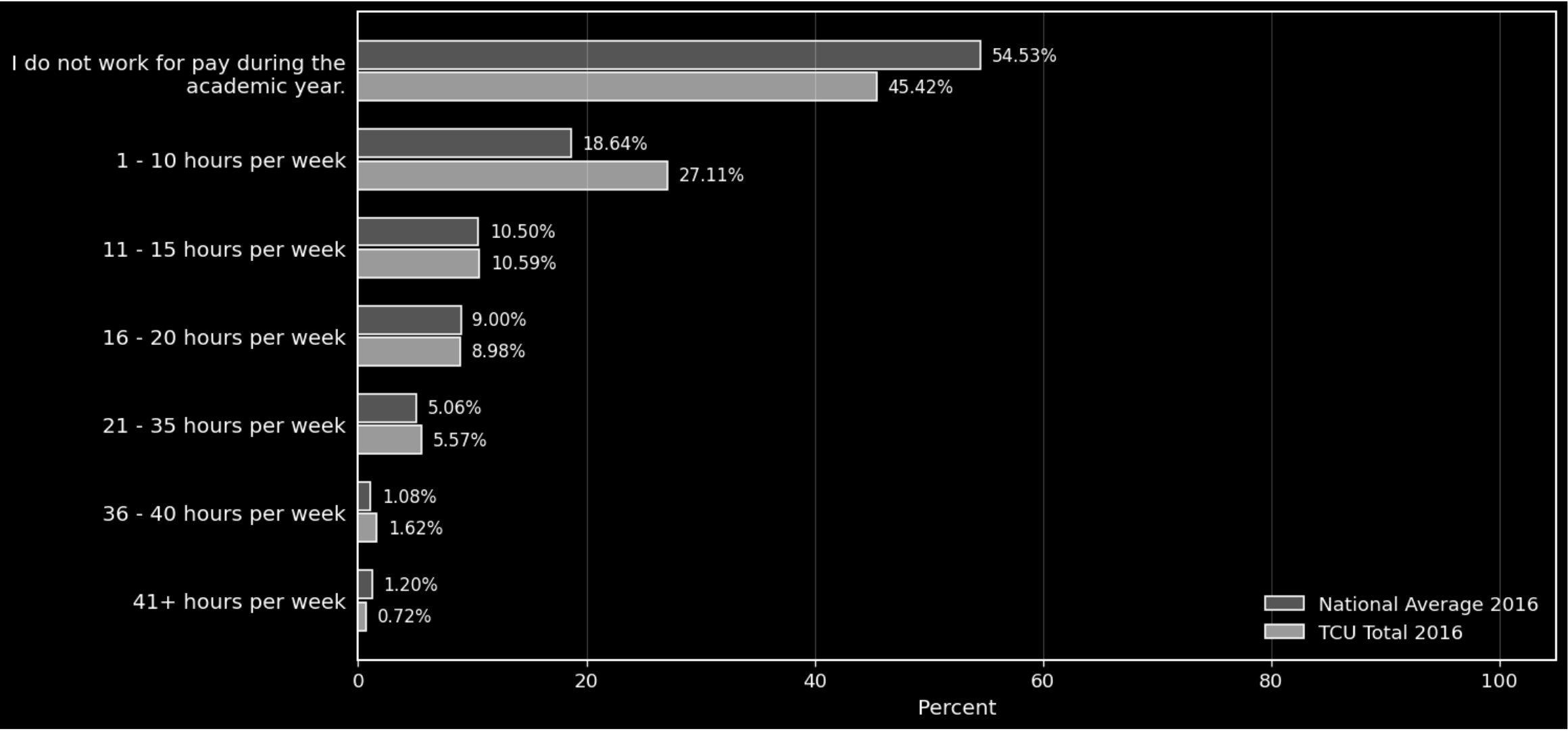


Chart 129. Please answer the following questions: - Are you a member of at least one student club or organization this semester/quarter?

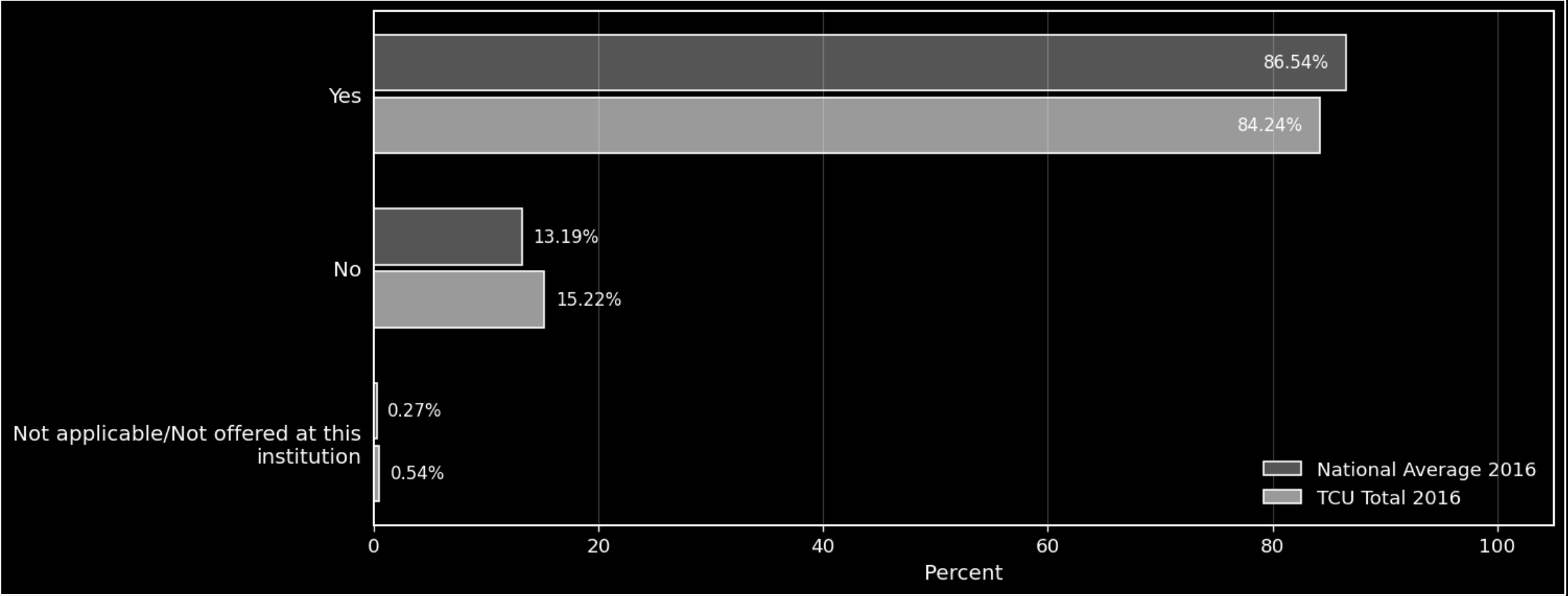


Chart 130. Please answer the following questions: - Are you involved in at least one intramural group, club sport, or organized fitness activity on campus this semester/quarter?

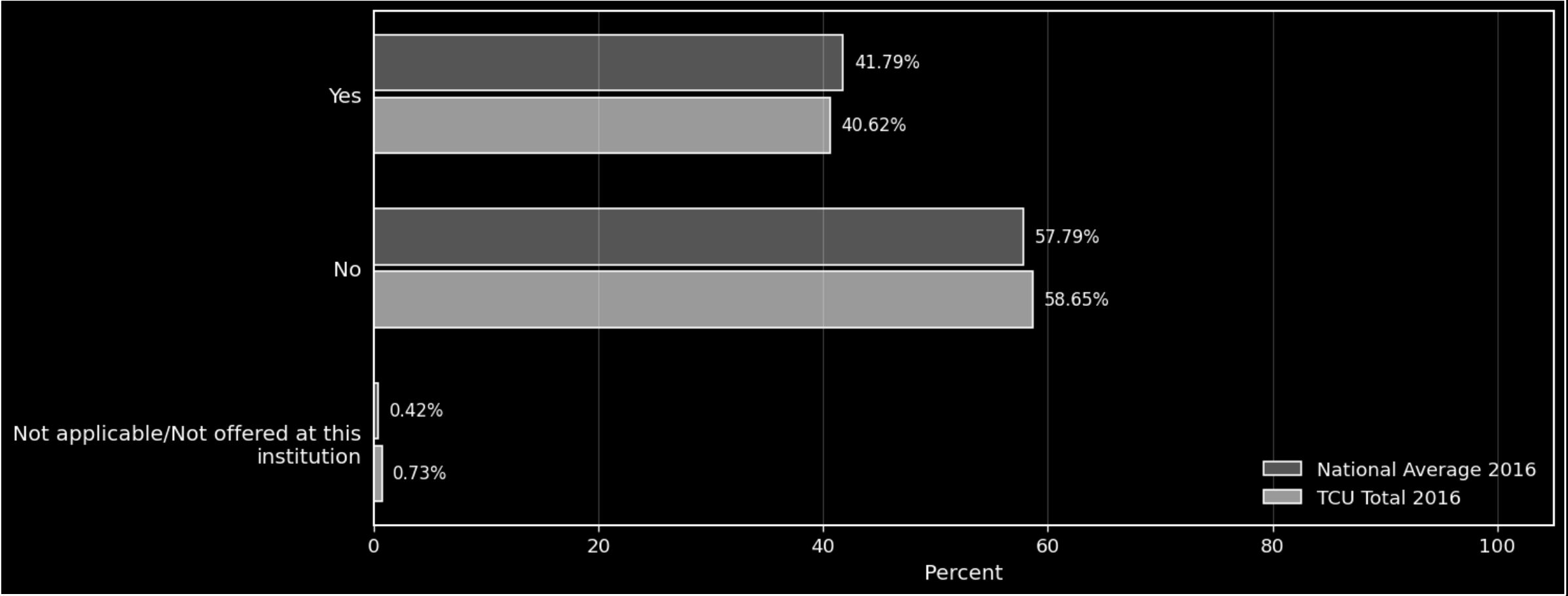


Chart 131. Are you a member of an intercollegiate (e.g., NCAA, NAIA) athletic team?

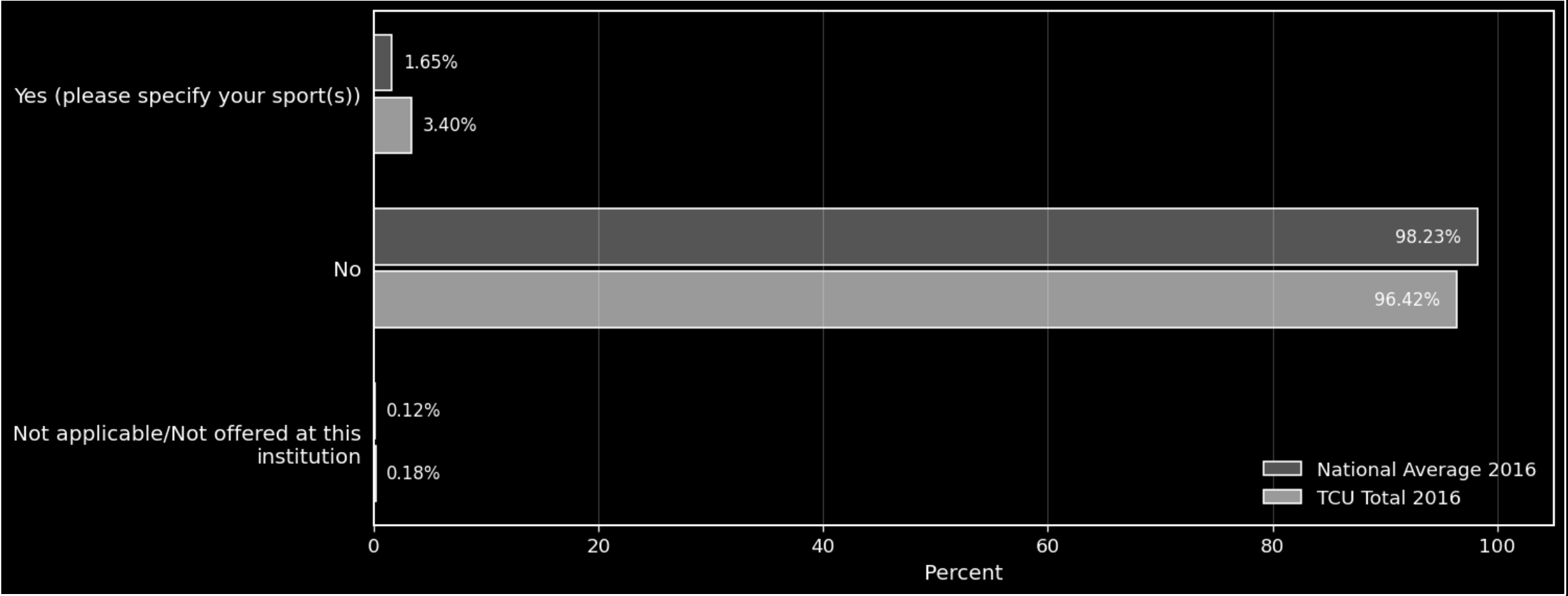


Chart 132. Is/was anyone in your family a member of a fraternity or sorority?
